ON THE ROAD

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas get set for the series opener on Tuesday night from Southwest University Park. Round Rock will will send out RHP Tim Brennan to start against El Paso RHP Randy Vasquez First pitch is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

SERIES VICTORY

Round Rock hung on for an 8-6 victory on Sunday to secure the series win. In the third frame, 1B Justin Foscue and C Sam Huff each drew an RBI walk with the bases loaded to make the score 2-0. In the ensuing inning, CF Elier Hernandez smacked a two-RBI double to increase the E-Train lead to 5-0. Foscue and 3B Davis Wendzel walked to load the bases yet again for Huff, who brought all the runners home on a double, making the score 8-0. The six runs scored marks the highest scoring inning for the Express on the young season. In the sixth, Sugar Land got on the board thanks to a two-run home run by 3B David Hensley and cut the Round Rock lead to 8-2. Fast forward to the top of the ninth inning where Space Cowboys SS Shay Whitcomb delivered a grand slam, Round Rock got the final two outs to earn an 8-6 win.

BRENNAN ON THE BUMP

Round Rock RHP Tim Brennan will make his 2024 debut. It will mark the first time Brennan has taken the mound since September 7, 2022 while pitching for Double-A Frisco. Brennan sat all of 2023 with a lat strain. He owns a 3.43 ERA (86 ER/225.1 IP) in 48 games and 41 starts since he was drafted in 2018. Tuesday also marks his Triple-A debut.

FOSS TO THE SHOW

After Rangers 3B Josh Jung was placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right wrist fracture in last night's game, Express INF Justin Foscue was recalled from Round Rock. Foscue will join Texas in Tampa Bay today as he seeks his Major League debut. He is listed as the No. 5 prospect in the Texas Rangers organization according to MLB.com, spent all of 2023 with the Express and opened the 2024 campaign in Round Rock. Last season, Foscue slashed 266/.394/.468 with 31 doubles, four triples, 18 home runs. 84 RBI and 94 runs scored.

HUFF IS HERE FOR MORE

Express C Sam Huff has picked up right where he left off in 2023. The righty is 3-for-10 with two doubles, four RBI, two walks and three strikeouts in his first three games. On Sunday, Huff went 2-for-3 with a double, four RBI and a walk. Round Rock went 26-33 when he was not on the roster last year compared to 63-27 when he was with the club.

WE SHOULD WALK THIS OUT

Round Rock earned nine walks in the series finale on Sunday with Sugar Land and they are tied with El Paso for the most walks in the Pacific Coast League (16). The E-Train enter today third in OBP (.400) to start the 2024 campaign.

CROOKED NUMBERS

The Express have posted a big inning in each of the last two games. On Saturday, Round Rock scored four runs in the fifth inning en route to an 8-6 victory. On Sunday, they posted a six-spot in the fourth inning before taking home another 8-6 win.

ROAD WARRIORS

While the Express went 49-25 at home, they put together a 40-35 record on the road last season which helped them clinch the Pacific Coast League second half title. This will be the only trip the Express take to Southwest University Park in 2024. The Chihuahuas will come to Dell Diamond for 12 games this year (May 28-June 2, June 25-30).

The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
