TODAY'S HEADLINES

Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 278-255 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints allowed four runs in the first inning, which Plutko faced nine batters in the first, allowed four runs on five hits, throwing 43 pitches in the inning. Trailing 7-0 in the seventh, Edouard Julien extended his on-base streak to 32 games with a bases-loaded walk, ending the shutout. Nick Wittgren allowed one run, picking up the bulk of the work by throwing 3.0 innings. Julien struck again in the ninth, clubbing a three-run home run to center field.

IN THE ZONE: Pitching has been at the forefront for the Saints for the last week, striking out 69 batters while issuing just 13 walks since July 30. The 13 walks issued since Tuesday are the fewest in Triple-A and tied for the fifth-fewest among full-season minor league teams. The Saints' 5.31 K/BB ratio is also the best in Triple-A and nearly two strikeouts better than the next-closest team (Salt Lake - 3.61). The 5.31 ratio since July 30 is the third-best among full-season clubs. The Saints' 2.66 K/BB ratio in 2024 is the best in Triple-A.

JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE: Edouard Julien has reached base in 32 consecutive games, riding the Saints' longest on-base streak this season. It is the second-longest franchise history trailing only Jake Cave's 49-game streak in 2022. It is the third-longest streak in the International League this season. During Julien's 32-game streak, he is hitting .274/.448/.436 (.884 OPS).

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 12th home run of the season on July 21 and the $43^{\rm rd}$ of his Saints career. He has tied Mark Contreras for the career franchise lead at 43 long balls. His 43 home runs since his Triple-A debut on July 17, 2022 are tied for the 10th-most in the International League.

Since the start of July, Williams has clubbed seven home runs, tied for the fifth-most in the International League. He also ranks among league leaders in that time with his .622 slugging percentage (3rd)19 runs (T-8th), his .993 OPS (T-9th) and 12 extra-base hits (T-9th).

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .418 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 21 of the 24 games he's played in, drawing 14 walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .443 across three levels. Of the three players ahead of him, only one has played in Triple-A.

When Saints Score 4+......47-20 SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 55 games since May 21, he has hit .337 (69-for-207), with 12 home runs, drawing 39 walks,
