TODAY'S GAMES: Leading the series 2-1, Sugar Land continues their six-game set with the Tacoma Rainiers... Sugar Land is now 9-6 all-time at home against Tacoma and 14-7 all-time against the Rainiers.

ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT: Pedro Leon drove in Rylan Bannon in the first inning to open a 1-0 lead for the Space Cowboys... On the hill, Spencer Arrighetti threw 4.0 scoreless innings and allowed his lone run in the fifth on a double, a single and a sac fly... Sugar Land reclaimed the lead in the bottom of the frame on a triple by JJ Matijevic and an RBI single from Cesar Salazar... Rylan Bannon added on a two-run homer in the seventh, and LHP Nick Allgeyer threw four innings to close out a 4-3 Sugar Land victory.

ROSTER MOVES: 8/4 - RHP Shawn Dubin placed on the 7-Day IL, retro to 8/3... INF Joe Perez clears waivers, outright to Sugar Land and released... LHP Blake Taylor clears waivers, outright to Sugar Land and released 8/3 - RHP Ronel Blanco optioned to Sugar Land... 8/2 - RHP Ronel Blanco recalled by Houston... RHP Matt Ruppenthal reinstated from the Development List... 8/1 - C Cesar Salazar returned from the Houston Taxi Squad...

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 9 players drafted by the Astros, 2 players signed as non-drafted free agents in 2020 and 7 international signings

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys active roster boasts six of the Astros' Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include OF Pedro Leon (#3), OF Justin Dirden (#4), RHP Spencer Arrighetti (#6), RHP Misael Tamarez (#8), RHP Shawn Dubin (#20) & INF Shay Whitcomb (#28)

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 5-9-1 in six-game series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-1 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 3-3-0 in their last six home series and 3-5-0 overall at Constellation Field.

WHIT-BOMB: With a multi-home run night on 7/27, Shay Whitcomb is tied for second in Minor League Baseball in home runs, launching 26 total homer between Corpus Christi (12) and Sugar Land (14), trailing Luken Baker (27)... It was the fourth multi-homer game of the season for Whitcomb and his second with Sugar Land (other, 7/16 vs. ELP).

The Space Cowboys infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs (26), RBI (71), Hits (96), Total Bases (188), T-2nd in Extra-Base Hits (41) & Runs Scored (62)... Whitcomb has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games, going 18-for-69 (.261) with 2 doubles, 5 home runs, 14 RBI, 9 R and 3 SB.

POSITION. PLAYER. PITCHING: In the 10th inning on Wednesday night, Marty Costes made his professional pitching debut... The outfielder walked two batters but got a double play and allowed just one unearned run before picking up the win in a 7-6 Space Cowboys victory... It's the second time this season Sugar Land has used a position player to pitch (Michael Sandle - 5/3 @ ABQ)

SINGLETON AND THE 'STROS: INF Jon Singleton was signed to a Minor League contract by Houston on 6/24 and started that night in Salt Lake... It was the first game Singleton has played in the Astros' organization since 9/4/17... In his first 30 games, Singleton is 37-for-109 (.337) with 5 doubles, 12 home runs, 27 RBI, 24 runs scored and 24 walks... The first baseman reached in his first 11 games with the Space Cowboys and 28 of his first 30 games.

Singleton has homered in 6 of his last 12 games, hitting 7 total, and has reached safely in 14 straight contests, going 21-for-55 (.382) with a .493 OBP, hitting 3 doubles, 7 home runs and driving in 12... His multi-homer game on Thursday was his first multi-homer effort since 7/22/22 @ Louisville with Nashville.

VOTE FOR PEDRO: INF/OF Pedro Leon is currently riding a pair of hot streaks, hitting in 8 straight games... In that span, Leon is 11-for-36 (.306) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 7 RBI, 4 runs scored and 4 stolen bases... The hitting streak is part of a 15-game on-base streak for Leon where he's slashing .328/.400/.508/.908 (20-for-61) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 9 runs scored and has walked 8 times.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE: On Tuesday night, Rylan Bannon and JJ Matijevic both had multi-homer games on Tuesday night... It was the first multi-homer contest of the season for Bannon and his first since 8/19/21 with Norfolk... Coincidentally, Bannon had three multi-homer games in a seven-game span from 8/11-8/19/21... Tuesday was the third multi-homer game of the season for Matijevic, who hit two home runs on 4/5 vs. RR and then again on 4/13 @ OKC.

FLAME THROWER: RHP Misael Tamarez clocked 4 pitches over 99.5 mph on Sunday at Las Vegas, throwing pitches of 99.6 mph (2X), 99.7 mph and 99.9 mph during his 1.1 innings of relief... They are four of the five fastest pitches thrown by Space Cowboys pitchers this year; the only faster pitch was a 100.0 mph fastball from RHP Forrest Whitley on 4/25 @ RNO.

404 ERROR: The Space Cowboys committed six errors on 7/26, including three in the bottom of the ninth inning... The six errors are the most this season in a game and the most in a single game in Space Cowboys history.

BUST OUT THE TAPE MEASURE: OF Pedro Leon launched a two-run homer in the third inning on Saturday night that was measured at 477 feet according to StatCast... That measures as the 5th furthest hit home run in Triple-A in 2023 and the 10th longest home run between Triple-A and Major League Baseball this season... The previous longest home run of the season for Sugar Land belonged to JJ Matijevic, who hit a 470-foot shot against Albuquerque on May 4.

RIDE THE BIKE, PEDRO: On 6/24, Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high among full season MiLB teams.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.
