NEW YORK METS TRIPLE-A AFFILIATE

WEST ON I-90: The Syracuse Mets are on the road for the second time this season and play their first series of the year against the Buffalo Bisons, the Triple-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays.

The Mets opened the 2026 season on the road, taking two out of three on opening weekend at Worcester.

LAST SERIES RECAP: Syracuse split their first six-game series of the season against Toledo to open play at NBT Bank Stadium this year. The Mets took the Wednesday contest and then won back-to-back on Saturday and Sunday, highlighted by a walk-off home run with two strikes and two outs in the ninth by Jackson Cluff on Easter Sunday.

With a minimum of 10 at-bats, seven Mets hit over .300 during the week. Jackson Cluff led the Mets, going 6-for-16 (.375). Jihwan Bae went 6-for-17 (.353), and Ronny Mauricio and Nick Morabito both went 7-for-20 (.350). As a team, Syracuse was fourth in the International League in AVG (.298) and eighth in OPS (.838) in the six-game series against Toledo.

Hayden Senger hit three home runs during the series, the most on the team, including two home runs on Wednesday. The catcher also paced the Mets in RBI (3).

LAST TIME OUT: Syracuse dropped both games of a doubleheader to begin the series at Buffalo. The Mets lost the first game 2-0 and the second game 4-2.

In game one, SP Jack Wenninger tossed 4.1 innings and recorded five strikeouts. In game two, SP Jonah Tong pitched five innings and retired the final 13 batters he faced. The Mets top pitching prospect tossed 5.0 IP, allowed 1 H, 2 R (1 2-R HR), 2 BB and recorded 7 K. Buffalo's Yohendrick Pinango cracked a two-run homer in the sixth inning to give the Bisons the win.

SCOTT START: RHP Christian Scott is slated to make his second start of the season on Thursday against Buffalo. The 26-year-old started on April 3 vs. TOL, his first appearance since 7/21/24 @MIA.

RELIEVERS ON A ROLL: Through the first two series of the season, Syracuse's bullpen is tied for first in the International League in SV (4), fifth in K/BB (1.52) and tied for sixth in K (50). Entering play on Tuesday, the Mets' relievers are responsible for five wins this season, tied for the second-most in the IL, and are one of two bullpens in the league to not have a loss tagged to their record (Memphis, 5-0).

YOUNG ROSTER: The Syracuse Opening Day roster features six Top-30 Prospects: Tong (2), Clifford (4), Wenninger (6), Morabito (12), Lambert (17), Pintaro (21). 18 of 28 players on the roster have big league experience with 1,889 total major league games combined (2,214 MLB games on last year's Opening Day roster, 4,240 MLB games in 2024).
