FIRED-UP FREDDY: C **Freddy Fermin** hit another home run last night, now with five during the month of August. His most home runs in a single month prior to August was two in April and July. Fermin has earned a hit in nine consecutive games, looking to become the fourth Storm Chaser to reach the 10-game hit-streak benchmark this season. He is also riding a 17-game on-base streak the fourth longest active on-base streak in the International League. Fermin is slashing .348/.427/.667 with a one-to-one walk-to-strikeout ratio with nine walks and nine strikeouts in 18 games this month.

CHASING HISTORY: OF **Brewer Hicklen** has reached base safely in 26 consecutive games, the second longest active streak in the International League. Hicklen is already in possession of the longest on-base streak on the team this season and is now chasing the longest by an Omaha Storm Chaser. His streak is the sixth longest in the Storm Chasers era (since 2011), needing to add one more game to tie OF **Paulo Orlando's** 27-game streak from 2018 as the fifth longest. The longest on-base streak by a Storm Chaser belongs to OF **Travis Snider** who played for Omaha in 2016, earning a 30-game on-base streak during his 85 games with the Omaha that season.

THIEVES: Omaha leads the International League in stolen bases this season with 147, while Buffalo has the second most with 146. The Storm Chasers also hold the best stolen base percentage in the league at .860. OF **Dairon Blanco** is tied with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's Estevan Florial for the most steals with 35. OF **Brewer Hicklen** has swiped 25 bases, the eighth most in the International League.

LAUNCHING HOMERS: The Storm Chasers have hit a home run in a season-best nine consecutive games, dating back to August 14 against Toledo. Omaha has hit 15 home runs during that span, off the bats of seven different hitters. The Chasers hit one home run in each of the first six games but have hit three homers in each of the last three games. C **Freddy Fermin** has hit a team-best four homers since August 14 while OF **Brewer Hicklen's** three home runs in that span are second most.

WALK IT OUT: Omaha has drawn a walk in each of the last 73 games, the second longest active streak and the fifth longest streak overall in the International League this season. The Storm Chasers have had 468 walks this season, with OF **Brewer Hicklen** leading the active roster at 49. INF **Nick Pratto** still leads the team with 51 walks but hasn't played a Triple-A game in more than a month.

20-20-20 VISION: OF **Brewer Hicklen** is closing in on a season that has not been accomplished with Triple-A Omaha during the modern franchise era (since 2005). He needs just two more doubles to have 20 doubles, 20 home runs, and 20 steals in a single season for Omaha. INF **Bobby Witt Jr.** accomplished the feat last year between Double-A Northwest Arkansas and Triple-A Omaha. Hicklen has 23 home runs, tied for fourth in the International League while his 71 RBIs come in at seventh.

FOR OMAHA: RHP **Jackson Kowar** toes the rubber to make his 17th start for the Storm Chasers this season. In his last start, Kowar snapped a seven-game winless streak (0-5) with a 5.0-inning start at Louisville on Saturday to earn his first win since May 25. In the game, Kowar allowed just one earned run on one hit with three walks and three strikeouts. Saturday's start was his longest outing since June 21, having spent the end of June and all of July in The Show with Kansas City. Kowar holds a 9.77 ERA for the Royals this season in seven relief appearances. Left-handed batters have a lower batting average (.235) compared to right-handed batters (.292) against Kowar. Despite having 35 fewer at bats, lefties have hit more home runs (seven) and doubles (five) than righties (four home runs and three doubles).

FOR SCRANTON/WILKES-BARRE: RHP **Mitch Spence** takes the ball to make his fifth start for the RailRiders. Spence, in his last start, went 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and three walks with three strikeouts in his first career Triple-A win at St. Paul. The 24-year-old started the season with Double-A Somerset, going 3-5 with a 5.24 ERA in 15 starts and two relief appearances for the Patriots. In his lone road start for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Spence allowed a .100 batting average. Overall, Spence is allowing opponents to hit .247 with a 1.27 WHIP.

KOWAR NOTES

- Went 4.0 no-hit innings on 8/9 at TOL, striking out eight with no walks
- Began 2022 season with Kansas City, allowing seven runs on 11 hits in 3.1 innings in relief appearance on April 10 vs. Cleveland, a game the Royals eventually lost, 17-3
- Made 16 career MLB appearances (eight starts), recording an 0-6 record with a 10.76 ERA in 46.0 innings with 46 strikeouts and 31
- Named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Year in 2021 in addition to earning Triple-A Postseason All-Star honors as the top right-handed pitcher in the league, Paul Splittorff Pitcher of the Year in the Kansas City Royals organization, and Omaha Pitcher of the Year
