BACK-TO-BACK WALKOFF WINS

Dane Myers' single allowed the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to walk off with a 3-2 victory in 10 innings over the Durham Bulls in front of 6.047 fans. With Durham (40-37, 0-2) ahead 2-1, Jerar Encarnacion walked against reliever Calvin Faucher (0-1) to put runners on first and second. Paul McIntosh followed with an RBI single, plating zombie runner Brian Miller to tie the game. Myers laced an RBI single with the bases loaded and two outs, scoring Encarnacion to win it for Jacksonville (34-42, 2-0).

EXTRA! EXTRA! READ ALL ABOUT IT...

After last night's 3-2 walk-off win against Durham, the Jumbo Shrimp notched back-to-back last at-bat wins for the first time since September 2-3 against the Charlotte Knights. This season the Jumbo Shrimp have 11 last at-bat wins with six wins coming at home. The 2021 Jumbo Shrimp, affectionately known as the Cardiac Shrimp, had 21 last athat wins for the season, Jacksonville had 11 last at-hat wins during the season with nine walk-off wins coming at 121 Financial Ballpark.

BULL****

Since returning to the International League in 2021, Jacksonville has failed to find an answer on beating the Durham Bulls. Since 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp own a .392 winning percentage against the Bulls, the lowest winning percentage against a team they've faced in multiple series'. Last year, Jacksonville matched up against Durham 24 times, winning just nine contests. This year, the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff owns a 5.83 ERA against Durham while the Bulls have posted a 3.15 ERA, allowing just 57 runs in 120.1 innings. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 83-57, an average of 5.9 runs/game to 4.1 runs/game.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine homes, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 29 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 36 dingers, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 36 homers are tied for 17th-most in Triple-A over the last 29 games.

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 34-42 record is 20th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-five of the club's 76 games, or 72.4 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league. On the flip side, Durham has had a relatively easy schedule. The reigning Triple-A Champs are 10-18 vs. teams with a record above .500, they are 30-18 vs. teams helow 500

APRIL SHOWERS HAVEN'T BROUGHT FLOWERS

Jacksonville finds themselves in the cellar of the International League. After finishing the first month of the season with a 13-12 record, the Jumbo Shrimp haven't found a spark, going 18-29 since May 1. The club posted the sixth-best ERA through the first month of the season at 4.47 in 227.1 innings. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 264 earned runs in 430.0 innings for a 5.53 ERA that ranks 12th in the IL. Through those 51 games, opponents have posted a .267 batting average against Jacksonville pitching which ranks tied for sixth-highest batting average against in the league. Through 75 games in 2022. Jacksonville owned a 40-35 record with a posted 4.42 ERA.

FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 14 of their last 20 games, going 10-10 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 104 to 99 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won seven of their last 13. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville split their previous two series against Nashville and Memphis at home...The club hasn't won a series since May 2-7 on the road against the Redbirds. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have gone 0-4-3 including a series loss to Gwinnett last week. Jacksonville posted a 6.13 ERA in 47.0 innings, the sixth-worst ERA in the IL. The Jumbo Shrimp were outscored 35 to 26, allowing a .291 BAA.

ABOUT CHI CHI

-González was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching $5\,2/3$ innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, González attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles.

-González starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summit League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.

-In his first stint in the rotation, Chi Chi went 1-4, 8.23 ERA (50.1 IP, 46 ER) through his last 11 starts (Rockies 4-7) from June 10 through his final start on Sept. 7. He was then placed on Injured List with a right oblique strain Sept. 8-Oct. 2 before electing to free agency.
