LAST GAME

The Baysox capped off their seventh win in the last ten games with a 3-2 triumph over the Harrisburg Senators Tuesday night. Back-to-back doubles from TT Bowens and Donta' Williams kicked off the second inning and got Bowie on the board. After plating Bowens, Williams would come home to score later in the frame on a Tim Susnara RBI groundout, stretching the Baysox advantage to 2-0. Harrisburg would plate a run in the third on a Donovan Casey RBI single and a run in the fourth on a Jose Sanchez RBI sac fly, against Baysox starter Peter Van Loon to tie the game at two. In the fifth, right-hander Garrett Stallings would take over and go the rest of the way for Bowie, retiring 15 of 16 batters faced en route to five shutout innings. The Baysox took the lead in the fifth on a two-out opposite field double from Coby Mayo, giving them a 3-2 lead they would not relinquish.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators enter play this week with a record of 22-23 - good for third place in the Southwest division and two-and-a-half games out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg split a six-game series in Reading last week, losing each of the last three contests. The Senators won five of six in Harrisburg against the Baysox back in the second week of May. Harrisburg has the fewest home runs (31) and road home runs (14) hit in the Eastern League, and the second fewest in Double-A, while the Bowie staff has allowed the second-most home runs at home (35) in the league. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the Nationals' top two prospects, according to MLB Pipeline - James Wood (No. 1 WSH/No. 7 overall) and Robert Hassell III (No. 2 WSH/No. 44 overall) patrolling the outfield. RHPs Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 27 WSH) alongside LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 23 WSH) feature on the Harrisburg pitching staff.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The Senators look to hand the ball to southpaw Alemao Hernandez tonight. Hernandez has gone five frames in each of his last two starts, and he continues to settle into a starting role for Harrisburg. The left-hander has allowed 13 hits in 14 innings through three starts for the Senators since his promotion to Double-A on 5/12. Hernandez made his Double-A debut against the Baysox on 5/13, pitching to a no-decision after allowing a single run on three hits to go along with four strikeouts. Hernandez started the season in High-A Wilmington, with an ERA of 9.00 through four relief appearances (10 innings). Hernandez had pitched in the Mexican Pacific Winter League since 2021, also representing his country of Mexico in the Caribbean Series, prior to being signed by the Nationals' organization in March. He last pitched in the minor leagues in 2019, when he was a member of the Dodgers' organization for three seasons after being signed in July of 2016. He posted a career 3.32 ERA as a member of the Dodgers' farm, but never appeared in a game at a level above rookie ball.

ONE CLUTCH CONDIMENT

Coby Mayo has been an RBI machine for the Baysox on their recent hot stretch. Mayo has a team-high 23 RBI on the season, including 10 in his last eight games. In that span, Mayo has three-multi RBI games, and has produced four game-winning runs for the Baysox. Mayo has also provided serious pop as of late, with an extra-base hit (five doubles, three home runs) in eight of his last nine games. Mayo leads the Eastern League and sits second in all of Double-A with 15 doubles and third in Double-A with 23 extra-base hits. He also has an active 15-game on-base streak - third longest by a member of the Baysox this season.

SLIPPING UP

The 46 errors committed by the Baysox this season are the most at the Double-A level. This comes after a season where Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors, an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season, Bowie is on pace for 144 total errors.

TERRY TATERS

TT Bowens has helped rejuvenate the Baysox lineup the past two weeks. Since making his Double-A debut on 5/16, Bowens leads Bowie with a .341 average and three home runs. Bowens' five doubles and eight extra-base hits in that span are tied with Coby Mayo for the team lead as well. The Baysox lineup is averaging 4.6 runs per game in the past 13 games, after averaging 3.9 runs per game prior.

TURNING A CORNER ON TANDEM TROUBLES?

Bowie has struggled with statistical splits relating to its starting pitching this season, but may be beginning to find some consistency. This season, Baysox starting pitchers have managed a 3.26 ERA in 193 innings, compared to a 5.73 ERA in 81.2 innings when arms with starting experience enter games as relievers. However, the arms in the back end of these tandems have combined for a 0.79 ERA (2 ER in 22.2 IP) in the past six games where a tandem has been used. Bowie has won five of those six contests. In total, the Baysox are 10-2 this season when a tandem combines for 3 ER or fewer and 0-12 when a tandem combines for 4 ER or more.

- Started the 12th No-Hitter in franchise history (5th Nine-Inning) on 5/19 when firing five innings against Altoona
- Opened the season with 13 consecutive scoreless innings, currently the longest scoreless streak for a Baysox pitcher this season.
- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft.
- Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Darner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

NOTES BY OUTING*

- Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
- 12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning)** Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit. Nolan Hofman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief.
- For the second-consecutive start, fired five hitless innings, but walked six more batters. Collected two outs to start the sixth, but allowed a single and two-run home run. Bowie only scored one run.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization.
