TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes kick off their first series after the All-Star Break, as they head to the Lake Elsinore Diamond to take on the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in game one of a three-game set. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday to host the Visalia Rawhide in a six-game series. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the tenth of 24 head-to-head games and the first of nine in Lake Elsinore. The Quakes are 8-1 against the Storm with the two teams having played all nine games in Rancho. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 3-12 in Lake Elsinore.

LAST GAME: The 66ers scored three times in the ninth to take the lead for good, on their way to an 8-7 victory over Rancho Cucamonga this past Sunday at LoanMart Field. The loss for Rancho is their fifth straight overall, as the Quakes dropped five of six in the series. Oswaldo Osorio slugged his first homer of the year, a two-out, two-run shot in the bottom of the ninth off 66ers' closer Jaren Warwick. Warwick (1-6) would come right back to record the final out and earn his first win of the year. Dilan Figueredo (0-2) gave up three runs (one earned) in the ninth, suffering the loss. Rancho's Jose Meza had three hits and three RBIs in the loss.

SERIES STUFF: The Quakes have hit a rough patch in the second half, as they've now dropped two straight series, their first two against South Division opponents. Rancho's only series losses prior to that had come against Stockton (twice) and San Jose (twice), a pair of North Division teams. Rancho's overall series record this year is 9-6-1.

ROAD NOT SO FRIENDLY, LATELY: The Quakes have had a tough go of it recently on the road, as they've dropped seven of their last nine road games overall. The recent San Jose series finished poorly for Rancho, as they dropped decisions of 9-2, 12-4 and 20-2. After dropping two of three in Visalia on their last road trip, they're now just 23-22 on the road this year.

FUTURE'S GAME: Saturday's MLB Futures Game in Atlanta was a huge success for a pair of former Quakes. 2024 Quake OF Zahir Hope and 2023/24 OF Josue De Paula both played in the game. Hope collected a single and was on board when De Paula cracked a three-run homer, as the National League downed the American League by a final of 4-2. De Paula was named the game's MVP. Both players have spent the entire 2025 season in Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League.

ALL-STAR RECAP: The National League bested the American League in this past Tuesday's All-Star Game in Atlanta. Former Quakes Zach McKinstry (DET), Will Smith (LAD) and Clayton Kershaw (LAD) all played in the NL's 7-6 win. Other Dodgers to appear in the game include Yoshi Yamamoto, Freddie Freeman and Shohei Ohtani.

AIDAN FOELLER: 23-year-old right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his 16th start and 18th appearance, his third against Lake Elsinore. In two games against the Storm, Foeller is 1-0, allowing six runs (five earned) on 13 hits over 9.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed two hits, while striking out four over two scoreless innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on July 9. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

MAIKEL MIRALLES: Righty Maikel Miralles makes his 11th appearance and eighth start of the year for the Storm, his second start against the Quakes. In one game against the Quakes, he allowed four runs (three earned) on four hits over three innings in a loss on Opening Day, April 4. In his last outing overall, he allowed just one hit with seven strikeouts over four scoreless innings in a no-decision at Visalia on July 11. Miralles signed with San Diego in January of 2023 out of Maracay, Venezuela.
