ABOUT LAST NIGHT: LHP **Nick Zwack** threw six more scoreless innings, taking a no-hitter into the fifth en route to Brooklyn's 6-1 victory over Hudson Valley to collect the first win of the week. Zwack went toe-to-toe with Renegades RHP **Blas Castano** who took a no-hitter of his own into the sixth. However, the Cyclones struck for four runs, knocking him out in the sixth inning. OF **Jaylen Palmer** started the rally with his team-leading seventh home run, INF **Shervyen Newton** drilled a two-run triple, and 1B **JT Schwartz** singled in a run. RHP **Grant Hartwig** saved his seventh game, tying for the league lead.

JUNE BUGS: LHP **Nick Zwack** allowed one earned run in June, tossing 25 innings and posting a 0.36 ERA. 1B **JT Schwartz** led the team with 37 total bases, hitting .299. OF **Jaylen Palmer** hit three home runs.

METS-YANKS: Brooklyn faces Hudson Valley 30 times this season, having already played 15 times. The Renegades have won eight of the 15 games. The Cyclones are hitting just .163 with a .287 on-base percentage against the Renegades over 14 games with a 32% strikeout rate. Against the rest of the league, the Cyclones are hitting .220 with a .312 on-base percentage with a 25% strikeout rate.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 31 home runs in the past 38 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

THE GRANT POOBAH: RHP **Grant Hartwig** earned his seventh save of the year last night which is tied with three other players for the league lead. Hartwig is a perfect seven for seven in saves and owns a

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees farm club has won eight of the 15 games so far with 15 head-to-head games remaining. The Renegades host seven of the Yankees' Top 30 prospects, including a trio of Top 10 prospects: No. 6 SS Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, and No. 10 OF Everson Pereira. The Renegades are managed by first-year skipper Tyson Blaser.

staff-best 42% strikeout rate. The undrafted free agent and former Miami RedHawks pitcher has allowed just one run in 14 1/3 innings.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms posted a 3.49 earned run average in 29 games with 16 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

MURPHY'S NEW LAW: OF **Tanner Murphy** has been on a tear since June began, going 14-48 (.292) with a double, triple, and two home runs -- good for an .479 slugging percentage over the stretch and an .837 OPS. Murphy is hitting .244 over 29 games with Brooklyn this year. Last year, Murphy hit just .181 through 23 High-A games.

FIVE MILLION: This past home series against Jersey Shore, Catherine Bruning was celebrated as the five-millionth fan. The Cyclones crossed over the plateau into 5,000,000 on Friday night.

SECOND HALF START: Thursday, June 24th, marked the start of the second half of the season in the South Atlantic League. Brooklyn finished the first half 30-36. Aberdeen won the North Division, while Bowling Green won the South. The final 66 games of the season determine the next two teams to make the playoffs.

BRYANT IS BACK: Bryant returns to the mound tonight, having thrown back-to-back quality starts.

AS STARTER: Bryant has started six games, posting a 3.90 ERA with a 24% strikeout rate and a 6% walk rate.

AS RELIEVER: Coming on as a piggybacker, Bryant has pitched in relief six times, posting a 3.63 ERA with a 23% strikeout rate and a 9% walk rate.

2021: Bryant spent 2021 with the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, breaking camp with the team in May. He made two starts before tearing his oblique in May. Did not pitch again until mid-August with the FCL Mets. Made one appearance with the Cyclones in September, allowing a career-high four home runs against Hudson Valley on September 8th.

2019 SEASON: Bryant put his name on the radar in 2019, leading the Cyclones pitching staff to a New York Penn League Championship over the Lowell Spinners. That season, Bryant was named to the mid-season All-Star team. Bryant struck out 75 batters in 75 innings and pitched a pair of seven-inning games for the Cyclones.

MAN, YOU MOVE: Bryant grew up in Deerfield, New Hampshire but moved to and grew up in the Clearwater, FL area. Bryant now makes his home in Saratoga Springs, NY.
