TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: Altoona opens up a three-game set with Reading tonight.

Luke Russo takes the ball for his second start against the Curve this year, he threw 6.0 innings of 2-run ball on June 25 against the Curve. Russo was Philadelphia's 16th round pick in 2023 out of Eastern Michigan, where he shared the field for his freshman season with former Curve righty Justin Meis.

DEUCES: The Eastern League leader in walks, **Duce Gourson**, was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on Friday, July 17. Gourson, ranks 1st in the league in BB (54), 4th in SB (29), 10th in OBP (.377), he also ranks 1st among Pirates minor leaguers in BB (54), T-3rd in SB (29).

GRAY ZONE: One of the most productive hitters in the minors this season, **Murf Gray**, joined the Curve on Friday, July 17 as the team returned from All-Star Break. Entering play on July 17, Gray ranks among all minor league players in several categories: 8th in HR (23), 9th in RBI (70), 10th in SLG% (.608) and OPS (1.014).

Among Pirates minor leaguers, he is 1st in hits (101), HR (22), RBI (68) and 3rd in 2B (18) across 78 games with Bradenton and Greensboro.

MATTY AG: Righty **Matt Ager** has overcome a rough month of June (18 R in 22.2 IP) and straightened things out across his first two starts in July. After throwing a career-long 7.0 innings on July 4 at Portland, Ager followed it up with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball on Friday, July 10, giving him a 2.08 ERA (3 ER / 13.0 IP) over his last 2 outings.

NICE TO MEET YOU, TITUS DUMITRU: outfielder **Titus Dumitru** had a 14-game on-base streak end just before the break, during which he batted .327 with a .920 OPS. It was the second-longest on-base streak of his season following an 18-gamer in late-May to early-June.

LONNIE LONGBALLS: Outfielder **Lonnie White Jr.** hit his career-high 16th home run of the season on Sunday, July 12 against Richmond. White Jr. is third among Pirates minor leaguers in homers this season, he also matched his career-high with his 45th RBI of the season in the 5-3 loss.

MOSS IS BOSS: Curve 1B **Callan Moss** had a 15-game on-base streak end in the final game before the All-Star break, during which he hit .393 (22-for-56) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 10 RBI and a 1.014 OPS. Since June 12 (25G), Moss is batting .333 with an .833 OPS and recorded 10 multi-hit games. In that time he's raised his season batting average from .246 to .273.

PUPPIES: Among the 21 position players that have suited up for the Curve, 11 have made their Double-A debut this season. Only 5 pitchers (23 total) who have thrown for the team this year have made their level debut.

ITS OUTTA HERE: The Curve have 19 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs. The Curve have hit 83 home runs in 87 games, they're on pace to hit 134 homers which would be the most in a season since 2023 when the club hit 122 round trippers. Altoona's franchise record of 143 homers in a season was set in 2022. 17 different players have hit a home run this season, 2nd-most by an Eastern League club.

Overall, Double-A clubs have experienced an incredible bump in home runs. Entering play on July 11, Eastern League hitters have hit 1,155 home runs in 33,224 at-bats (1 per 28.76 AB's), compared to 1,238 in 52,638 games last year (1 per 42.52 AB's); an increase of 47.8%. The most home runs hit in an Eastern League season, since 2005, is 1,824 home runs in 2022 (1 per 29.6 at-bats).

Across Double-A, homers are up 53.1% and the team batting average for the Eastern League is up to .247 (from .232 in 2025), which would be the highest since 2018 (.253).

Dominic Matthew Perachi... Is the first player to be drafted from Salve Regina (Newport, RI)... Signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$125,000... Born in Danbury, CT, raised in Washington Depot, CT... His father, Matt, is the Athletic Director at Shepaug HS where he attended high school... Shepaug Valley is one of the smaller school districts in Connecticut's Public School system, ranking 167th out of 185 in terms of size... His brother, Michael, plays basketball at Division II Bentley University, his sister Marissa plays Soccer at Division III Salve Regina... His girlfriend, Mikayla, is the Promotions and Entertainment Manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels, Dominic lived in Richmond with her in the 25-26 off-season...

In 2025... Began the season on the IL with a left elbow injury... Returned to the mound on rehab in the FCL on July 1 and made appearances with Bradenton and Greensboro before joining Altoona on August 1 at Portland... Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings at Portland in his first outing with ALT... Allowed 18 Runs in last 12.1 IP over his next 4 starts... Earned a win in each of his last 2 starts in the regular season (6.0 IP, 0 R at Harrisburg, 5.2 IP, 3 R, vs Richmond)... Tossed 2.0 innings in Game 2 of the Southwest Division series at Erie, allowing two runs... After the season played with the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League...

In 2024... Finished the season 4th among PIT MiLB in IP (114.2), 1 of 6 PIT minor leaguers to throw 100.0 IP or more, also ranked 3rd in strikeouts (121), 1st among LHP in the Pirates system... After the season was named a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star... Made a spot start on 5/2 @ HBG in the 2nd of a DH, took the loss allowing 4 runs (3 ER) in 4.0 IP, 7 H, 3 BB, 2 K... Picked up his first professional save with 4.0 scoreless innings on 5/8 vs. Somerset, combined with Ashcraft on a 3-hit shutout... Transferred to GBO on 5/9 and slotted into their rotation going 4-3 with a 2.42 ERA in 13 games, 10 starts... Led the SAL in ERA (2.42), BAA (.175), WHIP (0.87), also ranked 4th in strikeouts (74) in that time (5/14-8/6)... Was named the SAL Pitcher of the Week on July 28 after striking out a career-high 11 batters on 7/25 at Asheville... Transferred to ALT on 8/6....

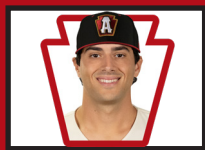

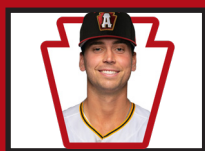
