A Matinee Double Feature– The Worcester Red Sox and the Buffalo Bisons (AAA-Toronto) play a make-up doubleheader this afternoon at 12:15 pm at Polar Park (both 7-inning games are live on NESN and on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). Today’s twin bill (thanks to last night’s rainout) comes on the final weekday matinee of the season at Polar Park. Worcester will put their 21-20 record in day games on the line twice today. Including the two games this afternoon, the WooSox have 17 day games and 30 night games among their remaining 47 games this season.

Double Trouble – The WooSox are 0-2-6 in their eight doubleheaders this season (no sweeps, twice swept, and six splits). The WooSox most recently split a twin bills at Scranton/WB on July 24 as they lost the opener, 8-1 but won game two, 7-4. Worcester’s previous two doubleheaders also came vs. the RailRiders...on June 27 in Moosic, PA (8-3 win & 6-5 loss) and at home vs. Scranton/WB on May 19 (6-3 defeat & 3-1 victory). Worcester’s other doubleheaders this season came during the first five weeks of the season. On May 8 in Buffalo, the WooSox split a doubleheader losing the first game, 11-2 but bouncing back to take the nightcap, 4-0. Worcester had been swept in each of their prior two doubleheaders...on April 24 at Toledo (5-3 & 3-2) and April 20 at home vs. Durham (12-2 & 4-3). That sweep at the hands of the Bulls marked the first time the Sox were swept in a twin bill since April 23 of last year at Lehigh Valley. The Sox had split their first two doubleheaders this season...on April 5 at home vs. Buffalo (9-7 win & 5-0 loss) and on April 14 at Syracuse (10-5 loss & 8-4 win). Worcester went 5-2-4 in their 11 doubleheaders last season...five sweeps, swept twice, and four splits. The WooSox played seven doubleheaders during each of the 2021 and 2022 seasons going 1-2-4 both those years. The last WooSox doubleheader sweep came in Buffalo over a year ago on June 29, 2023 by scores of 5-2 and 4-2.

Goodbye to July - The WooSox finished 10-13 in July after going 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, 14-14 in May, and 12-13 in June. This July the WooSox batted .253 (193-for-764) with 31 HR along with a 5.05 ERA (111 ER in 197.2 IP) while out-scoring the opposition, 129-122. Worcester’s best offensive month was June (.284) and their best month on the mound was May (4.88).

Three to Four – The WooSox will shoot for their third and possibly fourth wins in a row today which would be their longest winning streak since they began the month of July with three straight victories (June 30 and July 1 & 2). Worcester has won back-to-back games after dropping 7 of their previous 8 games from July 20-27. The WooSox have also won 3 of their last 4 home games dating back to July 12.

This Series – Tuesday night the WooSox played in Worcester for the first time in 16 days and they came out on top in a see-saw affair over Buffalo in the opener of this 6-game series, 11-6. The Sox erased an early 4-0 deficit and a 6-5 deficit midway through the game before pulling away behind a balanced offensive attack. Mickey Gasper (3 RBI), Nick Sogard (2 RBI), Enmanuel Valdez (2 RBI), and Mark Contreras (2 RBI) all had 2 hits apiece.

Seeing the Bisons - The WooSox are hosting Buffalo for the second time this season as the Bisons were Worcester’s first opponent at home way back nearly four months ago from April 2-7 at Polar Park. Buffalo won 4 of 5 games during that abbreviated series that included a rainout (April 3) and a snowout (April 4). This 6-game set features this afternoon’s doubleheader at 12:15 pm then single games on Friday at 6:45 pm and then over the weekend with standard games times of Saturday at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm.

Welcome Back Casas - Boston Red Sox 1B **Triston Casas** began his injury rehab assignment with the WooSox Tuesday night going 0-for-3 with a walk as the DH. Casas, 24, has been on Boston's injured list since April 21 with torn cartilage in his left rib cage. He last played for the Red Sox on April 20th and in 22 games for the Sox this season he is batting .244 with 6 HR & 10 RBI.

Triston finished 3rd in the 2023 American League Rookie of the Year voting after a fine first full season in the big leagues last year when he hit .263 with 24 HR & 65 RBI in 132 games along with 70 walks. Casas became the first qualified Red Sox rookie to lead the team in OPS (.857) since Fred Lynn in 1975 and he was only the 4th Red Sox rookie to ever lead the team in walks. Furthermore, last season he joined Ted Williams as the only two Red Sox ever to hit 25 career HR and have 75 career walks in 140 games or fewer. Casas also became the first Major Leaguer to do so since Juan Soto in 2018-19. Casas was Boston's 1st round choice in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft (#26 overall) out of American Heritage High School in Plantation, FL. In 2021 he played for Team USA in the Tokyo Olympic Games and led the field with 3 HR & 8 RBI to help Team USA win the Silver Medal. Triston, who hit .273 with 11 HR & 38 RBI in 72 games for the WooSox in 2022, made his Major League debut with the Red Sox on September 4, 2022 at only 22 years & 232 days becoming the youngest Red Sox to play 1B since Cecil Cooper in September of 1971.

Runs in the Family – Worcester has the 3rd best run differential in the league this season at +54 (591 runs scored and 537 runs allowed). Only Syracuse (+97) and Omaha (+98) are better. Worcester's overall record is 48-55 this season compared to Buffalo's record of 48-54 despite the Bisons with a -34 run differential on the year.

Nine Was Not Fine – The WooSox are currently 7-games below .500 with their 47-55 overall record this season. On Saturday, however, for the first time this year and the first time in franchise-history Worcester had fallen to 9-games under .500 (at 46-55). Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

Where Things Stand - The WooSox come into play tonight with a 13-15 record in the 2nd half and in 8th-place in the division, 4½ GB of Rochester who leads the division with their 18-11 record. Buffalo is in 10th-place, 6½ GB. Columbus now owns the best 2nd half record in the entire IL at 18-10.

Buffalo Bites – Worcester has beaten Buffalo three straight times now, but the Bisons still own a 12-7 advantage in the season-series over Worcester...the WooSox worst mark (and most losses) against any opponent thus far this season. However, the Sox have won the last three meetings back on June 15 (4-2) and June 16 (12-6) in Buffalo and last night (11-6). The Bisons finished 8-5 at Sahlen Field in Buffalo vs. the WooSox this season and they are 4-2 here in Worcester. Worcester's first trip to Buffalo came from May 7-12 for what amounted to a 7-game series including a make-up doubleheader on May 8 that was necessitated by an early-April postponement back in Worcester. The Bisons won 5 of those 7 games in Buffalo in May. And the clubs split a 6-game series in Buffalo from June 11-16. this week/weekend at Sahlen Field. Buffalo won 4 of 5 games in Worcester back from April 2-7 to begin the WooSox home schedule (that series included a rainout and a snowout).

Stats vs. Buffalo – Worcester has been out-scored by Buffalo, 107-94 in the first 19 games of the season-series, but have out-homered the Bisons, 17-15. WooSox pitchers are 7-12 with a 5.57 ERA vs. Buffalo this season (97 ER in 156.2 IP) while Sox batters are hitting .242 vs. the Bisons (146-for-604).

Series Matters – Worcester is 6-8-5 in their first 19 series this season (6 wins, 8 losses, and 5 splits). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

One is Such a Lonely Number – Worcester's 6-5 victory on Sunday at Scranton/WB improved the WooSox record in 1-run games this season to 5-14 (still the worst mark in the league). Every other IL club has at least eight 1-run wins. Worcester is also 7-13 in 2-run games this season. So, in games decided by one run or two runs, the WooSox are 12-27 (.308). When games are decided by 3 runs or more, the WooSox are 36-28 (.563). Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games and they were 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

One on the Rail – Four of the five WooSox 1-run wins this year have come against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...on May 16 (13-12) and May 17 (9-8) both at home and on June 25 (6-5) and July 28 (6-5) both in Moosic, PA. Their lone other 1-run victory came on July 10 vs. Rochester, 7-6.

Leading the Way – Worcester is 1st in on-base pct. among all 20 International League clubs with their .369 on-base pct. The Sox are also tops in the league with 533 walks (most in all of Triple-A in fact) and they are 1st with 73 hit batsmen (Buffalo has 71). It all adds up to an impressive .369 OBP. Furthermore, the WooSox are 2nd in the league with 591 runs scored behind only Norfolk (596).

Second Half Adjustments – The WooSox are 13-15 to begin the 2nd half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1st half good for 7th-place in the IL East and 11½-games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

Home Goods – Worcester is back over the .500 mark at Polar Park this year with their 26-25 record in Worcester (compared to 22-30 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, were recently 0-7 from May 22 – June 5, then went 3-0 from June 6-8, before currently going 8-9 in their last 17 games at home since June 9.

Left at the Altar – Worcester is 2nd in the league with 808 runners left on base this season. Gwinnett is 1st with 825 LOB.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – WooSox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 73 times this season. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

Rankings – Worcester is 8th in the IL in team batting with a .258 average while Buffalo is 14th at .252. On the pitching side, the Sox are 13th in team ERA (5.06) while the Bisons are 19th with a 5.32 ERA. WooSox pitchers have allowed the fewest HR in the league (105 HRA).

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (21-20) than at night (27-35).

Streaks – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

Comebacks and Last AB – Worcester has 23 come-from-behind victories this season including 5 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 13 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

June Over – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3rd highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June. Worcester went 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, and 14-14 in May.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (17-10)/(53-43) rolled over Erie, 9-3 last night to win their 6th in a row. Portland is in sole possession of first place in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League in the 2nd half.

Roman Anthony went 3-for-4 with a pair of homers and a stolen base. His first homer of the night marked the hardest hit homer by any Red Sox organizational player this season at 116 miles per hour exit velocity, according to Boston Globe's Alex Speier. Phillip Sikes finished a double shy of the cycle with his 8th homer of the season. Every Sea Dog collected a hit in the 15-hit affair.

Anthony annihilated his team-leading 12th homer in the bottom of the first inning to give Portland a 1-0 lead.

Sikes smashed his eighth homer in the bottom of the third. The two-run blast extended a three-run lead. Sikes singled in the bottom of the fifth inning to drive in the sixth run of the day and complete the third leg of a cycle.

Anthony torched his second homer of the night in the bottom of the seventh inning. A two-run blast to right center field marked his 13th of the season and his third hit of the night.

RHP Isaac Coffey (8-2, 3.84 ERA) earned the win after pitching 5.0 innings allowing two runs on three hits while striking out three. He did not issue a walk.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The WooSox today are expected to add INF/OF **Jamie Westbrook** to their roster following his option from Boston yesterday. Westbrook, 29, has played in 21 games for the Red Sox this season, his Major League debut. He has made 13 starts at second base, also appearing in one game in right field and one at third base. The right-handed hitter has batted .150 (6-for-40) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, and four walks. The Holyoke, Massachusetts native has also played in 49 games for Worcester this season, batting .282 (59-for-209) with 32 runs scored and 43 RBI while making 24 starts at third base, 15 in right field, eight at second base, seven as the designated hitter, and four at first base.

Worcester has already used 64 players this season (28 position players and 36 pitchers). Pitchers Quinn Priester and Greg Weissert will make 65 and 66 when they make their respective WooSox 2024 debuts.

RHP Quinn Priester, 23, has pitched in 20 games (14 starts) with the Pirates in 2023 & 2024, going 5-9 with a 6.46 ERA (68 ER/94.2 IP). Selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (No. 18 overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft, the right-hander was ranked by *Baseball America* as a top 100 prospect in 2021 (No. 58) and 2022 (No. 88). He ranks in Major League Baseball's 93rd percentile in ground ball rate (55.5%), as well as the 91st percentile in barrel rate (4.5%) and 73rd in walk rate (6.5%). In addition to his 10 outings with Pittsburgh this season, Priester has made seven starts for Triple-A Indianapolis, going 3-1 with a 3.21 ERA (12 ER/33.2 IP), 36 strikeouts, seven walks, and only two home runs allowed.

RHP Greg Weissert, 29, has recorded a 4.24 ERA (22 ER/46.2 IP) with 47 strikeouts in 45 games for Boston this season. Originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 18th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, the Bay Shore, New York native owns a 4.38 ERA (38 ER/78.0 IP) in 74 career games with the Yankees (2022-23) and Red Sox (2024). Last season, Weissert (WICE-ert) posted a 2.90 ERA with 58 strikeouts in 40.1 innings and a .184 opponent batting average in 38 games for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Greg had a sensational 2022 campaign with Scranton/WB when he was named International League Pitcher of the Year after registering 18 saves with a 2-1, 1.69 mark in 42 relief appearances to go along with 70 SO in 48 IP. Weissert was acquired from the Yankees along with RHPs Richard Fitts and Nicholas Judice in exchange for Alex Verdugo on December 5, 2023.

On July 20 the Boston Red Sox sent INF **Vaughn Grissom** to Worcester on an injury rehab assignment. Grissom has played in 8 games during this rehab (5 at 2B & 3 as DH) hitting .233 (7-for-30) with 1 double & 3 RBI. Vaughn has most recently been on the Red Sox injured list since June 2 with a right hamstring strain. He was also on Boston's IL from March 25 – May 2 with a left hamstring strain. During that stretch he did play in 9 rehab games with the WooSox from April 12-28, batting .333 (10-for-30) with 2 2B, 2 RBI, and 3 runs scored while playing 6 games at 2B and 3 as the DH. In 23 games for the Red Sox this season he is hitting .148.

The WooSox have sent 17 players to Boston since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, LHP Bailey Horn, RHP Trey Wingenter, and INF/OF Nick Sogard. Those 17 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, and OF Wilyer Abreu who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa, Dalbec, Heineman, Campbell, Valdez, and Westbrook are back with the WooSox, Wingenter is currently DFA'd, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
