LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones captured a second-straight series victory with a 5-2 win over Aberdeen on Sunday afternoon...Brooklyn erupted for three runs in the bottom of the eighth to take the lead on a bases-loaded walk to DH **Junior Tillen** and a two-run double by LF **José Hernández**. CF **Omar De Los Santos** collected a base knock and stole a pair of bags...SS **William Lugo** worked three walks in the contest...RHP **Brett Banks** posted a scoreless inning of relief or his second win, while RHP **Josh Hejka** tossed a scoreless ninth for his first save.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: OF **Nick Morabito** and C **Christopher Suero** joined the Cyclones roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday...Morabito posted an eye-popping .397 average (31-78) in 24 games in the Florida State League...The 21-year-old added five extra-base hits, one home run, 10 RBI, and 11 stolen bases...At the time of his promotion, Morabito was leading the Florida State League in hitting (.397), on-base percentage (.530), and OPS (1.043)...He also ranked third in slugging (.513), hits (31), and stolen bases (11), while tied for sixth in walks (18), and seventh in total bases (40)...Entering play on Tuesday, Morabito is second in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.530), third in batting average (.397), and sixth in wRC+ (210)...Suero joins the Cyclones after garnering a .265 clip (22-83) in 25 FSL games...The 20-year-old added nine extra-base knocks, two home runs, and 15 RBI...Suero departed the FSL tied for the league lead in runs scored (18) and tied for seventh in RBI (15)...RHP **Jake Stevenson** was signed by the New York Mets to a minor league contract and assigned to Brooklyn...The 27-year-old collected a 1.85 ERA (5 ER in 241 IP) in 22 appearances (one start) for High-A Greensboro in the South Atlantic League last year...C **Carlos Oviedo** was also added to the roster from the Florida Complex League and placed on the Development List...In corresponding moves, C **José Hernández** and INF **Kevin Villavicencio** were transferred to Single-A St. Lucie, and C **Drake Osborn** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton.

GOING BACK TO BACK: The Cyclones shut out the IronBirds for the second-straight day with a 4-0 win on Saturday...RHP **Nolan McLean** (5.0 IP), RHP **Victor Castañeda** (2.0), and RHP **Ben Simon** (2.0) combined on a five-hitter...On Friday, RHP **Brandon Sproat** (5.0), RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (2.2), and RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.1) united to one-hit Aberdeen, 2-0...The back-to-back shutouts are the first for the Cyclones at the full-season level and the first since Brooklyn blanked the Connecticut Tigers on the road in both ends of a doubleheader on August 23, 2019...RHP **Michel Otañez** (4.1), RHP **Mitch Ragan** (1.2), and RHP **Josh Hejka** (1.0) united on a 4-0 win in Game 1, while RHP **Dan Goggin** (2.0), RHP **Hunter Parsons** (2.0), and RHP **Jared Biddy** (3.0) led the charge to a 5-0 victory in Game 2...It is also the first for Brooklyn in consecutive nine-inning games since August 21-22, 2014, vs. Staten Island and Tri-City...RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (5.0), LHP **Brad Wieck** (2.0), LHP **Kelly Secrest** (1.0), and LHP **Shane Bay** (1.0) twirled the Cyclones to a 2-0 win over Staten Island in the first leg...RHP **Martires Arias** (5.0), RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** (2.0), and RHP **Cameron Griffin** (2.0) provided the zeroes in a 7-0 rout of Tri-City on the back end...Saturday's blanking marked the fifth of the season for Brooklyn's pitching staff...The five shutouts are the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the most in all of Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

COUNTDOWN TO 1K: After Sunday's 5-2 win over Aberdeen, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now three wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 997-840 (.543) in 1,837 games since 2001...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown...Since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021, the Cyclones are 199-209 (.488) in 408 games.

SWIPING THE TOP SPOT: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (54) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...De Los Santos enters Tuesday's contest 17-for-18 stealing bases to start the season...The 17 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for fifth throughout the minors...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is sixth across the Minors in steals (124).

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 48 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.70 ERA (23 ER in 76.2 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 18 and striking out 69.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie last Monday and punched out seven batters against Aberdeen in his High-A debut last Thursday...In six appearances (four starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 23.2 IP)...No pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings this year without allowing an earned run...Entering play on Tuesday, the Markham, Ont. native is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (48.9%)...Single-A Lynchburg's LHP **Matt Wilkinson** (50.5%) is first...Tong's 39.8% strikeout-to-walk rate is also second in MiLB to Wilkinson (40.7%)...Tong's 43 strikeouts are good for fifth-most in the minors.

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP **Nolan McLean** continued his incredible start to his career on Saturday afternoon...The 22-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 13.0 straight by tossing five spotless frames on Saturday vs. Aberdeen, en route to his second victory...Over his last three starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 13.0 IP), allowing just six hits and three walks (6.82 BB%), adding 16 strikeouts (36.36 K%)...In addition to his success on the mound, McLean enters play on Tuesday with eight extra-base hits with eight...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 30 fewer plate appearances (44) than any other player with 8+ extra-base knocks.

DOOGIE HOWSER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** had his 12.0-inning scoreless streak snapped in the third inning on Sunday...Orellana began the year with 81 consecutive

vs. ROME: Brooklyn opens its only two-week road trip of the season against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors possess nine of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Spencer Schwellenbach** (3), RHP **Owen Murphy** (5), RHP **Drue Hackenberg** (10), INF **David McCabe** (12), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (13), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (18), INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (21), RHP **Lucas Braun** (24), and RHP **Blake Burkhalter** (27)... This marks the first ever meeting between the Rome and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Rome will visit Coney Island from July 23-28.

spotless frames out of the bullpen...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 20.0 innings of work, Orellana sits third in opposing OPS (.427) and fewest hits allowed (10), fourth in ERA (1.33) and seventh in WHIP (0.98)...On April 24 vs. Wilmington, in relief, the 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced - striking out six - in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito Garcia** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit.

NICK THE STICK: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native reached base three times last Tuesday, adding a pair of extra-base hits and a career-high-tying three RBI...Lorusso is one of two Cyclones with a multi-extra-base hit contest in 2024 and the only one to accomplish the feat on multiple occasions...Coming into Tuesday's contest, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), sixth in slugging (.537), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (10), seventh in OPS (.902), tied for seventh in doubles (6), and tied for 10th in RBI (14).

FEAR THE HAWK: RHP **Dakota Hawkins** continued his stellar start to his 2024 season last Thursday with four innings of shutout relief...Since one out in the bottom of the eighth on April 19 at Jersey Shore, the 24-year-old has not allowed a run...The 8.2-consecutive scoreless frames is the longest spotless stretch by a Brooklyn reliever this year...Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for third in strikeouts (23), fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (11.50), and ninth in innings pitched (15.2).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 14.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old is tied for the fewest hits allowed (5)...Lawson also ranks second in ERA (0.63) and WHIP (0.70).

KING STANLEY: With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning last Friday, OF **Stanley Consuegra** became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 100 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in last Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

YOUTH IS SERVED: **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Cyclones have five of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 6), **Brandon Sproat** (10), **Nolan McLean** (11), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus six of the Top 30 per MiLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), **Wilfredo Lara** (23), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his third-straight loss on Wednesday night vs. Aberdeen...Permitted three runs (one earned) on five hits over four innings...Walked a season-high-tying three and struck out four...Tossed 82 pitches and 48 strikes (58.54%)...Relieved by RHP **Brett Banks** to start the top of the fifth with the Cyclones trailing, 3-2...IronBirds went on to win the contest, 6-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all 6.0 innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final 8 appearances (7 starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
