Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds regained the series lead over the Salem RidgeYaks with a 7-3 win on Saturday night. The Shorebirds jumped ahead in the second inning on a balk with runners at first and third, taking a 1-0 advantage. Delmarva added to their lead in the third on a pair of two-out RBI singles from **Elvin Garcia** and **Miguel Rodriguez**, going in front 3-0. In the fourth, an error by the RidgeYaks allowed another run to score, making it 4-0. Delmarva's offense put together its best inning in the sixth, scoring three runs on an RBI single by **Jhonnardo Reyes** and a two-run base hit by **Stiven Martinez**, taking a 7-0 advantage. That proved to be plenty for Shorebirds' pitching, led by **Esteban Mejia**, who threw three scoreless innings as the starter, and **Brayan Orrantia**, who gave up just two runs on back-to-back homers in the eighth but threw a career-high five innings in his first professional win. The Shorebirds held on 7-3 to position themselves for a series win on Sunday.

Sanchez and Layton Get the Call: Jordan Sanchez and DJ Layton are the latest two Shorebirds to be promoted to High-A Frederick. After a tough start and an unlucky run of injuries, Jordan Sanchez turned it on in a major way. Since the start of June, the Orioles' No. 20 prospect hit .294 with 36 RBIs and 15 multi-hit games in 42 starts. Sanchez became the team leader in RBIs with 47 on the season in 66 games. Layton was a breakout star for the Shorebirds, leading the team in walks (73), runs (64), OBP (.396), OPS (.785), doubles (19), and stolen bases (31) at the time of his promotion. He reached base safely in 50 of his final 55 games as a Shorebird.

Make Way for Lo Re: Jaiden Lo Re has had an incredible run at the top of Delmarva's order. In 50 games, Lo Re has 60 hits and is batting .339, with 20 multi-hit games. He has been a regular on base, with a .461 OBP, thanks to 40 walks compared to 20 strikeouts over 220 plate appearances. Since joining the Shorebirds, his .339 average is the best among all qualified hitters in the Carolina League, and he has a hit in 26 of 29 games. He lost a 13-game hitting streak on July 29 against Hickory, the longest run by a Delmarva player this season.

Welcome the Class of 2026: The Shorebirds have added three players from the Baltimore Orioles' 2026 draft class. The additions include OF **Eric Booth Jr.**, OF **Ty Head**, and SS **Jimmy Anderson**. Booth Jr. was the No. 7 overall pick in the draft and the highest-selected player by the Orioles since they picked **Jackson Holliday** No. 1 overall in 2022. **Ty Head** was the best center fielder in college baseball last season and won a Gold Glove at the position. **Jimmy Anderson** was originally selected by Baltimore in the 19th round of 2025 but returned to school at Heartland Community College in Illinois, where he was picked again in 2026 in the 5th round. He was previously a high school teammate of former Shorebird and current Orioles' prospect **Nate George**.

Trade Additions: In addition to members of the 2026 draft class joining the Shorebirds, two players were added via trade, including OF **Jhonnardo Reyes** and RHP **Harrison Kreiling**. Reyes was acquired from the Minnesota Twins for RHP **Dean Kremer**, and the 18-year-old outfielder instantly slots into the Orioles' Top 30 list, ranking No. 23 for MLB Pipeline and No. 17 by Baseball America. Kreiling was a former 17th-round pick by the Seattle Mariners and came over in the deal for OF **Taylor Ward**.

About the RidgeYaks: The Shorebirds welcome the Salem RidgeYaks to Perdue Stadium for the first time this season. The Single-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox has won two three-game series against the Shorebirds this season, while the teams split the only six-game set in Salem in early May. The team rebranded from Red Sox to RidgeYaks in the offseason, and the new nickname comes from the Blue Ridge Mountains beyond the ballpark. "Yak" is short for kayak, a popular outdoor activity in the Salem area.
