ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-1 at Dow Diamond on Wednesday night. Ismael Alcantara drove in both Loons runs with a two-out single in the bottom of the fifth inning to put the Loons up 2-0. Robert Moore hit a lead-off homer in the sixth inning for Wisconsin's run. Great Lakes pitchers combined to strikeout seventeen

MISIOROWSKI REPORT: Timber Rattlers starting pitcher Jacob Misiorowski allowed a hit, hit two batters, walked two, threw a wild pitch, and struck out three over three scoreless innings. He left the game with 70 pitches - 39 strikes - in his ledger.

UNEARNED: Great Lakes had two outs with none on base in the bottom of the fifth against Max Lazar. Griffin Lockwood-Powell doubled to keep the inning alive for the Loons. Taylor Young sent a grounder to short, but a wild throw for an error put runners on the corners. Young stole second before Alcantara's single knocked in two unearned runs.

DÉJÀ VU: Moore also homered in the sixth inning on Tuesday afternoon against the Loons. Moore has six home runs and 28 RBI on the season to lead Wisconsin in both categories.

BIG CHANCE: The Rattlers loaded the bases with no outs after the homer by Moore. However, the Rattlers were unable to score. They only had one base runner over the final three innings

DEBUT DAY: Tanner Shears made his Timber Rattlers debut with two scoreless, hitless innings. He hit two batters and struck out four.

ALL IT TOOK WAS ONE: Great Lakes went 1-for-12 with runners in scoring position last night with Alcantara's single providing the winning margin. The loons are 2-for-27 with runners in scoring position in this

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019 and again in 2022. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Hendry Mendez (#13) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has seven Great Lakes players on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Dalton Rushing (#7), Yeiner Fernandez (#14), Maddux Bruns (#15), Ronan Kopp (#19), Damon Keith (#24), Alex Freeland (#25), and Justin Wrobleski (#29)

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner had a no decision at West Michigan on <u>June 7</u>. He allowed three runs on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Wagoner has never faced the Loons prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP RONAN KOPP: The Dodgers selected Kopp in the twelfth round of the 2021 draft out of South Mountain Community College.

IS IT IN YOU? Kopp was named the Gatorade High School Player of the Year in Arizona in 2019 as a junior. He was 8-0 with a 0.41 ERA and 118 strikeouts in 51 innings on the mound and hit .522 with 39RBI and 29 stolen bases at the plate to help Scottsdale Christian Academy win a Conference 2A State Title.

GOING TO THE MOUNTAIN: Kopp was 0-1 with a save in ten games – six starts – for South Mountain in 2021. He had a 2,84 ERA and 38 strikeouts with 25 walks over 25-1/3 innings pitched.

FEELING A DRAFT: Kopp made eight appearances – four starts – for the Frederick Keys in the MLB Draft League. He was 1-1 with a 1.46ERA, 30 walks, and 45 strikeouts in 24-2/3 innings before Los Angeles picked him in the draft.

DODGING THE SYSTEM: Kopp made three relief appearances in the ACL after signing with the Dodgers in 2021. He was 5-2 with a save and a 2.81 ERA in 24 games – nine starts – for Rancho Cucamonga before a late season call up to the Loons in 2022. Kopp struck out 108 and walked 43 in 62-1/3 innings pitched in 2022.

LAST START: Kopp lost to Lake County at home on <u>June 8</u>. He allowed an unearned run on no hits and three walks with four strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Kopp has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He was called into a game against the ACL Brewers Blue affiliate on <u>September 2, 2021</u>, but was removed before facing a batter.
