**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve play a critical Second Half series with the Harrisburg Senators. Altoona is 10-6 against the Senators this season.

Top Nats pitching prospect Jarlin Susana takes the ball for the Senators tonight. Pipeline's top international pitching prospect in 2022 signed with the Padres and was acquired for Josh Bell in the same deal that sent Juan Soto to the Padres. Susana is ranked as the No. 71 prospect in the minors according to Pipeline and struck out 23 batters in 10 innings last week against Erie across two starts.

**A NIGHT TO REMEMBER:** In Altoona's 14-3 win over Harrisburg the team had several notable moments. **Nick Cimillo** hit for the cycle, becoming the second player in franchise history to hit for the cycle (**Andrew Lambo**, April 9, 2013), as part of a 5-for-6 day at the plate. **Konnor Griffin** hit his first career multi-homer game and drove in a career-high 7 runs in the win. **Esmerlyn Valdez** also hit two homers, marking the 7th time in franchise history that the team had two players hit two homers in the same game.

**No. 1:** Baseball's top prospect, **Konnor Griffin**, has a hit in 7-of-9 games with the Curve, including each of the last five, batting .353 (12-for-34) with a .988 OPS since joining the Curve on Monday, August 18. Griffin, at 19 years, 3 months and 26 days, is the youngest player in franchise history to suit up for The Curve. Griffin is the tenth player in franchise history, just the third infielder, to join Altoona while ranked as the No. 1 prospect in baseball, first since **Paul Skenes** in 2023. Griffin ranks among all minor league players in runs scored (2nd, 104), stolen bases (8th, 64), hits (4th, 145), 7th in RBI (85) and batting average. (3rd, .333).

Griffin is the first Pirates minor leaguer to steal 60 bases since Manny Ravelo stole 70 bases in 2001 with Single-A Lynchburg and Hickory.

**RECORD WATCH:** With three projected starts remaining in the 2025 season, righty **Wilber Dotel** has a chance to finish in the top-5 of strikeouts in a single-season in franchise history. His 119 strikeouts are just 5 shy of **Tom Gorzelanny's** 2005 campaign in which he struck out 124. **Ian Snell** holds the franchise record with 142 strikeouts in 2004. **Luis Ortiz** in 2022 was the most recent Curve pitcher to threaten the franchise record for strikeouts, earning 126 that season.

**DUCE IS LOOSE:** Infielder **Duce Gourson** has emerged as one of Altoona's most underrated players in the Second Half of the season. In his last 17 games, he is 23-for-60 (.383) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI and 12 BB (since August 7).

**THE SAGINAW KID:** Infielder **Mitch Jebb** has picked up eight multi-hit games across his last 22 games, he's batting .367 (29-for-79) with a .453 on-base percentage, 5 2B, 1 3B and 9 RBI.

Jebb picked up his 32nd stolen base of the season Tuesday, August 26 at Harrisburg, 5th-most by an Eastern League player this year. He is the first Curve player to steal 30 bases in a season since **Jared Oliva** stole 36 bases in 2019. Only two players in franchise history (**Rajai Davis** and **Rich Thompson** in 2005) have stolen 40 bases in a season for the Curve.

**POSTSEASON CURVE:** With 14 games remaining in the Second Half, Altoona holds a 1.0 game lead over Harrisburg in the Southwest Division. The Curve were last in the postseason in 2018 when they fell to the Akron RubberDucks in the Division Series.

**NICK AT NIGHT:** First baseman **Nick Cimillo** has returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. In his last 32 games, he's picked up 20 extra base hits (.984 OPS). In that time he ranks 2nd among Double-A players in HR (10), 3rd in XBH (20), 3rd in SLG% (.617) and 4th in OPS (.984).

**CLOSE WINS:** 25 of Altoona's last 33 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 60 of the team's 123 games this year (48%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

**WE'LL SEE THEM ALL:** For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNC Field.
