LONG VOYAGE: After winning an extra-inning thriller in the road trip opener last night in Charleston, the FredNats will try to win their 20th game of the season tonight in game two against the three-time defending league champion RiverDogs. Pitching prospect Travis Sykora gets his second professional start of his career tonight looking to bounce back from a rocky first outing where he allowed two earned runs in two-plus innings pitched. He faces Charleston righty Santiago Suarez, who has been one of many RiverDog starting pitchers off to a strong start this year. Last night, the FredNats improved to 3-0 in extra-innings with two of those wins coming on the road.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Fredgies scored first on back-to-back two out RBIs from Marcus Brown and the rehabbing Jeremy De La Rosa, and the game was tied 3-3 after nine. Then, Brenner Cox detonated his second homer of the season into the teeth of the wind in the 10th, and the Fredgies turned a game-ending double play in the bottom of the 10th to hold on for a 5-4 win in the series opener.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are a perfect 14-0 this season when scoring first, including all five wins two weeks ago against Delmarva, all four wins last week over Down East, and the series opener last night with Charleston.

CONTINUED: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 19 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .256 with RISP, compared to .091 in losses. The Fredgies went 2-for-17 with RISP on Sunday, and left 14 men on base in a two-run loss, but then bounced back last night in Charleston to go 2-for-5 with RISP in a one-run win.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in the Carolina League. In 151.2 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 38 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.25. The Fredgies are also 10/11 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League and tied with High-A Wilmington's Todd Peterson for most saves in Minor League Baseball with six. The team is 14-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 16-0 when leading after eight innings this year.

HARDWARE: Last Friday, Brandon Pimentel became the first FredNat position player in franchise history to win a Player of the Month honor when Major League Baseball announced him as the Carolina League Player of the Month for April. His 33 RBIs in April was more than anyone in Minor League or Major League Baseball, and he's top five in the Carolina League in OPS, slugging, total bases, extra-base hits and obviously RBI. The 23-year-old undrafted free agent from El Paso, TX is making his full-season debut in professional baseball this season, and has made a huge splash in his first month of the season. Pimentel is currently tied for second in all of MiLB in RBI with 34.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 160-129 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Travis Sykora is making his second professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Charleston RiverDogs.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

QUICK CLIMBER: Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during last week's series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Sykora's pro debut last week was a mixed bag as he flashed the elite stuff with his mid 90's fastball and sharp breaking pitches, but gave up three runs (two earned) in two innings.
