RIDERS THROW SIXTH NO-HITTER IN FRANCHISE HISTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored in each of their first four innings and capped the night with a four-run ninth in a 12-6 win over the San Antonio Missions on Thursday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. After a one-hour, 23-minute rain delay proceeded first pitch, the Riders (19-11) came out swinging in the first inning. **Abimelec Ortiz** started the scoring with an RBI single to left to make it 1-0 against San Antonio (15-15) starter Victor Lizarraga (0-5). The Missions (15-15) answered with a run in the bottom of the first, but Frisco volleyed back in the second frame. With the bases loaded, **Aaron Zavala** rolled an infield single to first, but two San Antonio throwing errors allowed him to circle the bases on a Little League grand slam, pushing the Frisco lead to 5-1. The Missions added three more tallies in the bottom of the second, but Luis Mieses plated a run with an RBI single in the third and **Sebastian Walcott** chalked an RBI double in the fourth frame to extend the lead to 7-4. That lead stayed until **Josh Hatcher** knocked in Zavala on a fielder's choice in the seventh to make it 8-4. The Missions then came back with two runs of their own in the bottom of the seventh to pull within 8-6. Leading by two in the ninth, **Keyber Rodriguez** drove in Zavala with an RBI single and Mieses added the exclamation point with a three-run blast, his fourth home run of the season, to balloon the lead to 12-6. **Nick Krauth** (2-0) earned the win with three strong innings from the bullpen while **Travis MacGregor** and **Larson Kindreich** also had scoreless outings in relief.

NO-HITTER NOTES:

The RoughRiders completed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history on Wednesday. It was the third nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, the first no-hitter since **Joe Wieland** no-hit San Antonio on July 29th, 2011 at Wolff Stadium and the fourth no-hitter against San Antonio in franchise history. It was also the third combined no-hitter in franchise history and first since **Neftali Feliz** and **Trey Hodges** no-hit San Antonio in six innings on August 19th, 2008 at Wolff Stadium.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .300 (12-for-40)/.442/.550/.992 over his last 13 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (24) and is fourth in OBP (.415) while leading the league in walk rate (25.5 percent), a mark which also ranks fifth in Minor League Baseball.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders have dominated the Missions over the last four years, but sludgehammered them in 2024. The Riders went 20-4 against the Missions last year and 12-1 at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Since 2021, Frisco is 36-8 at The Wolff and 63-28 (.692) overall against the Padres affiliate.

THE ROAD IS WHERE MY HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season, going 10-5 away from Riders Field. **Keyber Rodriguez** (.400) leads active Texas League players in road batting average. **Josh Hatcher** has hit all of his four home runs on the road, tied for the league lead. Frisco's 17 road home runs are second in the league. The Riders have averaging 5.9 runs per game on the road vs. 4.2 runs per game at home.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

The RoughRiders have pitched very well out of the bullpen in five May games, allowing just nine earned run over 34.1 innings (2.34 ERA). Overall, the RoughRiders have a 3.54 ERA out of the bullpen (ranked fifth in the Texas League).

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first five starts, his 2.45 ERA is tied for the eighth-best to begin a season in recorded franchise history. His 3.7 percent walk rate is the third-best in the Texas League while 7.25 K/BB is also third-best.

SCORE, SCORE, SCORE SOME MORE:

Outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** is off to a great start scoring runs in 2025. Osuna's 25 runs scored are tied for the most in the Texas League this season (Jac Caglianone, 25). The outfielder ended a 17-game hitting streak on Wednesday, in which he hit .391 (25-for-64)/.453/.547/1.000 with 12 runs scored in the 17 games with six walks to five strikeouts. His hitting streak was tied for the third-longest in franchise history. Since his streak started on April 15th, the outfielder is second in the Texas League with his .361 batting average. Osuna is also second in the Texas League with 35 hits (Jac Caglianone, 38). After hitting .306 in 57 games for the Riders last year, he is hitting .304 through 28 games this season. His strikeout rate of 21.5 percent last year has dropped to 13.5 percent this season, but his slugging percentage of .523 last year has dropped to .443 this season so far.

KEYBERRRRR. RODRIGUEZ IS ANYTHING BUT COLD:

Keyber Rodriguez has been fantastic at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over his 24 games this season, he is hitting .341 (30-for-88)/.394/.466/.860. He is second in the Texas League with his .345 average, but Peyton Wilson, who leads the league with a .392 average, is in Triple-A currently. So, Rodriguez is the active TL batting leader. In his last 16 games, he is slashing .377 (23-for-61)/.415/.541/.956 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, 12 RBIs, six runs scored, four walks and six stolen bases. On a six-game hitting streak, he is slashing .417 (10-for-24)/.440/.667/1.107. Over the season, he has seven multi-hit games.

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON
