TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve begin their first road trip of the season, a six-game series at Akron with the Cleveland Guardians affiliate. Akron is loaded with returners like RHP Aaron Davenport and Tommy Mace in the rotation along with INF CJ Kayfus and OF Joe Lampe. INF Travis Bazzana, the No. 1 overall pick in 2024 out of Oregon State, highlights thier prospect status. Bazzana was born in Austrailia and made history with Chase Burns (Italy, selected No.2 overall by Cincinnati) as the first pair to be born overseas and selected at the top of the draft.

On the mound, righty Rorik Maltrud takes the ball in Akron's home opener after they swept Richmond in 3 games over the weekend. A 25-year-old from Austin, TX, Maltrud joined the Guardians in January of 2024 after his well-traveled collegiate caréer at Oklahoma (Fall only, 2018), Grayson CC (19-20), New Mexico State (21-22) and Missouri (2023). He turned in a fine pro debut at Lake County and Lynchburg, recording a 3.44 ERA in 24 games, 19 starts.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters have thrown 14 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel. Solometo).

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson became the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve, when he arrived on August 27, 2024 in Curve, PA. This season, Johnson opens as the youngest in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7thyoungest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old).

Johnson's 85 walks last season were 9th-most by a minor league player and he's reached base safely in 11-of-16 games with the Curve.

DIXON BANGS: Infielder **Brenden Dixon**, who swatted eight homers last season for the Curve, banged Altoona's first home run of the season on Opening Day on April 4 against Chesapeake. Dixon added a double in Saturday's 2-0 defeat to the Baysox.

2024 IN REVIEW: The Curve totaled a 62-76 mark during the 2024 season, marking the 11th time in franchise history that Altoona finished with a record under .500. Since the cancelled 2020 season. Altoona has had a winning record just one time (2022) in four seasons. Returners Kervin Pichardo (Team MVP) and Sammy Siani (Unsung Hero) return to the Curve lineup.

PROSPECTS PARTY: Seven Curve players are ranked among the Pirates Top 30 according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. Termarr Johnson (No. 4 MLB/No. 5 BA) headlines the group, which also features LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7/No. 10), INF Jack Brannigan (No. 11/No. 14), INF/OF Mitch Jebb (No. 13/No. 14), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14/No. 15), RHP Alessandro Ercolani (No. 21 BA), RHP Wilber Dotel (No. 27 BA).

THE TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH ALTOONA: Five alumni went on to make their major league debut during the 2024 season. RHP Jared Jones (3/30, PIT), RHP Paul Skenes (5/11, PIT), C Grant Koch (5/29, PIT), LHP Luis Peralta (8/24, COL) and RHP Mike Burrows (9/28, PIT) all reached the major leagues for the first time. In 2025, RHP Thomas Harrington (4/1, PIT) and LHP Omar Cruz (4/1, SD) have both made their major league debut, totaling 219 alumni who have gone onto the major leagues.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.



He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford Pitching Coach 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an instructor in the Pirates system, previously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and joins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
