LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their series opener to the Somerset Patriots by a 3-2 final on Wednesday night. The Patriots tallied all of their runs on left-handed starter Cade Povich via a trio of solo home runs. Tyler Hardman led off the second-inning with his first solo shot of the game to give Somerset an early 1-0 lead. Bowie would tie the game with a two-out RBI single from Anthony Servideo in the bottom half of the second. However, in the top of the fourth, Everson Pereira led off the frame with a solo home run, before Hardman picked up his second long ball of the night immediately after. The back-to-back bombs gave the Patriots a 3-1 lead. From there, both bullpens would hold serve until the bottom of the ninth, where the Baysox tried to spark a late two-out rally with a double from Servideo followed by a Tim Susnara RBI single, but the effort would fall short, as Bowie dropped its first game of the second half.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots enter tonight's game with a 43-26 record - the best across the Eastern League and good enough to clinch the first half title in the Northeast division. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has been powered by its pitching staff this season, which holds a league-leading 3.71 ERA, while allowing the fewest home runs (50) across the league and accumulating the most strikeouts (694). Offensively, the Patriots have hit the most home runs (103) and stolen the second-most bases (128) - both notable weaknesses of this Baysox team. Somerset's roster is highlighted by six of the Yankees' top 10 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY/ No. overall), C Austin Wells (No. 2 NYY) No. overall), OF Everson Pereria (No. 4 NYY), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), RHP Richard Fitts (No. 8 NYY), and RHP Yoendrys Gomez (No. 9 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Richard Fitts is set to get the ball for Somerset tonight. The No. 8 prospect in the Yankees' system, per MLB Pipeline, Fitts has thrown the second-most innings (71.1) in the Eastern League this season, controlling the zone effectively with 80 strikeouts compared to just 15 walks. The right-hander is on a stretch of six consecutive quality starts, allowing just eight earned runs across 38 innings in his last six starts (1.89 ERA). Fitts last pitched this past Thursday against New Hampshire, where he allowed just one, unearned run on two hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. A sixth-round pick of the Yankees in 2021 out of Auburn University, Fitts features a mid-90s fastball, mid-80s slider, high-80s cutter, and mid-80s changeup

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. At the midway point, Mayo leads Minor League Baseball with his 42 extra-base hits, while his 26 doubles pace the Double-A level. The No. 8 Orioles'/ No. 80 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, had just his second hitless game in the past 16 contests on Wednesday. It was just his second time failing to reach base in the past 40 games. Mayo is coming off back-to-back Eastern League Player of the Week awards, hitting .440 across those two weeks with six home runs, seven doubles, and 13 RBI. Mayo also leads the Eastern League in both slugging (.599) and OPS (1.026), while sitting third in on-base percentage (.427).

TANDEM TROUBLES

The abundance of starting pitching experience on the Bowie roster has led to a reliance on tandems at times this season. Despite a collective starters' ERA of 3.72 - the best in the Eastern League and second-best at the Double-A level, when Baysox starters enter the game as relievers, they sport a collective 5.41 ERA. Bowie has utilized a tandem in 37 games thus far in 2023, going 19-18 in those contests. The back end of tandems have blown six leads for the Baysox this season, while failing to go two innings on nine ocasions, and allowing four runs or more in 12 different contests

HOME RUN HOBBLES

The Baysox pitching staff has struggled this season when its come to the home run ball, particularly within the confines of Prince George's Stadium. Bowie arms have allowed 82 home runs overall this season - third-most in the Eastern League. Of those 86 home runs, 56 have come at home - the second-most allowed by a team at home in the league. Meanwhile, Somerset leads the Double-A level with its 103 home runs. The Patriots have launched 18 more long balls than the second-highest total in the Eastern League (Erie - 85).

RUNNING RAMPANT

Bowie has seen repeated struggles in the first half when it comes to the running game. Baysox catchers have only caught 13.5 percent of attempted steals against them in 2023 (12-for-89) - the second-lowest mark in the Eastern League. Active catchers on the Bowie roster are just 3-for-55 (5.5 percent) catching attempted base-stealers at the Double-A level this season. Two stolen bases for Somerset on Wednesday night give the 128 this season - the second-most stolen bases in the league, succeeding on 80 percent of its attempts. Offensively, the Baysox have the fewest stolen bases (54) in the league, with the lowest success rate (66.7 percent) as well.
