Today: The Lugnuts go for their second series win of 2021 in the finale of a six-game series at the Lake County Captains. The Nuts are 8-9 against the Caps this year, 5-7 in Lansing and 3-2 in Eastlake, entering the final meeting of the year. Lansing right-hander **Jack Cushing**, who tossed 5 1/3 scoreless innings in the opener, takes on Lake County right-hander **Mason Hickman**. With a victory, Cushing would tie for the league lead with six wins -- in just his seventh appearance and sixth start in the High-A Central.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Captains 2. A quintet of pitchers - **Charlie Cerny**, **José Mora**, **Shohei Tomioka**, **Norge Ruiz** and **Brock Whittlesey** - limited the Caps to a pair of solo tallies, one in the 3rd inning and one in the 4th inning, and **Cobie Vance** slugged a no-doubt two-run homer to left to lift the Nuts to victory.

On Deck: The Lugnuts return home to enjoy an off day tomorrow before welcoming third-place Dayton to town from August 10-15.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG-NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Something's Got to Give: The Lugnuts have won all six games in which **Jack Cushing** has pitched... but they've also lost their last seven games played on Sunday.

Going Yard: With yesterday's **Cobie Vance** roundtripper, the Lugnuts have now hit 20 roundtrippers in 17 games against Lake County this year, compared to 38 home runs in their other 66 games.

So Many Starters: With **Charlie Cerny** receiving a spot start last night, the Nuts have now used 16 different starting pitchers this season, specifically **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Cerny**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Jorge Juan**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

S-A-T-U-R-D-A-Y NIGHT: With last night's result, the Nuts improved to 11-3 in Saturday games this season, their most successful day of the week. The Lugnuts' top Saturday hitters: **Cobie Vance** (.333/.423/.556, four doubles, two homers, including one last night) and **William Simoneit** (.306/.382/.531, three doubles, one triple, two homers).

Blue Rocks Report: On July 30, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Oakland Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison** (who each homered in last night's romp over Texas). Millas debuted on Thursday, Guasch debuted Friday, and Shuman debuted last night, tossing five innings and allowing four runs on four hits (two homers) and two walks with seven strikeouts in a loss to Bowling Green.

Alumni Report: **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who played for the 2017 Lansing squad at 18 years old, is second in the Majors in home runs (34), first in RBIs (85), third in on-base percentage (.410), third in slugging percentage (.629), first in OPS (1.039), first in total bases (249), and second in runs scored (84) behind 2017 Lugnuts teammate **Bo Bichette** (86). 2019 Lugnuts outfielder **Griffin Conine** leads the Minors with 29 home runs.

Going Once, Going Twice: With his start this afternoon, **Jack Cushing** becomes the second Lugnuts pitcher to make two starts in the same series, joining **Shohei Tomioka** from last series against Fort Wayne. Lansing had utilized a six-man rotation throughout the season, but that ended against Fort Wayne due to the trading of starters **Seth Shuman** and **Richard Guasch** to Washington. Lake County is one of the few other teams in the league to also utilize a six-pitcher rotation.

Nutlympics Report: Event 3, Juggling, was held before Saturday night's game, with **Jared McDonald** winning the gold medal, **DJ Lee** capturing silver and **Yerdel Vargas** taking bronze. Event 2, Grape Catching, was held on Wednesday, with the pairing of tosser **Brock Whittlesey** and catcher **William Simoneit** winning gold, followed by **Leudeny Pineda/Elvis Peralta, Jr.** taking silver, and **Jorge Juan/José Mora** earning bronze. Event 1, Fungo Golf, came last Sunday, opening the Nutlympics, with **Anthony Phillips** winning gold, **Javier Godard** silver and **Charles Hall** bronze.

The Lugnuts are 8-9 in 2021 and 91-92 vs. the Captains all-time, with a record of 53-47 vs. the Caps at home, compared to 38-46 in Eastlake. In 2019, the Nuts won the series, 10-9.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: Dawel Lugo became the 3rd Nut to be traded, joining Tim Locastro (LAD) and Jesus Tinoco (COL), shipped to the Arizona Diamondbacks in exchange for Cliff Pennington. Starlyn Surliel gave up a home run to Joe Bennie on the game's first pitch and then settled in to strike out 12 batters in 6 1/3 innings in an 8-5 win over Beloit at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2018: The Lugnuts won their third consecutive game by the same exact 5-4 score, knocking off the Dayton Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium. (On August 9th, the next day, the Lugnuts beat the Dragons 4-3.)

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 159 all-time - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18, outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17, pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 and pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltran** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor**'s franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

All-Time Roster History: Catcher **Cooper Uhl** became the newest Lugnut to debut on August 5, the 47th different player on the ballclub this season and the 851st Lugnuts player all-time.

Last Appearance: Started series opener, August 3 at LC... earned the victory with 5 1/3 scoreless innings, striking out six while limiting the Captains to three hits (two Micah Pries singles, one Aaron Bracho single) and one walk (George Valera)... 83 pitches, 52 strikes.

2021 in Lansing: The Lugnuts have won all six games in which Cushing has pitched.

- Debuted in the High-A Central against the Dayton Dragons, July 2, with a dominating performance: 6 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 6 K... allowed only one hit through five scoreless innings before giving up a run in final frame... Lugnuts cruised to 10-3 victory over Dayton.
- Started Game 2 of doubleheader, July 9 at Great Lakes: tossed 7-inning CG, 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 9 K on 84 pitches (57 strikes) in Lugnuts' 2-1 win... came four outs from throwing a no-hitter, broken up by Leonel Valera's two-out single in the 6th.
- July 15 vs. Lake County, pitched in relief, piggybacking Shohei Tomioka (4 IP, 2 H, 0 R) and firing the final five innings scorelessly to complete a five-hit 4-0 shutout of the Captains... result was even more impressive considering Captains scored 48 runs in the other four games of the series.
- July 22 at West Michigan: dominated the Whitecaps through five scoreless innings before tiring and allowing two runs in 6th and final inning... fanned eight batters in Nuts' 5-2 victory.
- July 29 vs. Fort Wayne: gave up eight hits and two walks in 5 2/3 innings, with runners constantly on base, yet allowed only three fourth-inning runs while striking out seven... Lugnuts rallied from 3-1 deficit with one in the 7th and four in the 8th against Austin Smith for 6-3 win.

2021 in the Low-A West:

- Began the season as the No. 3 starter in Stockton's rotation and blasted out of the gates with four hitless innings, walking three and striking out two, against the Modesto Nuts, May 6.
- Finished May with a 0.92 ERA in four starts: 2 ER in 19 2/3 IP, 7 BB, 23 K and a .147 opponent average.
- Struck out 10 batters in six innings at Rancho Cucamonga, May 27, allowing two hits, one walk and one run.
- In June, posted a 4.71 ERA in four starts, with 11 ER in 21 IP, 3 BB, 20 K, .321 avg., though of the four starts, two were poor (4 HR in 5 IP vs. San Jose, June 10; 7 R/4 ER in 4 1/3 IP at Fresno, June 17) and two were outstanding (5.2 IP, 2 R, 8 K vs. Lake Elsinore, June 3; and 6 IP, 1 UER, 0 BB, 4 K at Inland Empire, June 24).
- Handled right-handers: .221/.292/.379... lefties hit .281/.288/.421... of 10 BB, nine were to right-handers.
- Opposing base-stealers were 5-for-7 in success rate.

Going Pro: Drafted in the 22nd round, 2019, signing with the A's for \$1,000... signing scout: Tripp Faulk, who also signed the Lugnuts' DJ Lee, Bryce Nightengale and Elvis Peralta, Jr., and was the scout for 2021 Oakland Athletics draft picks Zack Gelof (2nd round) and Aaron Holiday (13th round).

2019 Pro Debut: Opened in AZL with two appearances for A's Gold before making 11 appearances, 6 starts, with Short-Season Vermont... in best appearance, 8/1/19, pitching five shutout two-hit innings at State College, striking out two... opposition went 4-for-5 in stealing bases against him.

Personal: Born in Enid, Oklahoma - the ninth-largest city in the state - Cushing moved to Colorado for "several years" before his family relocated to Flower Mound, 28 miles northwest of Dallas, when he was seven... parents were pilots in the Air Force, and then later pilots for Delta, hence the moves... grew up rooting for the Texas Rangers... Flower Mound is named for, yes, a flowering mound - a 50-foot tall hill nicknamed "The Mound," maintained by The Mound Foundation, which features dozens of flowers naturally blooming each spring... Flower Mound is located 28 miles northwest of Dallas, on Grapevine Lake... in his spare time, enjoys hunting, fishing, hiking and going to the beach... currently resides in Jupiter, Florida, where he worked on a golf course during the 2020 hiatus.

Glory Days: Attended Marcus High School... named team captain as a senior, going 6-2 with a 0.73 ERA to earn the honor of District 6-6A Pitcher of the Year... was named to the Texas Sports Writer's Association Class 6-A All-State Team and Dallas Morning News All-Area Team... set Marcus H.S. career records in no-hitters and shutouts, ranking second all-time in wins and innings and third in complete games... played two years on the Marcus H.S. varsity football team.

Legend in the Family: Sister Lexi ended her softball career at Middle Tennessee State University (2017-2020) as the Blue Raiders' all-time record holder in home runs (50), RBIs (145), total bases (371), putouts (1500) and sacrifice flies (T-1, 7).

Hoya Saxa: Attended Georgetown University, where he set the program's career strikeout record (236) with 11 K's in his final college appearance, 5/17/19 vs. Butler at Shirley Povich Field... set Georgetown's single-game strikeout record with 16 K's vs. Mount St. Mary's, 3/5/19... notched 87 strikeouts total in 79 1/3 innings as a senior in 15 games, 12 starts, leading the Hoyas with a 3.06 ERA... Named All-Big East Second Team, Big East Honor Roll, and Big East All-Academic Team... baseball greats from Georgetown include legendary scout Clyde Sukeforth, Doc White, speedster Art Devlin, and Del Bissonette... the only Hoyas to reach the Majors in the last 50 years: Sean Maloney (1997-98) and Tim Adelman (2016-17).

Lansing Connection: Played for 2018 Lugnuts hitting coach (and current Dunedin Blue Jays hitting coach) Matt Young on the Dallas Mustangs... teammates with Zac Cook, currently playing for the Dunedin Blue Jays.
