History vs. South Bend

The Lugnuts are 213-192 all-time vs. the Cubs, 103-90 at home and 110-102 in South Bend.

This is Lansing's first trip to South Bend since 2023, when the Nuts won three of five. On September 4, 2022, the Lugnuts threw a combined no-hitter in the road season finale vs. the Cubs.

Today is the fourth of a six-game series between the Lugnuts and the South Bend Cubs, with South Bend winning the first three games by a combined 21-4. A Cubs win today thus clinches a series victory, which would be the Cubs' first home series win against Lansing since 2022, when South Bend won the league championship.

Yesterday: South Bend 9, Lansing 2. First pitch was 7:07 p.m., last pitch was at 11:13 p.m., and in between there was a 92-minute rain delay – which is a pretty fitting delay for a 9-2 final. Cole Mathis supplied a two-run double in the first inning, Ty Southisene's two-run single keyed a three-run fifth, and Christian Olivo bounced a two-run single in a four-run sixth for the Cubs in the win.

On Deck: The Nuts and Cubs wrap up the series with a pair of weekend matinees, then the Lugnuts return home to welcome in the Quad Cities River Bandits next week, Tuesday, May 12, through Sunday, May 17.

LUG-NOTES

Milestone Watch: Lansing is five wins from the 2,000th victory in Nuts history and three players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster boasts five players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**).

Home Run Machine: 2025 undrafted free agent **Owen Carapellotti** is on a serious tear for the Stockton Ports, slugging two home runs in each of the last two games, giving him seven home runs in his first 11 games of the season. Carapellotti is a native of Canton, Mich., and attended U of D Jesuit.

Double-A Dominance: 2025 Lugnut lefty **Wei-En Lin** was named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week last week after twirling seven scoreless innings for Midland, and the 20-year-old followed up yesterday with 10 strikeouts in six innings of two-run ball to lead the RockHounds to a 6-2 win over San Antonio.

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Nuts lead the league with 37 double plays turned... *but* they've hit into the most, too (32).

Thou Shalt Not: Catcher **Davis Diaz** has nabbed eight of 14 attempted base-stealers, the highest total in Minor League Baseball for a catcher who has caught more runners than have been successful against him.

Starting Spotlight: Lansing right-hander **Kyle Robinson** makes his second career start against South Bend today. On May 17, 2025, Robinson earned the win with six innings of seven-hit, four-run ball, walking four and striking out six on 85 pitches. It was a wild game, too, with the Cubs rallying from a 4-1 deficit to plate three runs off of Robinson in the 6th (Drew Bowser had a key two-run single), but **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** stole third and scored the go-ahead run in the bottom of the sixth on a throwing error by catcher Miguel Pabon. Kuroda-Grauer added an important insurance run with an RBI single in the eighth allowing Lansing to withstand an Ivan Brethowr RBI single in the ninth for a 6-5 win that took just 2:12 to play. Bowser is the only remaining Cubs position player from that game's starting lineup, while **Casey Yamauchi** and **Nate Nankil** are Lansing's returning position players from that day.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac**, opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with the Giants before landing on the Injured List on April 21. The 202nd Lugnut to reach the Majors was 2024 southpaw **Eduardo Rivera**, who was called up for emergency relief purposes and tossed 3 1/3 scoreless innings against the Yankees on April 22.

MAY 8 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: The Nuts brought a 4-0 lead to the bottom of the 9th at Parkview Field, but the TinCaps rallied to tie the game thanks to errors by 2B Ryan Schimpf and 3B Sean Ochinko and a passed ball by A.J. Jimenez. In the 10th, a surprise storm blew in, causing Casey Beck to throw back-to-back wild pitches with a wet ball, bringing in Jonathan Galvez with the winning run in a frustrating 5-4 TinCaps win. Less than ten minutes after the game had ended, the sky was clear and blue again.

2011: Revenge against Michael Goodnight! Goodnight had dominated the Lugnuts on May 3rd, but this time the Nuts knocked him out with seven runs in the 2nd inning on their way to beating Lake County, 9-6, at Cooley Law School Stadium. The Captains committed five errors and a passed ball.

In a Nutshell: Roots for the Philadelphia Eagles and the LSU Tigers... got engaged shortly after getting drafted in 2025... promoted to Double-A Midland on May 20, 2026, returning on August 1... turned in seven different outings of at least six innings in 2025.

Stats Dive: Of nine walks issued this year, eight have been to left-handed hitters (who also have five of the seven extra-base hits Robinson has allowed, but have grounded into three of the four double plays induced... explain this one: Robinson has been excellent when the Lugnuts are trailing (.179 avg., 7-for-39) and leading (.167, 4-for-24), but is allowing a .391 avg. (9-for-23) in tie games.

High School: Played four years on varsity for George C. Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K.

Texas Tech: Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year.

Welcome to Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yunior Tur.
