Luisangel Acuña scored the go-ahead run on a passed ball in the ninth inning and the Frisco RoughRiders claimed a 6-4 win over the San Antonio Missions on Sunday at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. **Thomas Saggese** slammed a two-run home run in the fifth inning to tie the game and make it a three-RBI night for the 21-year-old. Frisco (2-3, 34-39) came back from a 4-1 deficit and did not allow a run to San Antonio (3-2, 40-34) after Daniel Johnson's go-ahead three-run home run in the third inning. Grant Wolfram (4-0) pitched the final two innings without a hit to collect the win for Frisco. James Bourque (0-1) allowed an earned run and an unearned run in the ninth to suffer the loss. **Jose Leclerc** began his rehab assignment with the RoughRiders on Sunday and pitched a perfect fifth inning, inducing two groundouts and a flyout. Back in the first inning, Acuña led off with an infield single and came home on Saggese's base hit to left field to lead 1-0. Down 4-1 in the fourth, the comeback began with a two-out rally when **Aaron Zavala** singled and **Kellen Strahm** brought him around on a double off the center field wall. Saggese then erased the rest of the deficit in the fifth inning on his two-run homer, blasting a ball to left field for his team-leading 11th long ball. That made it a 4-4 score, which remained unchanged until the ninth. Acuña walked with one out, got to third base on **Evan Carter**'s double, and sprinted home on a passed ball. Carter also touched home moments later when **Trevor Hauver** grounded a ball through the right side. Hauver pushed his hitting streak to 12 games by going 1-for-4 with a walk. After Leclerc pitched the fifth inning, **Michael Brewer** held San Antonio scoreless in the sixth. **Juan Mejia** delivered a hitless seventh inning and Wolfram went 1-2-3 in the eighth when the score was still tied. He did the same in the ninth once Frisco provided him a two-run cushion. Zavala went 2-for-4 and has reached base six out of nine times in his last two games in San Antonio.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 10 games since his return, he has five multi-hit games, batting .436 (17-for-39)/.489/.718/1.207 with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and nine runs scored. Carter is now fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.307), third in OBP (.420) and seventh in OPS (.870).

Trevor Hauver has been one of the best hitters for the RoughRiders recently. He is currently riding a 12-game hitting streak, batting .372 (16for-43)/.500/.512/1.012 with three doubles, one home run, five RBIs, seven runs scored, 11 walks and a steal

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .254, though Frisco is fourth with 283 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 16 games (7-9 record), Frisco is hitting .252 (37-for-147) in those situations.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak, Saggese hit .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks. Over his last 22 games, he is hitting .368/.451/.690/1.141 with seven home runs and 22 RBIs

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, second in the Texas League with a .583 average (14-for-24) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.558 OPS on the first pitch, which is second in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .460 (23-for-50) on the initial offering while his 23 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 33 and is on pace for a career-best 64 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 104 bases in 123 attempts (85 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)).

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 (85-for-281)/.363/.448/.811 through the first 65 games. In June, Acuña hit .300/.336/.460/.796. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (116).

On the season, Frisco's 354 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .353 team OBP is third in the Texas League. The Riders have four in the top seven players in Texas League walk rate this season: **Dustin Harris** (3rd, 15.8%), **Trevor Hauver** (5th, 15.6%), **Evan Carter** (6th, 15.2%) and Jax Biggers (7th, 15.2%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, Aaron Zavala is walking at a 17.0% rate so far this season.

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVIDshortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrines College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2023 SEASON

- -Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com.
- -When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.
- -Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.
- -Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

2022 SEASON

- -Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.
- -After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

- -After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.
- -Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
