### SUNDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox won the final two games of the series in Hartford, winning Sunday's contest by a final of 5-1. Starting right-hander **Braxton Bragg** earned his first Double-A win with eight strikeouts in five innings. **Doug Hodo** smashed a two-run homer and **Max Wagner** collected two extra base hits and two RBI. The bullpen of **Houston Roth**, **Daniel Lloyd** and **Keagan Gillies** combined for four perfect innings.

### CREED CRUSHES

**C Creed Willems** recorded his first two homer game of the season on Friday and the second of his career. The Orioles No. 12 prospect has a 1.067 OPS over his last 10 games and shares the league lead in doubles with **nine** on the regular season. He has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

### ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is tied for 10th in the Eastern League in hits (25) and is tied for fourth in doubles (8) to start the season. Jackson has struck out only 13 times in 103 total plate appearances (13.9% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career. **The former Angels and Mets farmhand is three homers away from 100 on his career.**

### WALK THIS WAY

**C Silas Ardoine** is tied for the Eastern League in walks (20). **Ardoine has reached base in 10 consecutive starts dating back to April 23.** No player has drawn more walks in the Eastern League since April 23 than Ardoine. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

### TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** has collected a hit in five consecutive games and is batting .417 (5-for-12) with a double, two homers and four RBI to start the month of May. The 24-year-old began the season on a 16-game on-base streak, which is tied for the longest in the Eastern League. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is third in the league in walks (19) and is ninth in OBP (.396).

### BRIGHT LIGHTS

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his sixth start of the season for Chesapeake. The Orioles No. 25 prospect struck out a season-high six batters in five innings on Wednesday against Hartford but allowed five runs on four hits and three walks. Bright has given up four or more earned runs in each of his last three starts.

### BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.04 ERA, which is third-best in the Eastern League and sixth-best in all of Double-A. Last season, the bullpen threw the most innings and struck out the most batters out of any Double-A club.

### ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the fourth-fewest runs in all of Double-A (87), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with **nine** so far this season.

### SIZING UP THE SEA DOGS

The Portland Sea Dogs are the Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. The Sea Dogs played two doubleheaders last week in New Hampshire and won five of eight in Manchester. Portland's active roster features six Red Sox Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): OF Jhostynxon Garcia (No. 6), RHP David Sandlin (No. 9), LHP Connelly Early (No. 10), IF Mikey Romero (No. 12), RHP Yordanny Monegro (No. 24), and RHP Blake Wehunt (No. 28).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Jack Anderson is set to make his first Double-A start in what looks to be a bullpen game for the Sea Dogs. This will be Anderson's third career start in his 124th career appearance. The 25-year-old has allowed only one run in 10.2 innings pitched to start the season (0.84 ERA). Anderson was acquired by the Red Sox from the Tigers in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 Draft this past offseason.

Arsenal: Fastball, Cutter, Curveball, Changeup, Splitter

Ranked the Orioles No. 25 prospect, via MLB Pipeline

Delivered 1,305th Baysox strikeout last year, setting new franchise single-season record

**2025:** Struck out season-high six batters in five innings on 4/30 @ HFD. Earned first Double-A win in 32 career starts after delivering first hitless start of AA career on 4/12 vs ERI (Gm 2) with 5.2 IP. Enters third stint (second full season) with Chesapeake.

**2024:** Completed third season in Orioles organization and first full season in Double-A with Bowie as a full-time starter. Eclipsed 100.0 IP for first time in career with 112.0 IP but allowed a career-high 60 BB. 2nd on team in IP and K (120). Led Eastern League in walks but finished 8th in K. Delivered 1,305th strikeout of the season in final start of year, which set a new Baysox single-season franchise record. Threw 4th-most IP, struck out 8th-most batters, and allowed 2nd-most BB in O's system. One of two winless starters in all of Double-A (minimum 20 starts). Went 5.0+ IP in only four starts. Baysox went 9-18 when Bright started. Started season strong with a 2.41 ERA in month of April (9th-lowest in EL) over 18.2 IP with 23 K. Ended season strong with a 1.93 ERA in 14.0 IP in September.

**Career Notes:** Began '23 in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in K. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in K. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least 4.0 innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.... Debuted professionally in '22 with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27.

**College:** Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were 4th- most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with 3rd round pick Nolan McLean...Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

## COACHING STAFF

### **ROBERTO MERCADO**

#### *Manager*

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

### **JORDIE HENRY**

#### *Pitching Coach*

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

### **JOSH BUNSELMEYER**

#### *Hitting Coach*

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. He spent the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. Bunselmeyer played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at St. Louis University.

#### *Fundamentals Coach*

Chase Sebbby returns for his second season as Baysox Fundamentals Coach in 2025 and his fourth as a member of the Orioles' organization. Before joining the Baysox, Sebbby was the fundamentals coach for High-A Aberdeen in 2023. Prior to that, he was a development coach within the Orioles' system in 2022. Sebbby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

### **CALVIN CHRISTIANSEN**

#### *Development Coach*

Calvin Christiansen joins the Baysox staff for his first season as Baysox Development Coach in 2025. Previously, Christiansen spent three seasons with Single-A Delmarva as a Minor League technology coordinator and most recently as the team's development coach. He is a 2019 graduate of the University of California, Davis.

The updated team name represents a new chapter in Baysox baseball, expanding the brand to better reflect the broad and diverse community of fans who support the team across the region. The Baysox will continue to play at their home, Prince George's Stadium, in Bowie, Maryland.

The Chesapeake Baysox logos were created by Baltimore-based Younts Design, whose clients over the years have included a variety of professional baseball teams (including the Baltimore Orioles).



## ALTERNATE IDENTITIES

### CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

### CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

### BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
