Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound tonight, making his third start of the season (had 0GS in 54G during last season in affiliated ball, 2024). Iowa will counter with RHP **Connor Noland**. Columbus is 7-3 (.700) versus right handers this year. Noland has pitched against the Clippers four times in his career, going 2-2 with a 5.68ERA (19.0IP, 21H, 18R, 12ER, 9BB, 21K).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 13-13 opposing the I-Cubs (28-20 in the last 48 matchups). In Columbus, the Clippers are 24-20 all time (2-0-5 in 6G series, 0-2-0 in other series). Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has 5HR and 14RBI in 15G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit .319 (30x94) with 9HR and 29RBI in 26G.

Could Have Been Worse

The Clippers lost the series in Worcester (2-4) even though they held the Woo Sox to a .177 (11x62) average with runners in scoring position (1x10 in an 8-5 loss on 4/8, 1x17 in an 8-5 loss on 4/10). Through the first 9G (6-3), opponents hit them at a .295 clip in scoring chances. Columbus pitching issued walks to 12.8% of batters last week, topped by the 13.8% Clipper batters were able to draw.

Walters Rehab

Andrew Walters (right lat surgery) has remained with the Clippers on rehab, as **Hunter Gaddis** and **George Valera** ended their assignments yesterday. Walters has pitched twice so far, giving up a homer in each outing (2-run shot on 4/7 at Worcester and a solo bomb on 4/10 at Worcester). All-time in Columbus, two thirds of his 15ER allowed have come on 6HR (one every 31.3BF).

Solid Second Half

Travis Bazzana was 2x6 with an RBI in the series opener at Worcester before going 0x4 in each of the next 2G. He followed up by going 5x10 in 3G over the weekend, while also drawing a walk in each game (.615OBP). That weekend explosion resulted in a 55-point gain in his batting average (.191 to .246) and a 67-point increase in OBP (.319 to .386). He has not homered since 9/7/25 (65AB).

First at First

CJ Kayfus will get the start at 1B tonight (140th start at 1B in minor league career, 71% of minor league starts), following a series of fill-ins to start the season (**Kody Huff**- 6GS, **Dayan Frias**- 4GS, **Dom Nunez**- 3GS and **Juan Brito**-2GS have combined for 109 starts at 1B in 1,934 career games, 5.6%). Kayfus struggled at Huntington Park last season (.217/.283/.383 with 4HR in 30G).

Big Dog

Nolan Jones was hitless in the series finale at Worcester (also hitless in last game vs. Indy in the series prior), but including his time in Albuquerque, he is slashing .322/.439/.651 with 22HR and 76RBI over his last 79G in Triple-A, having reached base in 71 of them (22 hitless games) and scoring 72 times. In Columbus, he has a line of .321/.421/.457 in 23G since 2022 (.197/.319/.420 in 46G in 2021).

Slump Busted

Kahliil Watson snapped a 19AB hitless streak on Saturday, going 3x4 with a triple and a pair of homers (second career 2HR game, 6/18/25 with Akron). Watson also drew a walk on Saturday (14B on the year, tied for 5th most in the IL), giving him a .381OBP despite hitting only .204 (10x49). He reached base in his first 10G of the year, extending a career best streak to 33G (8/19/25-4/8/26, .407OBP).

Delayed Start

Kody Huff was 1x8 with 5K in March (2G), but has rebounded to hit in each of 10G during April (.316, 12x38), drawing 8BB to 8K. He has 10RBI this month, including an RBI streak of 4G from 4/3-4/8 (8RBI total, multi-RBI in 3G). Huff has gone 5x17 (.294) with runners in scoring position, following a 2025 in which he batted .299 (hit .193 in all other situations), and is hitting .314 (11x35) off RHP.

Free For All

Clipper backstops have allowed 13SB in the last 5G (11SB in first 10G), while catching just a pair of runners (had 4CS in first 10G). Through the first 15G of the season, none of three Clipper catchers have had a passed ball, but each of the three has committed a throwing error on a steal attempt (**Kody Huff** has twice). Among the IL, Columbus has allowed the 5th most steals (24, -9 from the top).

This Date in Clipper History

4/14/1983

The Clippers squeaked past Pawtucket 4-3, thanks to a 2-run HR in the top of the 9th by **Steve Balboni**. The 1983 season was Balboni's last in Columbus. He hit 27HR in only 84 games with the '83 Clippers, finishing his career atop the all-time Clipper HR list with 92. In his three seasons with Columbus, he turned in what are currently the 2nd, 4th and 15th highest HR totals in team history with 33 in '81, 32 in '82 and 27 in '83.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,409 to 1,355).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 394-413 (.488), 364-367 with Columbus (.498).
