On The Road Again

The Fightin Phils continue a two-week road trip on Saturday night at the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the 17th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and eighth-of-nine at TD Bank Ballpark. Somerset leads the season-series 9-7, and can clinch it with one more win.

Losing Streak Snapped

The Fightin Phils snapped a five-game losing streak with a 2-0 win at Somerset on Friday night. The bullpen was the story of the night, as five relievers combined to hold Somerset to four hits and no runs. With the game tied at zero in the top of the seventh, Cade Fergus delivered a two-run, two-out, bases-loaded, single to break the tie. Andrew Baker got the win and Tommy McCollum the save. Carlos Francisco, Nelson L. Alvarez and Andrew Walling all also combined in the winning effort on the mound.

Marcus Mashing

After a recent slow stretch, Marcus Lee Sang is swinging the bat well again. Since August 13, Lee Sang is slashing .304/.333/.522, with an .855 OPS. He's added seven runs, two doubles, one triple, two home runs and four RBI. This comes after a stretch that saw Lee Sang go 7-72 (.097) from July 4-August 10. In Friday night's game, Lee Sang set a new career-high with three stolen bases. It also marked the second time this season a R-Phil stole three bags in a game. The other came from Gabriel Rincones Jr. on July 27 at New Hampshire.

Carson Cruising Again

After going 0-for-10 in his first three starts at Binghamton last week, Taylor followed with a five-game hit and seven-game on-base streak that was snapped on Friday night. During the hit streak, Taylor slashed .471/.571/.588, with a 1.159 OPS. He added one run, two doubles and four RBI over that stretch. Taylor's strong season has seen him littered amongst the Eastern League leaderboards.

News and Notes

Friday night was Reading's eighth shutout win of the season which by far and away surpasses last season's total of three. It's the most shutouts Reading has had in a season since posting 11 in 2022. Tommy McCollum also reached 10 saves in Friday night's ballgame. That mark surpasses last season's individual high of seven from Orion Kerkering. McCollum's 10 saves are the most by a Fightin Phil in a season since Brian Marconi had 18 in 2022.

Swiper Yes Swiping

The Fightin Phils enter Saturday night's game in fifth place in the Eastern League with 138 stolen bases on the season. That mark passes last season's total of 119, which ranked 10th in the Eastern League. Reading is on pace to finish this season with 154 stolen bases on the season. Since the All-Star Break, Reading is fourth in the Eastern League with 53 stolen bases. That has coincided with the debut of Justin Crawford and return of Gabriel Rincones Jr., who each own 12 stolen bases over that stretch. The R-Phils 138 stolen bases is their most in a season since swiping 130 in 2010. The next-best mark was 145 back in 2003.

Going Going Gone

This week's series matches up the two teams with the most home runs in the Eastern League this season. Somerset is in first place with 131 home runs and Reading sits in second with 127 long balls. Reading is on pace for 141 home runs this season, which would be the first time the R-Phils hit over 140 home runs in consecutive seasons since 2017 (153) and 2018 (141).

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 31, 2006: At Reading, on a night honoring the late Charlie Wagner and fallen police officer Scott Wertz, the R-Phils set a modern day franchise record by drawing 9,816 fans for the final home game of the season. The fans are treated to a Phillies victory as they rally for five runs in the 8th en route to the 6-3 decision. Twin Valley grad Nick Mattioni earns his 5th and final win in a Phils uniform.

Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with a 32-21 record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took four-of-six at Portland. Following this week, Somerset goes to Binghamton. Somerset's roster features seven players ranked amongst the New York Yankees' top-30 prospects: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (6), Brock Selvidge (7), Zach Messinger (17), Cam Schlittler (25), Trystan Vrieling (28) and Rafael Flores (30).

Patriots Pitcher

Righty, and Yankees' No. 17 Prospect, Zach Messinger gets the start tonight for Somerset. This season, Messinger is 5-8, with a 3.40 ERA over 24 games and 22 starts (132.1 IP, 107 H, 44 BB, 123 SO). Messinger last started on Aug. 22 at Portland and had a no-decision. He allowed one run over five innings, with three strikeouts and two walks. Against Reading this season, Messinger is 0-2, with a 4.50 ERA over three starts (16 IP, 13 H, 11 R, 8 ER, 8 BB, 14 SO). Messinger spent the bulk of last season with High-A Hudson Valley, but made one start with Somerset. Overall, Messinger was 1-10, with a 4.35 ERA over 22 games and 21 starts. The Yankees drafted Messinger in the 13th round of the 2021 draft out of Virginia, where he was teammates with former R-Phil Griff McGarry.

2024 Notes: Began season on Baltimore's High-A Aberdeen's Opening Day Roster. Made nine starts in 17 total appearances for IronBirds. Earned first win in second appearance on Apr. 14 against Wilmington. Went four-shutout innings out of bullpen and struck out six. Struck out season, and career-high, nine batters in season/High-A debut on Apr. 9 vs Wilmington. Walked six in no-decision at Hudson Valley on Apr. 20, where he lasted just three innings. Made final start with Aberdeen on July 27 at Jersey Shore. Traded to Phillies on July 30 and assigned to High-A Jersey Shore. Made BlueClaws debut Aug. 3 at Hudson Valley, took loss over 3.2 innings. Allowed three runs and struck out six. Earned second win of season in final High-A start Aug. 10 at Wilmington. Went season, and matched career-high, five innings, while allowing one run on three hits, and striking out seven in victory. Promoted to Double-A Reading Aug. 13. Earned win in first Double-A start Aug. 17 vs NH. Allowed one run over five innings and struck out six. Became second Reading pitcher to win Double-A debut in first start (Eiberson Castellano 7/21 at POR). Struck out career-high 10 hitters Aug. 24 at BNG, in just second Double-A start. Allowed two runs on one hit, with four walks, over 4.2 IP in no-decision.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by the Baltimore Orioles as an international free agent on July 2, 2019, out of Venezuela. Traded to the Philadelphia Phillies, along with Seth Johnson, in exchange for Gregory Soto on July 30, 2024.

2023 Notes: Spent entire season with Single-A Delmarva for second-straight year. Started in nine-of-21 appearances and struck out 100 over 68 innings, which was good for 13.24 strikeout-per-nine ratio. Was first season in pro career reaching 100 strikeouts and personal season-best. On 7-day IL from Aug. 1-24. Surrendered career-high eight walks on June 25 against Augusta. Pitched for Tigres de Aragua in offseason in Venezuelan Winter League, making one appearance and pitching one inning. Did not allow an earned run in the month of July (17.0 IP), as he also struck out 27 in month. Strong in second half of season, as he went 2-0, with 2.39 ERA (7 ER, 26.1 IP) over final eight appearances, compared to 5.83 ERA (27 ER, 41.2 IP) over first 13 outings of year. Held LHH to .182 (22-121) and RHH to .216 (25-116). Opponents hit just .173 against him with RISP (13-75) and .181 with runners on base (21-116).
