### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox were shut out for the ninth time this season in a 5-0 loss to Altoona on Friday night. Starting right-hander **Seth Johnson** took the loss after lasting just 0.2 inning with four consecutive walks. Two sacrifice flies and two wild pitches plated home the other four runs for the Curve, who have now won three in a row. **Cody Scroggins** made his Bowie debut and went 2.1 innings of relief. **Dan Hammer** punched out a season-high five batters over three scoreless innings.

### BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 23 of his last 25 games dating back to May 21. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the fourth-longest in the Eastern League. Since May 21, the 19-year-old is slashing .323/.387/.939 with five homers and 17 RBI. He is currently tied for the fourth-most hits (67) in the Eastern League and the ninth-most in all of Double-A.

### RHODES IS ROLLING

In the month of June, OF/1B **John Rhodes** is batting a team-high .327 with a team-leading 15 RBI after going 2-for-4 with a two RBI on Thursday night, including the game-tying hit in the 10th to send the game to the 11th. The Orioles No. 23 prospect has 11 hits and nine RBI over his last six games.

### WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** has made quite a first impression since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on June 11. Etzel has collected a hit in seven of nine games played for the Baysox thus far and has five stolen bases. His 36 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is third most in all of MiLB. He is the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of Southern Miss.

### THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is second among active Eastern League players in home runs (12). Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three last week in Harrisburg. On Thursday night, Fabian reached base five times and drove in four RBI, his seventh career 4+ RBI game. He's hitting .249 through 56 games after hitting just .176 in 64 AA games last season.

### YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** makes his 14th start of the season for the Baysox and his second against Altoona this year. The Orioles No. 24 prospect is coming off two strong starts in Harrisburg last week. In his first start against the Senators on June 11, he earned the win with his first scoreless start of the season with six shutout innings and six strikeouts. In his next start on Father's Day Sunday, Pham struck out a season-high eight batters over five innings and limited the damage, allowing three runs on six hits to pick up the win. This is Pham's fourth career start against Altoona.

### ASSESSING ALTOONA

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve sit in last place in the Southwest Division at 24-39 on the season. However, the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates has won their last four in a row and eight of their last 10, including back-to-back series victories over Richmond and Erie. Altoona's roster includes six of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26)

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Thomas Harrington makes his seventh start of the season for Altoona. The Pirates No. 5 prospect started the season on the injured list but after a brief rehab assignment in Single-A Bradenton, he was activated on May 12. The 22-year-old most recently threw five scoreless innings with five strikeouts and allowed just one hit on Sunday vs Erie in a no-decision. Harrington has walked only two batters all year over 31.2 innings pitched. The 36th overall pick in the 2022 draft is in his first season at the Double-A level.

**2024:** Struck out season-high 8 batters over 5.0 IP across 6 H, 3 R and 1 BB to record win on Sun. 6/16 @ HBG. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Baysox have won eight of last nine games that Pham has started in. Has struck out 6+ batters in five of last six starts. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

**2023:** Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

**2022:** Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

**2021:** Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

**Personal:** Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach
