Bolte finished the game 3-for-4 with a single, double, homer, HBP and stolen base.

- The Lugnuts' best hitter on Fridays this year? **Cameron Masterman**, hitting .333 (5-for-15).
- Should the Lugs take the lead, watch out for **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, who is batting .370 (10-for-27) when Lansing is in front.

#### Streaking:

- **Cameron Masterman** enters today on a 16-game on-base streak, one shy of **Will Simpson's** team high set in April.
- **Henry Bolte** is riding a seven-game hitting streak, tied with **Euribiel Angeles'** team high mark from earlier in the year. Over those seven games, Bolte is 12-for-27 with 6 BB, 4 2B, 3 HR, 4 SB, slashing .444/.571/.926.

**Pride of Palo Alto:** 20-year-old Bolte, the youngest player on the team, is 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (31), tied for 3rd in steals (16), tied for 4th in total bases (64), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (16) and tied for 7th in home runs (6). Overall in May, he has drawn 14 walks and scored 15 runs in 14 games.

**Individual Efforts:** **Brayan Buelvas** is tied for 5th in walks (25), tied for 7th in runs (25), tied for 7th in RBIs (25) and tied for 6th in steals (12); **Colby Halter** is tied for 2nd in walks (27) with **Will Simpson**; meanwhile, Simpson is tied for 1st in triples with teammate **Euribiel Angeles** (3) and ranks 4th in OBP (.459) and 4th in OPS (.974).

**Team Effort:** Lansing's offense tops the Midwest League with 14 triples, is tied for 1st with Great Lakes in walks (178), ranks 2nd in hits, 2nd in total bases (457), 2nd in runs scored (189), 2nd in team OBP (.348) and 2nd in team OPS (.727).

**Down to the End:** 13 of the last 15 Lansing games have included a save for either the Lugnuts or the opposition.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 28). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and **Will Johnston** at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization, writing "Morales is a wild card given his age and lack of experience, yet those also make it easy to dream on the package of stuff and tools, and he offers as much upside as anyone in this system."

**Return to Glory:** Closer **Colton Johnson**, who missed all of the 2022 and 2023 seasons due to injury, leads the Midwest League with 14 appearances and is tied for 2nd with five saves.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2009:** The Lugnuts and Dragons went to the 12th inning in a scoreless tie, but Dayton snapped the deadlock with three runs against Jonas Cuotto for a 3-0 win. The game was played in three hours and 19 minutes. (This was a bad year for the Lugnuts in extra innings: They went 1-14, losing their first 12 extra-inning games of the year.)

**2012:** The Nuts topped Fort Wayne, 5-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium, thanks to four hitless innings from starter Noah Syndergaard (striking out three) followed by four innings of two-hit, one-run ball from Anthony DeSclafani (striking out eight).

**2018:** The Lugnuts extended their winning streak to nine with their second four-game home sweep of the year against the Dayton Dragons, 4-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium. The game was played in two hours and 12 minutes. Turner Larkins led the way with six scoreless innings, striking out seven. The Dragons' only run came with two outs in the ninth on a Stuart Fairchild RBI single off Brody Rodning.

**Retrospective:** Signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023, and motored through four levels in his professional debut.

**In a Nutshell:** Opened 2024 on the Lugnuts' Injured List, activated April 29... set a career high for professional innings pitched in April 30th season debut with 4 2/3 innings... limiting right-handers to .190/.261/.333 (4-for-21) compared to lefties (.375/.500/.438, 6-for-16)... leadoff hitters have reached in nine of 12 innings pitched, with four singles, one double, one triple and three walks.

**Prospecting:** Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

**Path to Lansing:** Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... strikeouts high: 6, 6/20/23.

**In a Nutshell:** Opened the season in a tandem with Jose Dicochea, relieving Dicochea the second day of the season, April 6 at Dayton, and receiving his first start of the year, April 13 vs. Great Lakes... moved full-time to a relief role following Luis Morales starts when Morales joined the Lugnuts on April 29... coming off finest appearance of the year, with four scoreless one-hit innings at Great Lakes, May 11.

**Statistically Relevant:** Has dominated right-handers (.156/.250/.311, 5 BB, 15 K) compared to left-handers meeting slightly greater success (.220/.327/.317, 7 BB, 3 K)... has faced Lake County once, tossing three hitless innings in relief on April 18th.

**Home Cooking:** Born in Barquisimeto in the state of Lara, where former Lugnut and current Diamondbacks catcher Gabby Moreno was also born... cousin is Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco, in his 15th year in the Major Leagues and a current member of the Cleveland Guardians rotation; Carlos Carrasco led the Majors in victories (18) in 2017 and finished 4th in A.L. Cy Young voting.

**Minor League Path:** Signed at age 16 by Ruben Barradas in 2018... debuted on June 19, 2019, in the Arizona League... following the canceled season of 2020, split 2021 between the Arizona Complex League and the California League, working out of the Stockton bullpen... repeated in the AzCL and Cal League in 2022... spent all of 2023 pitching for Stockton... tossed six innings for the Ports on four different occasions, finishing the season with six shutout five-hit innings on September 7 at San Jose, with no walks and nine strikeouts... posted 6.57 home ERA in Stockton, 3.12 ERA on the road.
