SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

WHY DO WE LIKE HIM? HE GETS ON BASE: Entering today, INF Tyler Black and INF Zavier Warren have both reached base in 10 straight games, the longest on-base streak by any Shuckers player in 2023... Over that span, Black has a .452 OBP... Black has also drawn nine walks, the second-most by any Shuckers player over that span... Black is one of two Shuckers, along with INF Noah Campbell, to have drawn more walks than strikeouts this season... Warren is slashing .294/.400/.471 over his on-base streak, including three extra-base hits and six walks.

DOUBLING UP: Today's doubleheader marks the second straight series in which the Shuckers have played a doubleheader... The Shuckers split a doubleheader with Pensacola in their last series... The Shuckers won game one 6-4 after four runs in the sixth inning, but lost game two 6-2.

STARTING OFF HOT: Through 12 games, the Shuckers starting pitching staff has been lights out to the tune of a 3.79 staff ERA, 12.8 strikeouts per nine and a .205 opponent's batting average... The staff enters today with 81 strikeouts, tied for second-highest total in Double-A behind the Chattanooga Lookouts [96]... The Shuckers, Lookouts and Pensacola Blue Wahoos are the only three Double-A teams with at least 80 strikeouts from the starting staff... Four different Southern League teams make up the top-five.

CAMPBELL'S FIRST: When INF Noah Campbell launched a home run to right in the second inning of Thursday's game, it was his first of the 2023 season with the Shuckers... The homer was Campbell's eighth in professional baseball since signing with the Brewers as an undrafted free agent in 2020... Last year, Campbell smashed two home runs while playing in just 60 games due to injuries... The home run was his first since June 10, 2022 against the Tennessee Smokies.

TODAY'S GAME ONE STARTER // RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ [0-1, 1.00]: The Brewers' 12th-ranked prospect, RHP Carlos Rodriguez, makes his third Double-A start after allowing one earned run over five innings against Pensacola last time out... Today marks his first start against an Angels affiliate in his career... In his only road start of the year, Rodriguez struck out eight over four scoreless innings against Mississippi... Right-handed batters are hitless against him in eight at-bats, while lefties are 4-23 (.174) with eight strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME TWO STARTER // RHP JUSTIN JARVIS [0-1, 2.45]: RHP Justin Jarvis looks to continue his dominant form this season in his third start... In two starts last series against Pensacola, Jarvis allowed three runs in 11.0 innings and struck out 13... Right-handed batters are 1-13 (.077) against him, while left-handed batters are 6-25 (.240) with 10 strikeouts... In his first start during the Shuckers home opener, he struck out eight over six scoreless innings... Jarvis enters today with a 2.61 career ERA in six Double-A starts.
