By the Numbers

Lake County has been in 1st place in the Midwest League East overall standings for the last 37 days, a stretch dating 37 back to May 28. Since then, the Captains are 21-11 and have MiLB's 4th-best win percentage in this span

Lake County ranks 2nd in the Midwest League and 3rd in High-A with a .349 on-base percentage. The Captains .349 clip is their highest through their first 77 games of a season since the 2007 team posted a .367 mark.

Lake County leads the Midwest League and ranks 3rd in 397 High-A with 397 runs (5.2 per game), its most through 77 games since the 2007 Captains scored 443 in this span.

CAPTAINS LOG

ALMOST INDEPENDENCE DAY: RHP Rorik Maltrud (1-0) earned his 1st High-A quality start, and 2B Angel Genao delivered a 2-out, go-ahead RBI single in the top of the 10th to give Lake County a 2-1 win over Dayton on Wednesday at Day

MALTRUD'S MASTERPIECE: Maltrud spun his 2nd Minor League quality start between Single-A Lynchburg and Lake County, allowing 1 run while striking out 4 across 6 innings. His 0.58 ERA since May 31 ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball in that span.

EXTRA, EXTRA: After Genao ripped the go-ahead single in the top of the 10th, LHP Adam Tulloch earned his 1st Minor League save with a scoreless bottom of the 10th. The Captains are 5-1 (.833) in extra innings, the highest winning percentage in the

TO THE MOON: After Dayton took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the 5th, 3B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, tied the game with a sacrifice fly in the top of the 6th. He now leads the team with 39 RBI.

ANGEL ON THE INFIELD: SS Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, went 3-for-5 on Wednesday, his 4th 3-hit game as a Captain. He is batting .419 (13-for-31) since June 25, tied for the 5th-best clip in the MWL in that span. Genao is 2nd in Single/High-A with 91 hits across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, hitting safely in 13 of his last 15 games. Genao is the only player in Minor League Baseball with a .330+ AVG, 30+ XBH, and 15+ SB this season.

HEY DRIVER: RHP Jay Driver retired the Dragons in order in the 8th inning on Tuesday. His 0.36 ERA is the 2nd lowest among Minor League relievers with 25-plus innings pitched. Driver has not allowed an earned run in 22 innings, 19 appearances, and

DOMINANT DEBUTS: On June 27, Captains RHP Rorik Maltrud arned his 1st High-A win in his 1st High-A start, allowing 1 run on 4 nits while striking out 5. On June 28, former Captains RHP Austin Peterson struck out 10 and earned his 9th quality start of the season n his Double-A debut for Akron. Also in his Double-A debut, former Captains LHP Parker Messick pitched 5 no-hit innings versus Binghamton on June 23.

THIS IS 40: The Captains won their 40th game of the season in their 55th contest, becoming the fastest team in franchise history to win 40 games since the 2010 Midwest League Championship Team won 40 in 61 games.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

PROVIDING THE FIREWORKS: Since 2005, the Captains are 10-7 on July 4, with their last Independence Day win being a 6-0 victory at Fort Wayne in 2022. 7-year MLB veteran Erik González (CLE, PIT, MIA) has the most total bases by a Captain on July 4 since at least 2005, with 6, going 3-for-5 with 1 HR and 3 RBI In the 13-0 win at Lansing in 2013.

In that span, there have been 6 other 3-hit games by a Captain on July 4, with Gio Urshela (2011), 5-time All-Star Jose Ramirez (2012), and Anthony Santander (2015) providing 3 of those performances. On the mound, current Double-A Akron RHP Jack Leftwich pitched the most shutout innings on July 4 by a Captain since at least 2005, spinning 5.1 scoreless frames in the 6-0 win at Fort Wayne.

TARS AND STRIKES: Lake County leads the Midwest League with a 3.63 ERA, surrendering just 302 runs, tied for the 9th fewest in MiLB. Captains starters lead the MWL with 376 strikeouts, while the bullpen leads the MWL with a 3.43 ERA.

THE BATTLE OF TRENTON: RHP Trenton Denholm ranks T-2nd in the Midwest League in quality starts (6), 3rd in WHIP (1.04), 4th in ERA (3.39) and is 1 of 2 Midwest Leaguers to pitch a 7-inning complete game shutout (5/10 vs. DAY G1). Denholm won 7 games in his first 11 starts, the fastest Captain 7-game winner since Ryan Miller won 7 in 10 appearances (9 starts) in 2008

TRIPLE ENTENTE: INF Alex Mooney, OF Jonah Advincula and OF Guy **_ipscomb** are the 1st Captains trio to steal 20-plus bases in Lake County's first 74 team games of a season since 2012. 4 Captains that stole 20-plus bags in 74 team games, 1 of them being current New York Mets SS and 4me All-Star Francisco Lindor.

THE STEAL INDUSTRY: The Captains have stolen 136 bases through their first 76 games, their most through their first 77 games since at least 2005. Lake County ranks 3rd in MiLB with an 88.3% stolen base

NAVAL POWER: LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson eclipsed 100 strikeouts on June 25 versus Great Lakes, and now ranks 3rd in MiLB with 108 trikeouts this season. He and current Guardians LHP Logan Allen are the only Cleveland Minor Leaguers since at least 2005 to reach 100olus strikeouts through a team's first 70 games. Allen fanned 104 with Double-A Akron in 2022.

THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN: Since 2021, 11 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft. Of those 11 ACC draftees, 5 have played for the Captains his year (LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney), with 5 total '23 draftees being Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

PROSPECTING: Cleveland has experienced a gold rush of prospects, with 5 current Lake County Captains and 6 2023 draftees listed among Cleveland's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. The latest is C Cooper Ingle, who is MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, replacing 2021 Captain and current Cleveland Guardians SS José Tena who graduated om "prospect" status on Sunday

LAST TIME OUT: Carter Spivey (5-1) earned his 5th High-A win on June 28 versus Great Lakes, going 6 innings, allowing 1 run on 5 hits while striking out 3 and walking 2 in the 2-1 win. His lone run allowed came on a solo home run in the top of the 4th. **Spivey's 2.52 ERA since May 26 is the 5thlowest in the Midwest League in that span.**

QUALITY CONTROL: Spivey has made 6 quality starts in his 1st season of Minor League Baseball, which are tied for 2nd in the Midwest League with teammate **Trenton Denholm** and 2 others, trailing only former teammate and current Double-A Akron RubberDuck **Austin Peterson**.

A NEW FRONTIER: After his 5-year collegiate career at East Carolina University ended in 2023, Spivey made 8 starts in independent ball for the Florence Y'alls (Florence, KY) of the Frontier League from July 22 to September 1. He tallied 4 quality starts for the Y'alls and posted a 3.06 ERA, the lowest on the team among pitchers that threw 40+ innings. Spivey went 7+ innings in 2 starts (August 3 at Evansville and August 20 at Joliet). Starting with San Diego RHP Brian Tollberg making his MLB debut on June 20, 2000, 52 Frontier League alumni have made the Majors.

A PIRATE'S LIFE FOR SPIVEY: Spivey went 17-4 with a 4.71 ERA in 83 games (15 starts) across five seasons at East Carolina from 2019-23. The right-hander was a teammate of current Cleveland Guardians RHP Gavin Williams from 2019-21. In 2023, Spivey was a 2nd Team All-American Athletic Conference selection. He went 7-3 with a 4.68 ERA in 24 games (10 starts), moving into the weekend rotation by the end of the season. The Fairfax, Virginia native was also tabbed the 2023 AAC Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Spivey's 15 wins over his last 2 seasons were the most by any AAC pitcher during that span.

HE'S GOING THE DISTANCE: On April 15, 2023 against the University of Cincinnati, **Spivey** pitched a complete game shutout in 7 innings. He allowed 4 hits and no walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts in the 10-0 win.

IN THE JUNGLE, THE MIGHTY JUNGLE: Pitching at Clark-LeClair Stadium, nicknamed "The Jungle," **Spivey** was named the 2022 AAC Pitcher of the Year. He went a perfect 8-0 with a 2.83 ERA and 76 strikeouts in 76.1 innings of work. The 24-year-old was also named the ECU Jungle Pitching MVP. The right-hander was named a Collegiate Baseball 3rd Team All-American, and a finalist for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year. **Spivey** made 35 appearances, the 8th-most in the country and 3rd-most in a season in program history. In the Greenville Regional, he went 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA and a .214 opposing average. **Spivey** also finished the season with 5 saves, which ranked 2nd in the AAC behind Houston's Ben Sears, who currently pitches for the Midwest League's Quad Cities River Bandits.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, **LHP Raymond Burgos** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. **Burgos** made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

INF Angel Martínez: On Saturday, June 22, **INF Angel Martínez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

INF/OF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
