DE LEON AND CHACE SHUTOUT RIVERDOGS: The Delmarva Shorebirds evened the series with the Charleston RiverDogs on Wednesday behind a pitching masterpiece put together by **Luis De Leon** and **Moises Chace**. De Leon made his Shorebirds debut as the starter and the southpaw shined as he did now allow any runs, giving up just one hit with three strikeouts. With the game tied at zero in the sixth, **Samuel Basallo** broke the tie with an RBI triple with two outs to score **Stiven Acevedo. Carter Young** doubled the Delmarva lead to 2-0 in the eighth with an RBI single. After De Leon departed on the mound after four innings, **Moises Chace** took the baton from him and took the Shorebirds to the finish line by tossing his best outing of the season as he did not allow a run across 5 innings, striking out 8 with no walks to complete a 2-0 shutout victory over Charleston.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Juan De Los Santos gets the ball for game three and he'll square off with **Trevor Martin** for the RiverDogs. Martin enters Thursday's start as the No. 30 prospect for Tampa Bay per MLB Pipeline. He'll be making his 15th start of the season and his second against Delmarva, last facing them on May 19 where he allowed 7 runs on 6 hits in 4.2 innings. However, Martin has been hot lately as he's earned a winning decision in his last four starts. He has 26 strikeouts and just 3 walks during current four-game stretch on the mound.

BACK LIKE HE NEVER LEFT: Trendon Craig has had an instant impact for the for the Shorebirds since rejoining the team on June 9 after two months on the IL. In 22 games since returning, Craig is slashing .329/.433/.519 with 10 extra-base hits, 13 RBI, and 11 stolen bases. Craig has reached base safely in 26 of 28 games with the Shorebirds and has multiple hits in 11 of his 28 games with Delmarva. His 16-game on-base streak that was snapped on June 23 is the longest by a Shorebirds hitter this season.

BLAZING BASALLO: Samuel Basallo is currently in one of his hottest stretches this season. Since June 18, Basallo is batting .333 with 7 home runs and 17 RBI. During his current run, he was named the Carolina League Player of the Week for June 20-25 versus Augusta, featuring a game where he went yard twice, his second multi-homer game of his career. He also hit the first grand slam of the season for the Shorebirds on July 2, helping Delmarva edge Lynchburg 4-1.

HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo has come out of the All-Star break hot as he has a hit in five straight games. He has especially thrived batting in the leadoff spot in his last four starts as he has three multi-hit games while scoring four runs, and stealing three bases in that short span.

HEATING UP AT THE HOT CORNER: Third basemen **Anderson De Los Santos** has begun find his stride at the plate. After picking up a walk-off hit in extra innings against Augusta on June 24, De Los Santos is batting .273 in his last 15 games with 6 extra base hits and 7 RBI. The 19 year old is batting .308 during the month of July with 4 multi-hit games.

FEELING YOUNG: Carter Young continues to swing the bat well as he enters Thursday's game versus Charleston with a 12-game hitting streak, the longest by a Shorebirds player this season. Young also maintains a great ability to get on-base as he leads the team in walks with 42 along with an OBP of .364 since May 12.

FROM THE BOTTOM TO THE TOP: The Shorebirds return home to face the Charleston RiverDogs. Both teams finished the first half at the bottom of their respective divisions and now they enter the series as the current division front runners. Delmarva will look to get revenge on Charleston as they dropped four of six games at the Joe in May. This is the RiverDogs first trip to Perdue Stadium since July 29 of 2019 when both clubs were members of the South Atlantic League.

TODAY'S STARTER: Juan De Los Santos gets the start for the Shorebirds in game three against the Charleston RiverDogs.

LAST OUTING (7/14 @ SAL): De Los Santos last pitched in the first game following the All-Star break as a reliever against the Salem Red Sox. He pitched 3 innings and allowed 4 runs on 5 hits. Three of the four runs De Los Santos allowed occurred in the first inning he pitched in, which was the fourth frame.

vs. CHARLESTON: This will be the second time this season De Los Santos will pitch against Charleston and the last time he faced them, he delivered one of his best outings of the season on May 17 as he tossed five, no-hit innings. He allowed just three base runners on a walk and two hit batters and he went on to earn win in 6-4 victory as he finished the game.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: 2022 was overall a nice season for De Los Santos as he established himself as one of the more consistent arms in the Delmarva rotation early in the season. The right-hander had a strong first two months of the season before a tough June where he had an ERA of 8.44 in five appearances. The length of his starts began to go down in July as he easily eclipsed his prior career high in innings thrown as he finished season with 79.2.

SPECIAL K: Despite a 1-6 record this season, Juan De Los Santos has quietly put together a strong season for the Shorebirds. The right-hander was the victim of some tough defense as he allowed 12 runs in June but only 3 of them were earned. 13 total unearned runs have scored against De Los Santos this season, which is the most of any pitcher on the staff.
