**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 7-2. It was their third straight win and fourth of the series. **Andy Thomas** opened a 2-0 lead with a two-run double in the bottom of the first inning. Onix Vega hit a sac fly for the Senators in the first to cut the deficit to 2-1. In the top of the seventh, Donovan Casey tied the game, 2-2, with a sac fly. Richmond scored four runs in the bottom of the seventh to pull ahead, 6-2. **Shane Matheny** hit a two-run double to put the Flying Squirrels in front. Thomas and **Carter Williams** followed with RBI singles. In the bottom of the eighth, Matheny extended the Richmond lead to 7-2 with an RBI double.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Richmond played six games in Harrisburg from April 11-16 and dropped four of them, three by one run. The Flying Squirrels return to Harrisburg for a three-game series from July 14-16. The Senators will play a second six-game set at The Diamond from August 15-20.

**GAME 69:** Today marks the final game of the season's first half. The Erie SeaWolves have clinched the first-half title for the Southwest Division and the Somerset Patriots have won the Northeast Division. Those two teams, who met in last year's Eastern League Championship Series, have locked in playoff spots for this year. The second half of the Eastern League season officially begins on Tuesday. The Flying Squirrels will open the second half on the road at Reading. With the records resetting next week, the second-half champions will meet the SeaWolves and the Patriots in this year's Eastern League playoffs.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 18-29 since May 3. Over the last three games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .345 (30-for-87) with seven homers, two homers and have scored 19 runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.90 ERA is tied for second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 242.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 344.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.35 ERA, which is the eighth-lowest in Double-A and is eighth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors. Richmond is for the second-most one-run games is the league this year (23) behind Harrisburg (24) and they lead the league in one-run losses (16), ahead of Harrisburg (15).

**THE SENATORS** have dropped nine-of-their-last-12 games, including four-of-six in last week's series at home against the SeaWolves and four-of-five this week. The Harrisburg offense has scored 296 runs, the second-fewest in the Eastern League this year. Harrisburg relievers are tied for the league lead with 20 saves. Harrisburg's roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF James Wood (No. 1), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 2), RHP Jackson Rutledge (No. 6), RHP Cole Henry (No. 13), 3B Trey Lipscomb (No. 17), LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 24) and OF Jacob Young (No. 27). Hassell is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best strike-zone discipline in the system. Evan Lee is rated as having the best curveball in the system. MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes Wood (No. 1), Hassell (No. 2), Rutledge (No. 11), Henry (No. 12), Lipscomb (No. 18) and Parker (No. 22).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Mason Black** makes his 14th Double-A start and second third the Senators. He started the series opener on Tuesday and did not allow a run over a season-high five innings of work, striking out six. Black has not allowed a run in his last three starts dating back to June 8, spanning 13 innings. He also faced the Senators on April 15, his second Double-A start, and allowed one run over four innings. For the season, Black ranks fourth in the Eastern League (min. 40 IP) in strikeout percentage (29.8) and eighth in K/9 (11.1). Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Left-hander Alex Troop makes his 13th start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. On Tuesday, he worked five scoreless inning and allowed one hit with a season-high 10 strikeouts. He also made his season debut against the Flying Squirrels on April 11 at FNB Field and allowed five runs (four earned) over 3.1 innings. In his second start of that series on April 16, he pitched five innings and allowed three runs against Richmond. In his career, Troop has pitched seven games (five starts) against Richmond, combining to go 1-1 with a 5.04 ERA (13 ER/25.0 IP/34 SO/12 BB). Troop was selected by the Nationals in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Michigan State. He first reached Double-A in 2021 for four relief outings and pitched 28 games for the Senators in 2022, going 7-5 with a 4.81 ERA. Today marks his 45th Double-A appearance and his 30th start, totaling a 10-10 record with a 4.55 ERA.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,605) and rank first in total attendance (237,765). The team's average attendance is the 12th-highest among the 120 full-season teams in Minor League Baseball.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** In Game 1 of Friday's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game, joining **Conor Gillaspie** (2010), **Nick Noonan** (2010), **Juan Perez** (twice, 2011 and 2012), **Kelby Tomlinson** (2014), **Rando Moreno** (2015), **Austin Slater** (2016), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (2022), **Jacob Heyward** (2022) and **Patrick Bailey** (2023). On Saturday, Meckler set a new career high for hits and tied his career high with four RBIs. Meckler has now reached base in all 15 of his Double-A games, including 21 hits and 11 walks. His on-base streak is the third-longest active streak in the league and the third-longest by a Richmond player this season. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 150 PA) this season with a .413 batting average.

**I LOVE LUCI:** On June 4, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot last Wednesday at Bowie. Luciano is tied for the team lead with nine homers this year. He went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. After going 1-for-20 over his next five games, Luciano has picked up five hits in his last two games, including an RBI double and a walk on Friday night and going 4-for-4 with a double and a walk on Saturday night.

**ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN:** **Shane Matheny** was assigned to the Richmond roster on June 13. In his season debut for the Flying Squirrels that night at Bowie, he hit a first-inning homer on the second pitch of the game. On Sunday, Matheny added three hits, including two doubles, and drove in three runs. In his 11 games with Richmond this year, Matheny has six doubles, a homer, 10 RBIs and eight walks. He leads the Giants organization with 46 walks this season.

**RAGIN' CANTRELLE:** In his last nine games since June 14, **Hayden Cantrelle** has reached base 16 times, posting a .471 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up six hits, walked eight times and been hit by a pitch twice in 34 plate appearances. Cantrelle is hitless in his last five games but has walked six times. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks sixth in the league in on-base percentage (.397) and tied for sixth in walks (43). He is also second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year.

**OLD FRIENDS:** Harrisburg's Frankie Tostado returns to The Diamond this week as a visitor for the first time in his career. He played 177 games for the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, batting .264 with 25 homers, 34 doubles and 104 RBIs. His 25 home runs are tied with **Sean Roby** for the fifth-most in a career in Flying Squirrels history. Tostado is one of four former Richmond players who are on other teams in the Eastern League this year. Diego Rincones, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves. Pitcher Grey Fenter, a member of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, is now with the Somerset Patriots. Reliever Matt Seelinger was with Richmond in 2021 and is now in his second season with the Reading Fightin Phils.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Hayden Cantrelle** is eighth in OBP (.396) and tied for eighth in walks (41). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for third in triples (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for ninth in strikeouts (68). **Mason Black** is tied for second in games started (13). **Carson Seymour** is eighth in ERA (3.35), seventh in BAA (.223) and eighth in WHIP (1.21). For the Senators, Frankie Tostado is tied for fifth in RBIs (38) and J.T. Arruda is tied for eighth in walks (41) and seventh in stolen bases (21).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 8), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and **José Cruz** is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).

In the top of the ninth inning, Frankie Tostado hit a two-out, two-run homer against Yoan Aybar to give the Flying Squirrels a 10-9 lead. He also had a solo home run in the fifth inning. The following night, he hit another two-run homer in the ninth against Aybar in a 4-3 win.
