TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for the completion of a six-game series, as your Quakes host the Visalia Rawhide (Arizona). Earlier today, local kids received free baseball instruction and autographs, as part of our final U.S. Bank Youth Baseball Clinic of the season. After today's game, kids can "Run the Bases", thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Game time is 2pm. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 12th of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the sixth of 15 at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 6-5 against the Rawhide in 2024, 2-3 here at home. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 7-5 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes dropped game five of the series on Saturday night, as Visalia took an 11-4 decision over Rancho Cucamonga at LoanMart Field. Jackson Feltner and Jefferson Pena combined for eight hits and seven runs scored out of the eight and nine spots in the lineup, respectively. Visalia starter Wilkin Paredes (1-2) got the win, allowing three runs over five innings. Rancho reliever David Tiburcio (2-1) suffered the defeat, as he allowed three runs (two earned) over 1.1 inning of relief. Wilman Diaz bashed his first homer of the year and drove in all four Rancho runs. Visalia has now won three of five in this series.

SERIES WINS AND LOSSES: With a win today, the Quakes have a chance to split this six-game series. A loss though, gives the Quakes their third straight series loss. The Quakes only lost one other six-game series prior to this tough stretch that has seen Rancho drop 16 of their last 19 games overall. The last series win for the Quakes was in Visalia, back in early-May, when they took four of six.

APRIL 12: On April 12, the Quakes started the day in second place in the South Division. With a win that night over Stockton, the Quakes moved into first and remained there until Friday night's game went final. That stretch came to an end last Friday in Lake Elsinore, as the Quakes were knocked from first place after their fourth straight loss to the Storm. Now, with just 10 games to play in the first half, the Quakes trail Lake Elsinore by three games. Rancho's last 10 games of the first half will be today at home against Visalia (1), on the road at Fresno (6), then finishing at home with Inland Empire (3). The Storm are at Inland Empire (1), home against Stockton (6) and then at Visalia (3) to end the half.

RIVER RYAN: Former Quake right-hander River Ryan returns to Rancho for the first time since 2022, as he'll make a rehab appearance today for the Dodgers. Ryan, who is on the Dodgers' 40-man roster as of this past off-season, has made only one appearance in 2024, as he's been on the Injured List since February with right shoulder fatigue. Ryan has yet to make his big-league debut, but went 1-7 with a 3.80 ERA over 26 games (24 starts) in 2023 with Double-A Tulsa and Triple-A Oklahoma City, respectively. WIth the Quakes

ADONYS PEREZ: Lefty Adonys Perez will make his tenth appearance and ninth start of the year, his second start against the Quakes. In his lone outing against Rancho, he allowed just three hits and two walks over 5.2 innings of scoreless work in a no-decision on May 12 in Visalia. In his last outing, he allowed just one run on six hits over six innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on June 2. The Diamondbacks signed Perez in 2022 out of the Dominican Republic.
