TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - The St. Paul Saints fell behind 4-0 after three innings and couldn't mount a comeback in a 6-2 loss to the Iowa Cubs on Friday night at CHS Field. Caleb Hamilton hit his first home run of the season for the Saints. Curtis Terry and Cole Sturgeon each collected a pair of hits.

RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK: The St. Paul Saints catchers have done a tremendous job throwing out base runners this season. On Friday night they nabbed their 11th would be base stealer of the season. The 11 caught stealings are tied for second in Triple-A, only the 14 of the Buffalo Bisons. The Saints have thrown out 29.0 of base stealers.

HOW DO YOU SPELL R-E-L-I-E-F: The St. Paul Saints bullpen has been very good in the series against Iowa. In 20.1 innings they have allowed three runs on 10 hits while walking nine and fanning 24.

A NIGHT OF FIRSTS: Two former Saints had big nights at the big league level with the Twins on Friday. Jose Miranda hit his first Major League home run and Royce Lewis, in his first game in the Majors, collected his first hit, a single to right field.

WELCOME THE NEW GUYS: Cole Sturgeon and Ernie Yake got into the game on their first nights with the Saints on May 5. Sturgeon got in defensively and Yake scored what turned out to be the winning run as a pinch runner. On Friday night they both contributed with their bats. Sturgeon went 2-5 and Yake collected his first Triple-A hit.

THEY'RE SO EXTRA: This season the Saints are 10-0 when collecting four extra base hits or more. When they collect two or fewer extra base hits, the Saints record is just 3-9. EXTRA: The Saints are 8th in the International League in total extra base hits with 80, including a league best 54 doubles.

SAINTE GOT NO TIME FOR THAT: The Saints and Cubs completed their game on May 5 in 2:17, the third fastest nine inning game this season for the Saints. It was already their 9th full game under 2:35 this year. All of last season the Saints played 13 total nine inning games in under 2:35. This year they are on pace to play more than 50 games in under 2:35.

DOMINATING THE I-35 RIVALRY: In their first season as the Minnesota Twins Triple-A affiliate, the Saints found their first rival, the Iowa Cubs. The team closest in proximity to the Saints faced off 35 times a season ago with the Saints going 23-12, including a six-game sweep in Iowa from May 25-30. Overall, the Saints went 3-0-3 in their six series. Jose Miranda hit .319 with two homers and 13 RBI. Ryan Mason went 1-0 and didn't give up a run 4,1 innings while Ian Hamilton was 2-0 with a 1.15 ERA in 11 relief appearances.

IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The St. Paul Saints made a habit out of scoring first over the first two series, but over the last 15 games they have scored first just four times. In the 11 games in which the opposition scored first, they are 2-9.

THAT 70s THROW: Through 25 games no Saints pitcher had thrown more than 78 pitches in a game. On Friday night, May 6 that streak came to an end when Jake Faria went where no Saints pitcher this season had gone before: he threw 80 pitches.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins got solo homers from Jose Miranda and Byron Buxton and Josh Winder tossed 6.0 innings allowing one unearned run as the Twins downed the Oakland Athletics 2-1 on Friday night at Target Field.

LATE START: Jordan began the season on the injured list with a left knee strain and didn't begin the season until his first start on May 7.

MOVING ON UP: Prior to the 2021 season, Balazovic was the #6 rated prospect in the Twins organization. Just a year later he is now the #3 rated prospect in the organization and #85 overall

NOT THE NEXT JOHN TAVARES: Canada is a hotbed for NHL talent. Born and raised in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada, Jordan grew up playing both hockey and baseball, but the grind of both sports got to be too much. His parents made him choose one sport over the other and he chose basketball. That had to be a relief to his parents because despite being from Canada they aren't a big fan of winters.

A PORTRAIT OF A PITCHER AS A YOUNG MAN: When Balazovic looks around the Saints clubhouse, he will notice he's a boy among men, at least age-wise. At 23-years-old, he is the youngest pitcher on the staff and the second youngest player on the team, only behind Royce Lewis. Lewis was born June 5, 1999 while Balazovic is a full nine months older, born on September 17, 1998. The next closest in age to Balazovic is Jose Miranda who was born on June 29, 1998.

HE WANTS TO PUMP YOU UP: At 6'3 and 175 pounds at the age of 17 when the Twins drafted him in 2016, Balazovic definitely had room to grow, both in height and strength. Since that time he has grown two inches and put on 40 pounds.

ALL IN THE FAMILY: Baseball and softball run in the family. His Dad grew up playing baseball and his grandfather, Joseph, played two years in the Cleveland Indians organization. He played for the Fargo-Moorhead Twins, a C-Level team in 1957 and was promoted to the Burlington Indians in 1958, a B-Level team. Overall, the outfielder hit .238-6-48 while slashing .238/.333/.332 in 143 career games. Joseph hit the first pitch he saw in 1958 with Burlington for a home run.

QUITE THE OPENING ACT: As far as first appearances of the season goes, it's tough to beat what Balazovic has done in his career. In his five seasons pitching he is 1-0 with a 1.97 ERA allowing just four runs in 18.1 IP. Of those five appearances he only started his first appearance once, in 2019 with Cedar Rapids. He went 5.0 innings allowing one run on four hits while striking out nine on 76 pitches, 54 for strikes.

OPENING ACT PART DEUX: In 2019, Balazovic was promoted from Cedar Rapids to Fort Myers on May 3. He made his High-A debut for the Miracle two days later and had a debut for the ages. He pitched 7.0 perfect innings while striking out 10 at the Palm Beach Cardinals (St. Louis Cardinals). He threw 95 pitches, 62 for strikes.

OH CANADA: Balazovic was the top-rated Canadian coming out of the 2016 draft. He was the fifth Canadian selected that year. RHP Cal Quantrill (Port Hope, ON) went 8th overall to San Diego out of Stanford (CA) University, C Andrew Zerzy (Toronto, ON) went 52nd overall to Arizona out of York Mills (Toronto) Collegiate Institute, RHP Curtis Taylor (Port Coquitlam, BC) went 119th overall to Arizona out of the University of British Columbia, and SS Charles LeBlanc went 129th overall to Texas out of the University of Pittsburgh.
