HENCE, 'PEN LEAD CARDINALS TO 2-1 WIN TO EVEN SERIES: Four Cardinals relievers combined to allow just 3 hits over 5.1 scoreless innings making two early runs stand up in a 2-1 victory over the Wichita Wind Surge on Wednesday night at Riverfront Stadium. **Tink Hence** struck out 6 in 3.2 innings and **Bryan Torres** continued his torrid stretch with a 2-for-5 outing with a double and an RBI. **Jeremy Rivas** tallied his second straight two-hit game and **RJ Yeager** also drove in a run for the Cardinals. Springfield snapped a two-game skid and evened the series with the win and has not lost 3 straight since June 27-29.



OPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Jaylen Nowlin** makes his 13th start (19th appearance) of the season for Wichita...Last pitched on Friday, August 23 in relief at Midland and surrendered 3 ER on 5 H with 3 K over 3.0 IP...Has allowed 9 ER on 9 H in 5.1 IP over his last 2 appearances (1 start, 1 relief appearance) and has a 7.98 ERA over his last 4 appearances...Has pitched well against the Cardinals this season going 1-1 with a 2.87 ERA in 3 appearances (2 starts)...In his last two appearances against Springfield has allowed just 2 ER in 10.2 IP...Made 9 appearances (7 starts) for Wichita last season and went 3-1 with a 3.82 ERA...Began last season with High-A Cedar Rapids and made 15 appearances (13 starts) and went 3-6 with a 4.79 ERA...Made 4 starts against Peoria last season and went 1-2 with a 3.43 ERA...Split the 2022 season between Low-A Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids...Selected by the Twins in the 19th round of the 2021 draft out of Chipola JC in Florida...HS teammate of former Midland RockHound Lawrence Butler and played travel ball for Marquis Grissom with Butler and 2022 NL ROY Michael Harris in Atlanta...Spurned a commitment to UAB to sign with Minnesota...23 years old

CARDS WRAP UP SEASON SERIES WITH WIND SURGE IN SIX-GAME SERIES: With just 3 weeks left in the regular season, the Springfield Cardinals head to the Sunflower State for a six-game series against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins) at Riverfront Stadium. The Cardinals won 5 of 6 in Wichita in their first series in Kansas from May 28-June 2.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

ON PACE...: With 16 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- » Springfield is on pace to win 80 games this season, which would eclipse the franchise record of 77 (2012 & 2017).
- » The Cardinals have 37 road wins this season, within one victory of the franchise record of 38 (2008).
- » The current strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,270, which would surpass the 2019 franchise record of 1,263.
- » With an average of .336, **Bryan Torres** is 12 points ahead of the Springfield record held by **Tyler Minges** who hit .324 in 2005
- » With 24 saves, **Matt Svanson** is within 3 of the franchise record of 27 (**Mark Worrell**, 2006 & **Chris Perez**, 2007)

LONG, HOT SUMMER: The Cardinals are 32-15 since July 1, the best record in the Texas League during that time and 2nd-best in Double-A behind the Tennessee Smokies. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .276. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.79, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

ROAD WARRIORS: For the duration of the 2024 season to this point, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League by a wide margin. Springfield is 37-21 (.638) away from Hammons Field this season, well ahead of the 2nd-best road record belonging to Frisco (34-26, .567). The best road record in Double-A belongs to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) of the Eastern League who are 37-20 (.649).

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 14 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 8 of their last 14 games, Springfield is 11-3 during that time. The Cards outscored their opponents 30-9 in the 8th inning or later.

POWER SURGE: After getting off to a slow start in the power category to start the 2024 season, the Cardinals have already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 49 longballs in 53 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 64 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest OBP (.350) and OPS (.760) in the Texas League and is tops in runs scored (279) in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half.

LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT: Over their last 3 games the Cardinals have scuffled with runners in scoring position. After going 1-for-9 on Wednesday, Springfield is batting just .135 (5-for-37) with RISP since Sunday. Springfield is 2-for-18 so far this week against the Wind Surge.

FOR STARTERS: The Cardinals starting rotation has been up and down this season but has been one of the best units in the league since the calendar turned to August. Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.48, trailing only Midland (2.22). Opposing hitters are batting just .230. Since the beginning of their series against the Drillers last Tuesday the Cardinals' rotation leads the league with a 1.73 ERA over their last 8 games. The Cards are 3rd in the Texas League with a 3.30 ERA in August.

TORRES ON ANOTHER PLANET: Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, nobody has been swinging a hotter bat in the month of August than Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres**. **Torres** is batting .452 through 21 games in the month with 8 2B, a home run and 12 RBI while compiling a .520 OBP and 1.103 OPS. He has recorded multiple hits in 11 of his last 14 games and is a scorching-hot .525 (32-for-61) since August 10. The Texas League Player of the Week for August 12-18, **Torres** leads the league in hitting (.336), OBP (.423), hits (135) and runs (73).

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 24-for-24 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 24.2 IP (0.36 ERA) and is 14-for-14 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one unearned run over his last 19 appearances, allowing just 14 H with 19 K over 23.2 IP. The Cardinals are 51-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
