NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, won 3 straight series and then lost back-to-back series, but are trending up, coming off a series win over Toledo.

After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games to open a stretch from April 22 to May 8 where the team went 3-11 ... however, the Chasers won 4 of 6 against Toledo last week and have won 8 of their last 11, since May 9.

Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August ... with a 10-8 record in May, the Storm Chasers need to win 4 of their final 9 this month have a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

Omaha's 82.8% success rate (53-for-64) ranks 3rd in the International League and 7th at the Triple-A level.

John Rave leads Omaha in steals (12) ... Gavin Cross has 10 steals in as many tries while Tyler Tolbert and Kameron Misner have each swiped 8 bags ... Cross and Tolbert are 2 of 4 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught this year.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.988 pitches per plate appearance, 6th-most in the International League and 10th at the Triple-A level.

Among 145 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, Kameron Misner is 4th in pitches seen/PA (4.441) while John Rave ranks 10th (4.340).

ST. PAUL SLUGGERS

A pair of Omaha hitters have seen some of their best road success at CHS Field.

John Rave is a career .342 hitter (27-for-79) with an .924 OPS in 19 games at CHS Field, his 2nd-best average and 3rd-best OPS of 12 road venues in the IL since 2022 ... his 27 hits in St. Paul are the 2nd-most of any Omaha hitter in a road ballpark since 2023 ... between 2024 and 2025, his 36 total bases at CHS Field were the 2nd-most of any visiting player.

Drew Waters is a career .362 hitter (17-for-47) with a .988 OPS in 11 games at CHS Field, his 2nd-best average and 3rd-best OPS at a road venue in the IL since 2021.

DON'T BRETT, SQUIRES IS HERE!

Chasers first baseman Brett Squires has been on fire recently, starting to find his groove after his call-up to Triple-A at the start of last week.

After a 1-for-15 start to his Triple-A career, Squires is 9-for-19 (.474) over his last 5 games with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 3 home runs, while driving in 9 runs.

Squires is the 4th Omaha player this year to have 3-straight multi-hit games, trailing only Tyler Tolbert's 4-game multi-hit streak from April 29 to May 3 ... he had back-to-back 3-hit games to finish the series against the Mud Hens, the first Storm Chaser to record consecutive 3-hit games this year.

COMEBACK KIDS

Thursday was Omaha's 13th comeback win of the season and the Storm Chasers' 6th consecutive win where they trailed at some point in the game.

After Omaha took a 1-0 lead in the 1st inning Tuesday, St. Paul took a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the 1st that held through the end of the 3rd, before Omaha tied the game in the 4th and took the lead for good in the 5th ... the Chasers trailed in each of their 4 wins last week over the Mud Hens, albeit for less than 1.0 inning in the last 3 wins.

Omaha's 13 comeback wins rank tied for the 3rd-most in the International League and tied 7th at the Triple-A level ... the Storm Chasers have trailed for more than 2.0 innings in 5 of the 13 comeback victories, while 5 of the 13 have only been brief deficits (1 inning or less).

In total, the Storm Chasers' 97 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and 3rd-most at the Triple-A level in that span.

Last Wednesday and Thursday's walk-off wins marked the 5th time in Werner Park history (since 2011) that the Chasers walked off back-to-back games and the first time since March 2024 ... it was also the 5th time Omaha had two straight walk-off wins come courtesy of the same player, with Kameron Misner delivering both game-winners ... however, it was the first time in Werner Park history the same player has had the walk-off hit in consecutive games.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Aaron Sanchez is making his **10th start** with the Storm Chasers this year, also his **10th overall appearance** of the season ... is one of 13 players (6 pitchers) that has been active with Omaha all year.
- ✓ Playing his **17th professional season** this year, the Royals are his 7th MLB organization ... has played parts of 8 Major League seasons with Toronto (2014-19), Houston (2019), San Francisco (2021), Washington (2022) and Minnesota (2022) ... has played parts of 7 years in Triple-A, Omaha is his 6th Triple-A team.
- ✓ Sanchez has faced St. Paul once in his career, though he pitched 28 games for the Saints from 2022 to 2023 ... he allowed 5 runs (4 earned) over 3.1 innings in his start against St. Paul with Buffalo in May 2024.

THE SANCH FACTOR

- ✓ **FORMER TEAM FURY:** In 17 professional seasons, Sanchez has played for 19 teams but has faced only 5 of them as a former player ... one of those is St. Paul – he allowed 4 ER in 3.1 IP (10.80 ERA) against the Saints on May 25, 2024 ... against the other four, he has a 5.43 ERA (35 ER in 58.0 IP) in 14 games (13 starts).
- ✓ **FINDING HIS FOOTING:** Pitched to a 9.68 ERA (19 ER in 17.2 IP) with 15 walks to 14 strikeouts over his first 5 starts (March 29 to April 22) ... in his last 4 starts (since April 28), has a 4.58 ERA (9 ER in 17.2 IP) with 7 walks to 19 strikeouts (2.71 K/BB).
- ✓ **BATTERY POWERED:** Luke Maile caught 17 of Sanchez's starts with the Toronto Blue Jays between 2017 and 2019, and the two are reunited in Omaha after more than 6 years apart ... across their careers, Maile has caught Sanchez for 95.2 innings (including 12.2 innings and 3 consecutive starts in Omaha this year), 2nd-most among any catcher behind only Russell Martin (339.0 innings).
- ✓ **ROAD BACK TO THE SHOW:** Sanchez last appeared in the Major Leagues 1,326 days ago on October 4, 2022 with the Minnesota Twins ... he has since pitched 45 games (43 starts) in the Minor Leagues.
