Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Akron RubberDucks 5-2 in the series opener at Canal Park on Tuesday, backed by dominant pitching. Luis Moreno twirled five no-hit innings with nine strikeouts and just one walk. Marcel Rentería tossed a perfect frame before allowing the first Akron hit of the game in the seventh. Brandon McIlwain had two RBIs and Wyatt Young hit a two-run homer.

Master Moreno: RHP **Luis Moreno** threw five no-hit innings on Tuesday night against Akron. He issued just one walk and struck out nine batters. Moreno has now twirled three-straight dominant starts. Over his past three starts, the 24-year old is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA. In that span his line is: 18 IP, 11 H, 3 ER, 5 BB, 26 K, and a 57% ground ball rate. He has 19 strikeouts over 11 innings in his past two starts.

Big BMac: Outfielder **Brandon McIlwain** continues to swing a hot bat. Over his last 25 games, McIlwain is slashing .330/.394/.604/.998, with 30 hits, 10 doubles, five home runs, 23 RBIs, and 12 runs scored. He has drawn eight walks and struck out only 11 times over that span. The 25-year-old is currently riding a six-game hitting streak and nine-game on-base streak. McIlwain currently leads the team with 36 RBIs this season.

Out With the Old, In With the Young: Infielder **Wyatt Young** smashed his second home run of the season on Tuesday in the series opener at Akron, with a two-run shot to right field on a breaking ball. His first of the season was at New Hampshire on May 21. Young hit seven home runs last year, with six coming for Binghamton and one coming for Triple-A Syracuse. He has nine homers in his professional career.

Scott Shines: RHP **Christian Scott** shined in his Double-A debut on his 24th birthday in the second game of last Thursday's doubleheader against Portland. Scott got the win and threw a career-high six innings of one-run ball and tied his career high with nine strikeouts. He allowed just two hits without issuing a walk. He has registered a career-high nine strikeouts in each of his last two starts, with one coming for High-A Brooklyn. Over his past three starts overall, Scott has allowed two runs on six hits over 15 innings with 21 strikeouts and just two walks. He holds a 39-to-4 strikeout-to-walk ratio this season.

Last Start: Scott made his Double-A debut on his 24th birthday in the second game of the double-header last Thursday against Portland. He dazzled, tossing a career-high six innings and tying his career high with nine strikeouts, for the second-straight start. Scott allowed just one run on two hits, off a solo homer and did not issue a walk.

2022: Scott made 18 appearances and nine starts across two levels at Class-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn. He held a 3.80 ERA in his five starts and six appearances for the Cyclones last season. Across the two levels, Scott held a 77-to-22 K-to-BB ratio.

BACKGROUND: Scott was drafted by the Mets in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Florida. Scott made four starts for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League this past fall, alongside Rumble Ponies outfielder Brandon McIlwain and pitcher Mike Vasil. He currently ranks as the Mets' No. 27 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He totaled a 12-5 career record in 55 appearances and five starts with a 3.72 ERA, three saves, and 111 strikeouts across 121 innings pitched for the Gators across three seasons from 2019-2021. As a redshirt sophomore in 2021, Scott went made 26 appearances and one start going 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA and 51 strikeouts in 54 innings. He ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in appearances in 2021, leading the Gators. Led Calvary Christian Academy to the 2018 4A State Title in Floriday and was a First Team All-American selection by MaxPreps. Was a member of the USA Baseball 2016 17U National Team Development Program.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history.
