The Round Rock Express and Tacoma Rainiers (Seattle Mariners) will play the series final of their six-game set on Sunday at Dell Diamond. First pitch is slated for 6:05 p.m. CT.

EXPRESS BOUNCE BACK

The Express beat the Rainiers, 15-4, on Saturday. Round Rock RF Billy McKinney belted a leadoff homer. LF Trevor Hauver, 3B Alan Trejo and DH Konner Pottot recorded RBI singles to put the E-Train ahead 5-0 after one. The Express plated three in the third on RBI singles from CF Kellen Strahm, SS Richie Martin and McKinney extending the lead to 8-0. Tacoma 1B Tyler Locklear belted a solo homer in the top of the sixth to put the Rainiers on the board. In the bottom of the frame, Hauver drove Martin in with a single to make it 9-1. The Rainiers got a run back in the top of the seventh on LF Jacob Hurtubise's sacrifice fly, cutting their deficit to 9-2. Round Rock tallied five more in the bottom of the seventh. Martin recorded a RBI single and a 3B Austin Shenton fielding error allowed two more to score. Hauver and Trejo hit back-to-back RBI singles to give the E-Train a 14-2 lead. Strahm belted a homer in the bottom of the eighth, tacking on another run. Tacoma 2B Samad Taylor drove two runs in with a double in the ninth, but Round Rock could not be caught in Saturday's 15-4 final.

ABBOTT ON THE MOUND

Round Rock RHP Cory Abbott is scheduled for his ninth game and eighth start for the Express. Abbott has made it past 4.0 innings in four of his eight appearances. The 28-year-old has 32 strikeouts in 27.1 innings with 15 walks. He was second round selection by the Chicago Cubs in 2017.

SEARCHING FOR THE SERIES

The Express can win the series over Tacoma with a victory tonight. It would be Round Rock's first series victory since April 15-20 at Reno and their first home series win since April 1-6 against Toledo. The E-Train are 2-4-7 in series play this year.

LET THEM COOK

Over the last four games, Round Rock is averaging 12.0 runs per game on an average of 15.3 hits per game. They have hit nine home runs which is tied with Omaha for the most in all of Triple-A in that span. In June among Triple-A clubs, the E-Train are fifth in batting average (.288) and runs scored (178), fourth in on-base percentage (.383) and sixth in slugging percentage (.470).

TACOMA CAN'T STOP TREJO

In the last four games, Round Rock INF Alan Trejo is 8-for-17 with a double, three home runs, 11 RBI, seven runs scored, two walks and three strikeouts. Since 2021, Trejo has appeared in 19 games against Tacoma and is hitting .379 (28-for-71) with six doubles, nine home runs, 24 RBI, 17 runs scored, seven walks and 16 strikeouts.

ON-BASE STREAKS

OF Trevor Hauver owns a 21-game on-base streak. It is the fifth-longest active streak in the PCL. During the streak, he is hitting .312/.426/.468/.894 with four doubles, a triple, two homers, 14 RBI, 15 runs scored, 13 walks and 23 strikeouts. 1B Blaine Crim also owns a 17-game on-base streak.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
