TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes open a six-game series at The Diamond in Lake Elsinore, taking on the Lake Elsinore Storm (SD). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field at the completion of this series, opening a six-gamer against Visalia on Tuesday, June 4th. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: This is the tenth of 30 match-ups and the fourth of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 6-3 against the Storm in 2024, 1-2 here at The Diamond. Last season, the Quakes won the season-series (17-13).

LAST GAME: The Quakes ended their season-worst seven-game skid on Sunday, taking an 11-4 win over the Modesto Nuts at LoanMart Field. Dodger rehabbers Bobby Miller and Evan Phillips combined for four innings to get Sunday's game started, but it was the offense that finally contributed with their first big day of the series. Kendall George, Josue De Paula and Oswaldo Osorio all had multi-hit games to lead Rancho's nine-hit attack. Rancho reliever Robinson Ortiz (2-0) got the win, while reliever Jose Rodriguez fired three scoreless innings with six strikeouts for his first save of the year. Modesto reliever Pedro De Costa Lemos (3-1) suffered the loss.

NOW THAT THAT'S OVER WITH: The Quakes had a tough home stand, finishing 4-8 which included a seven-game losing streak, their longest stretch of futility this year. The Quakes scored 33 runs over their most recent series against Modesto and did not hit a single home run. Their team batting average entered the Modesto series second in the league at .259 and now enters this series against Lake Elsinore ten points lower at .249, now third in the league. Despite dropping five of six to Modesto last week, Rancho's lead in the South remained exactly where it began the week, at three over Lake Elsinore. Rancho's largest lead this year was a five-game lead over the Storm.

BOBBY MILLER: Dodgers' right-hander Bobby Miller made his first career appearance on Sunday for the Quakes, allowing three runs, all in the second inning, on four hits with four strikeouts and two walks in a no-decision. Miller is slated to make two more rehab starts, but the location of those two starts is still to be determined. Right shoulder inflammation has sidelined Miller for the last six weeks. Miller is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA this season across three starts. Miller was a first-rounder (29th overall) in 2020 out of Louisville. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

EVAN PHILLIPS: Dodgers' closer Evan Phillips, pitched a 1-2-3 fourth inning with two strikeouts on Sunday, marking his first appearance ever in a Rancho uniform. Phillips has been on the Injured List since May 6, due to a grade one hamstring injury. Phillips has a 0.66 ERA across 14 appearances this year, allowing one earned run over 13.2 innings, collecting eight saves along the way. Phillips was originally drafted by Atlanta in the 17th round of the 2015 draft out of UNC Wilmington. He was designated for assignment by Tampa Bay in August of 2021 and claimed by the Dodgers.

GARRETT MCDANIELS: Garrett McDaniels makes his ninth appearance and fifth start of the year, his second against the Storm. In his only outing against the Storm, he allowed two runs on three hits over 4.2 innings in a no-decision on April 23. In his last outing, he allowed two runs on three hits over four innings in a loss to Modesto on May 22. He signed with the Dodgers as an undrafted free agent in 2023 out of Mount Olive College in North Carolina.

FERNANDO SANCHEZ: Left-hander Fernando Sanchez makes his eighth appearance and sixth start of the year, his second start against the Quakes. In his lone game against Rancho, he allowed two hits and one walk over three scoreless innings in a no-decision on April 23. His last outing was against San Jose on May 21, where he allowed just one run on two hits over five innings. Sanchez signed with the Padres out of Mexico in 2019.
