series vs. the Indianapolis Indians (Pittsburgh Pirates) at Coolray Field, the only series between the two clubs this season. Tonight is Giveaway Saturday, featuring a Xolos de Gwinnett Black Cap Giveaway for the first 1,500 fans (courtesy of Georgia Power).

VS. INDIANAPOLIS: Gwinnett is 34-22 (.607) all-time vs. Indianapolis at Coolray Field. Last night's loss snapped the Stripers' nine-game home winning streak (outscored IND 59-27) and eight-game overall winning streak (outscored IND 52-25) against the Indians. In 11 season series vs. Indianapolis since 2009, Gwinnett is 3-4-4 (2-0 since 2018).

STIFLING STAFF: Gwinnett leads Triple-A in ERA in the month of June with a 3.55 mark in 15 games. That's 0.31 points lower than Lehigh Valley (2nd, at 3.86 in 15G). Stripers' starters Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa have combined to post a 3.59 ERA (33 ER in 82.2 IP), 9.47 SO/9.0 IP ratio (87 SO), and six quality starts this month.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett's pitching staff leads the International League in strikeouts with 651 in 64 games (10.17 SO per game). That's 10 more than Worcester (2nd with 641 SO in 64G). Kyle Muller (1st, 84) and Tucker Davidson (6th, 57) both rank in the IL top 10 in strikeouts. In all of Triple-A, only Sacramento of the Pacific Coast League has more team strikeouts (654 SO in 64G).

KRAMER SAYS 'GIDDY-UP': Kramer Robertson blasted his first home run with Gwinnett last night (#6 overall), a solo shot to center on the first pitch of the game from RHP Jerad Eickhoff. It was the fourth clout by a Stripers player leading off a game this year (Drew Waters has 2, both on the first pitch, Phil Gosselin has 1). Robertson has hits in each of his last five games, batting .350 (7-for-20, 1 2B, 1 HR, 5 R, 4 RBI, 4 SB, .985 OPS).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. is riding a seven-game on-base streak since 6/3, batting .412 (7-for-17, 1 2B, 1 HR, 5 R, 3 RBI, 5 SB, 1.240 OPS) in that span. Overall with Gwinnett, he has reached base safely in 37 of 44 games (84.1%), batting .268 (33-for-123, 5 2B, 1 HR, 19 R, 13 RBI). He currently ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-7th, 15) and walks (T-9th, 33).

WATERS WATCH: In 30 games since being activated from Gwinnett's 7-day IL on 5/3. Atlanta Brayes No. 2 prospect **Drew Waters** is batting .243 (28-for-115, 6 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR. 16 R, 10 RBI, 1 SB), including .432 (5 XBH, 1.084 OPS) vs. LHP and .154 (5 XBH, .482 OPS) vs. RHP.

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year, including leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero), and a leadoff triple on 6/11 at Jacksonville (off RHP Bryan Hoeing).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .246 (154-for-626, 33 2B, 2 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 58 RBI, 32 SB, .704 OPS) in 159 games.

TUCKER ON TRACK: Preston Tucker belted his teamleading third homer of June on Thursday (2-run, off RHP Osvaldo Bido). He's batting .286 (14-for-49, 3 2B, 3 HR, 6 R, 7 RBI, .938 OPS) over his last 14 games since 5/27, including a 12-game on-base streak from 5/27-6/14.

Tonight: The Stripers play game five of a six-game DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .125 (2for-16, 4 R, 1 RBI, 1 SB) in four games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

> GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 164 of 193 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .280 (187-for-667, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 14 SB, .932 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Meija.

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller struck out 11 batters over 7.0 IP (4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB) for the win on Tuesday, his second double-digit strikeout game of the year (tied career high with 12 SO over 6.0 IP on 5/14 at DUR). He has recorded three straight quality starts since 6/2, going 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (2 ER in 20.0 IP), 0.90 WHIP, .194 BAA, and 12.60 SO/9.0 IP ratio (28 SO) in that span.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (84) and is among the top 10 in ERA (3rd, 2.89), BAA (5th, .230), WHIP (6th, 1.19), and innings (T-6th, 62.1).
- · GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.17 ERA (50 ER in 142.0 IP), .226 BAA, and 177 strikeouts (11.22 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 28 starts.

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager on 6/9 at Jacksonville (won 5-1). He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining Dave Brundage (293 from 2009-12), Brian Snitker (161 from 2014-16), and Damon Berryhill (221 from 2017-19).

GOSSELIN GETS THE CALL: On Tuesday, the Atlanta Braves selected the contract of INF Phil Gosselin from Gwinnett. Gosselin hit safely in 23 of 29 games from 5/1-6/12, batting .312 (34-for-109, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 16 RBI, .885 OPS) in that stretch. Through 6/13, he ranked 14th in the IL with a .297 average (54-for-182, 13 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 24 RBI, .831 OPS) in 49 games.

• GWN Career: In 284 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .295 (309-for-1046, 64 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 106 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS). He is one of just seven players in Gwinnett history to record 300 career hits with the club.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Since joining the Stripers on 4/19, has pitched at least 5.0 innings in seven of his nine starts ... **4/24-5/26:** Over his first six starts, went 1-2 with a 5.64 ERA (19 ER in 30.1 IP) and .228 BAA ... **Since 6/1:** In three starts in June, is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (4 ER in 16.0 IP) and .143 BAA (8 H, 8 BB, 14 SO) ... **6/7 at JAX:** Fired 7.0 no-hit innings (3 BB, 6 SO) for the win, combining with **Brandyn Sittinger** (1.0 IP, 1 H) and **Brad Brach** (1.0 IP, 0 H) on a one-hit shutout in a 7-0 victory.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made the Braves' Opening Day Roster for the second time in his career (also in 2021) ... Served as the fifth starter, going 0-2 with a 13.50 ERA (10 ER in 6.2 IP) and .355 BAA over two starts ... Optioned to Gwinnett on 4/19.

2021 REGULAR SEASON: In an injury-shortened year with Atlanta, went 4-6 with a 4.05 ERA and .224 BAA in 18 games (17 starts) ... Was on the Braves' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career ... Won four consecutive starts from 4/23-5/9 (4-0, 1.11 ERA, .165 BAA), and drove in more runs (6) than he allowed (4) over that stretch ... Homered in back-to-back games (solo off CHC's Kyle Hendricks on 4/28, grand slam off WSH's Tanner Rainey on 5/4) ... Broke his right hand after departing the game on 5/16 at Milwaukee and was placed on the Injured List on 5/17 ... Transferred to the 60-day IL on 5/31 ...
