TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - The St. Paul Saints lost a pitcher's duel on Sunday afternoon at Sahlen Field 2-1 to the Buffalo Bisons. Mario Sanchez was brilliant going 6.0 innings allowing two runs on three hits while striking out six. Jake Cave scored the lone run for the Saints with an opposite field home run to left, his seventh of the season. Evan Sisk and Drew Strotman each threw 1.0 scoreless inning of relief.

TWO WEEK EXCURSIONS: The St. Paul Saints return home from their fourth, two-week roadtrip in franchise history. They split a six-game series against Columbus and lost four of six to the Buffalo Bisons. Here is how their roadtrip stacked up against the previous three.

HOMETOWN HEROES: The St. Paul Saints return home from their two-week roadtrip to the friendly confines of CHS Field where they have won their last seven games. The Saints won the last game of the homestand against the Indianapolis Indians on May 29 and then swept a six-game series against the Rochester Red Wing from June 7-12. The seven game win streak is a franchise best. Last season, the Saints won five in a row from July 17-29 beating Columbus twice and Indianapolis three times.

THE GAUNTLET: The St. Paul Saints finished up of perhaps the most difficult three-week stretch for any team in the International League. They faced the Rochester Red Wings at CHS Field from June 7-12, the Columbus Clippers at Huntington Park from June 14-19, and the Buffalo Bisons at Sahlen Field from June 21-26. At the time the Saints played each of those teams the Red Wings had the best record in the league at 35-19, the Clippers were tied for the second best record in the International League at 35-25, and Buffalo had the third best record in the International League at 37-28. That's a total of 107-72, a .598 win percentage. The Saints swept the Red Wings split against the Clippers and lost four of six to Buffalo (all by one run) and are finished 11-7 during the stretch.

QUALITY OVER QUANTITY: Mario Sanchez pitched an outstanding game on Sunday throwing 6.0 innings allowing just two runs. It was the third quality start by Sanchez this season and just the fourth by a Saints pitcher this season. Sanchez had back-to-back quality starts on May 26 vs. Indianapolis and June 2 @ Iowa. Chi Chi González tossed a quality start on May 11 @ Columbus. The Saints, however, are just 2-2 when a starter throws a quality start.

START ME UP: Aaron Sanchez worked 5.0 innings on June 25 at Buffalo allowing three runs. In the top of the sixth the Saints scored two runs to take the lead and Sanchez was lifted in the bottom of the sixth as the pitcher of record. The Saints went on to win and Sanchez earned the victory. It was just the sixth win by a Saints starter this season. Those six wins are the fewest among starters in Triple-A tied for 11th in all of Minor League Baseball among 120 teams. Three teams starters have four wins: Visalia Rawhide, Rancho Cucamonga Quakes and Great Lakes Loons and three teams starters have five wins: Columbia Fireflies, Daytona Tortugas, and Delmarva Shorebirds.

HEL(MAN) ON THE BASES: Michael Helman hasn't been with the St. Paul Saints for long, but he is showcasing his speed on the basepaths. He stole another base on Sunday at Buffalo, giving him 10 stolen bases in just 24 games. Royce Lewis, who set the franchise record for steals in a season earlier this year, stole 12 bases in 34 games.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME (PLATE): On April 19 the St. Paul Saints were blanked 11-0 at the Toledo Mud Hens. Since then, the Saints have scored at least one run in 59 consecutive games, tied for the longest active streak in Triple-A (Worcester), tied for the longest overall in Triple-A (Salt Lake 59), tied for the fourth longest overall and active streak in all of Minor League Baseball. Active streaks that are longer: Rome (69), Fort Myers (66), and Myrtle Beach (59).

AND THEN THERE WERE SIX: The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final six, but not a final six they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only six Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the Charlotte Knights in the International League, the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies and Delmarva Shorebirds in the Carolina League, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.24 ERA in the second lowest of the six teams. Chattanooga's ERA in 5.03.

S-CAVE-NGING FOR BASES: Jake Cave homered in his first at bat on Sunday to extend his streak of reaching base safely to 41 consecutive games. During the streak, which began on May 3, he has a hit in 32 of the 41 games and in the nine games he has failed to collect a hit, he has drawn at least one walk. It's the longest streak in franchise history, topping the 20 consecutive by Jimmy Kerrigan last season. It's the second longest streak in Minor League Baseball this season. The longest streak is 51 consecutive games by Luke Berrihoff of Corpus Christi from April 14-June 21. The last time Cave didn't reach base was a five inning game on April 30 against the Nashville Sounds when he went 0-2.

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The St. Paul Saints have played 71 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 63 consecutive games, third longest in all of Minor League Baseball. The other two are also active (El Paso-72 & Biloxi - 64). The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

JUNE BOOM: The St. Paul Saints continue to destroy the baseball in June. After hitting just 19 home runs in April, tied for 60th in Minor League Baseball and 29 home runs in the month of May, tied for 40th in all of Minor League Baseball, they have clobbered 44 home runs in 23 June games, second among the 150 teams in Minor League Baseball, behind Albuquerque's 52, and tied for fourth best in all of baseball including the 30 Major League teams. The New York Yankees have hit 52, the Atlanta Braves have hit 48, and the Toronto Blue Jays have 44.

TWINS UPDATE - In game one of a series between the top two teams in the Central Division, the Minnesota Twins dismantled the Cleveland Guardians 11-1. Gary Sánchez, Carlos Correa, and Nick Goheen all homered with Sánchez collecting three hits and four RBI. Alex Kirilloff went 3-3 and Gio Urshela was 3-5. Sonny Gray was brilliant going 7.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out three. Mark Contreras collected his first Major League hit.

A ROSE BY ANY OTHER NAME: Going by ones middle names is a common theme with this St. Paul Saints team. Dereck Rodriguez joins the middle name club. His given name is Ivan Dereck Rodriguez.

SON OF PUDGE: If you think the name Ivan Rodriguez sounds like a baseball players name, it should. Dereck's father is Hall of Fame catcher Ivan "Pudge" Rodriguez. Pudge played 21 seasons in the Major Leagues (1991-2002, 2009 with Texas, 2003 with Florida, 2004-08 with Detroit, 2008 with the Yankees, 2009 with Houston, and 2010-11 with Washington). He was a 14x All-Star, won 13 Gold Gloves, and won a World Series with the Marlins in 2003. On top of that he caught Kenny Rogers' perfect game with the Rangers in 1997. He was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 2017.

SHOULDN'T YOU BE A CATCHER: If your Dad is a Hall of Fame Catcher one would think you would grow up being a catcher too. For Dereck, he did start off his high school career at Monsignor Edward Pace (FL) HS as a catcher. Unfortunately, he didn't love the position and transitioned to the outfield. One of the other reasons he made the transition is he had a growth spurt in high school that vaulted him to 6'1 which made it uncomfortable to crouch.

I'M BATMAN: Dereck is a huge fan of Batman. He's such a big fan that he has a Batman tattoo on his right forearm. The tattoo's didn't stop there. He has since added a tattoo of The Joker, Catwoman, and Harley Quinn

IF YOU CAN'T BEAT THEM, JOIN THEM: From starting as a catcher in high school to being a converted outfielder, Dereck Rodriguez turned that into an 6th round selection out of high school. Unfortunately, hitting became an issue for Rodriguez. He hit just .216 with six homers and 37 RBI across 2017 games between the GCL and Rookie Elizabethton from 2011-13. The Twins then transitioned him into a pitcher and his career has since taken off.

SON OF PUDGE MEET KUNG FU PANDA: Once Rodriguez became a free agent, he decided to sign with the San Francisco Giants in 2018. The greatest influence was one Pablo Sandoval. The two were working out together during the offseason in Miami and Sandoval told him signing with the Giants would be a good fit.

DIDN'T YOU USED TO BE A HITTER: From high school position player, to 6th round draft pick, to transitioning into a pitcher after three professional seasons because he struggled at the plate to...collecting a base hit in your first Major League at bat. That's right. In his Major League debut on May 29, 2018 in Colorado he promptly doubled in his second at bat off Kyle Freeland. Since then, he's collected just seven more hits and is hitting .131 (8-61) in his career.

- Has been part of four different MLB organizations (Minnesota - 2011-17, San Francisco - 2018-20, Detroit - 2020 and Colorado - 2021)
- Made his first career Opening Day roster for San Francisco in 2019
- Named to the Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team in 2018
- Made his major league debut May 29 at Colorado and finished the season second in ERA (2.81), third in opponent batting average (.223), sixth in innings pitched (118.1), eighth in starts (19) and ninth in strikeouts (89) among qualifying National League rookies
- His 2.81 ERA (118.1 IP, 37 ER) was the lowest by a Giants rookie pitcher (min. 100.0 IP) since Hall of Famer Hoyt Wilhelm (2.43) in 1952 and the seventh lowest among NL pitchers on the season (min. 100.0 IP)
- Became the first Giants pitcher since 1900 to pitch six-or-more innings and allow two-or-fewer runs in at least 13 of his first 16 career starts (June 3-Sept. 10, 2018)
- Made nine consecutive starts of six-or-more innings and two-or-fewer runs from June 14-Aug. 24, 2018...became the third rookie pitcher in major league history to make nine such starts consecutively since 1958 (also: Joe Blanton, 2005 and Mike Fiers, 2012)
- Was 2017 Florida State League Midseason All-Star with High-A Fort Myers
- Led the Appalachian League in innings pitched (66.1 IP), while ranking fourth in strikeouts (61) and sixth in ERA (2.85)
- Named 2015 Appalachian League Pitcher of the Year and was name a Postseason All-Star
- Converted to a relief pitcher in 2014 after spending three years as an outfielder (2011-13) and didn't allow a run over his first 11 appearances (17.0 IP). Finished the season 2-2, 1.05 ERA (25.2 IP, 3 ER) with five saves, eight walks and 19 strikeouts across 17 relief appearances
