EXTRA INNINGS EXPLOSION: The Delmarva Shorebirds began the season 2-0 with a 15-8 win in extra innings on Friday night. After cruising to a 6-1 lead after seven and a half innings, but Red Sox rallied for five to tie the game in the bottom of eighth to even the game at six. The game would go to extras tied at seven but the Shore-birds offense dominated the extra frame by scoring eight runs with Jackson Holliday delivering a go-ahead two-run single, Samual Basallo hit a two-run homer, Creed Willems brought home a run with a double, Elio Prado had an RBI single, and Adam Crampton capped off the inning with a two-run double as the Shorebirds survived Salem's Friday night comeback.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: The opening series concludes as Boston's No. 24 prospect, Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz takes the ball again Juan De Los Santos for Delmarva.

BOUNCE BACK SEASON: 2022 was a rough campaign for the 'Birds who finished the season 49-81 overall, which was the worst overall record amongst teams in the Carolina League and third worst in all of Single-A (Stockton & Visalia, 45-87). The 2022 squad narrowly avoid being the least successful team in franchise history according to winning percentage as they just edged out the 2012 team that finished 52-86 (.376). However, the Shorebirds with plenty of fresh faces finished the 2022 regular season strong 15-12 in their final 27 game, which included a series victory of Down East in the final week of the regular season and taking 4 of 6 versus Lynchburg who finished as the runner-up in the Carolina League.

YOUNG MAN'S GAME: The debut roster for the Delmarva Shorebirds will showcase plenty of youth as the average of the team is 20.9 years-old.

HE'S #1: The number one pick in the 2022 draft, Jackson Holliday showed-out on Friday night with the top performance of his young career. Holliday collected four hits and four RBIs, both career-bests. His final two RBIs were timely on Friday night as it put the Shorebirds ahead for good. Holliday is now the No. 2 prospect in the Orioles farm system and No. 10 overall in MiLB according to MLB Pipeline.

WHAT ABOUT US?: The Delmarva Shorebirds opening day roster features three other prospects in addition to Jackson Holliday. Catcher Samuel Basallo will begin his first run at full-season baseball as the Orioles No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 15 by Baseball America suits up for the Shorebirds at just 18 years of age as he showcases big time power and a strong arm behind home plate. Two other infielders make the rankings as infielder Carter Young (No. 30 MLB Pipeline) and Anderson De Los Santos (No. 30 Baseball America) look to make impacts on both sides of the ball.

HITTING IS FUN: Delmarva's calling card to start 2023 has been their offense as they've score 26 runs on 26 hits thought the first two games of the season. In the series, the Shorebirds have 7 doubles and 4 home runs. Samuel Basallo has hit two of those home runs as he has driven three with a homer in the first two games of the season.

REMEMBER US?: There will be plenty of familiar faces on the Shorebirds Opening Day roster with 24 players who suited up at least once for Delmarva will be on the team to start the season.

WELCOME BACK FELIPE: Felipe Rojas Alou Jr. takes the helm for the second straight season in Delmarva as the team's manager. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization and he'll be joined by pitching coach Adam Bleday, Hitting Coach Josh Bunselmeyer, Fundamentals Coach Daniel Fajardo, Athletic Trainer Julio Ibarra, and Strength and Conditioning Coach Juan Sanchez.

LAST OUTING (8/18/22 @ SAL): The last time De Los Santos appeared was against the Red Sox at Salem Memorial Ballpark where he only recorded one out, allowing four runs (two unearned) with four walks. It would be the last game he would start in 2022

vs. SALEM: The Red Sox are no stranger to Juan De Los Santos as tonight will be his seventh start versus Boston's Single-A affiliate. The right-hander was 0-2 against Salem with a 6.52 ERA in 19.1 innings. De Los Santos threw a combined 11 innings with 14 strikeouts in his first two starts versus the Red Sox, but only covered 8.1 in his final four starts where he walked 13 batters, leading to 11 earned runs.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: 2022 was overall a nice season for De Los Santos as he established himself as one of the more consistent arms in the Delmarva rotation early in the season. The right-hander had a strong first two months of the season before a tough June where he had an ERA of 8.44 in five appearances. The length of his starts began to go down in July as he easily eclipsed his prior career high in innings thrown as he finished season with 79.2.

SHOREBIRDS COACHING STAFF

ELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

Returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH

Enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH

Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

DEVELOPMENT COACH

Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization. Prior to joining the Orioles, Murray worked with three other MLB clubs (Tigers, Marlins, and Angels), most recently as a Baseball Information Assistant with the Detroit Tigers in 2021.
