#### **ACOSTA HOMER NOT ENOUGH IN 7-2 LOSS**

A Maximo Acosta home run wasn't enough on Saturday in the Jumbo Shrimp's 7-2 loss to the Knights. The game was scoreless until Tim Elko went deep in the fourth inning. The Knights added to their lead with a three-run fifth. Acosta went deep in the bottom of the fifth and a Jacob Berry RBI double sliced the deficit to 4-2. However, Jacksonville could get no closer. Charlotte plated three runs in the ninth to go up 7-2. After going 6-0 against Charlotte in April, the Jumbo Shrimp went 2-3 against them in the last week.

#### WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville has now won 16 of their last 23 games heading into play on Sunday. Since this stretch began on June 10, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their opponents by a whopping 130-80 (+50) margin. The club has yielded the tied for the third-fewest runs (87) in Triple-A while also ranking second in ERA (3.56) and third in both fewest hits allowed (168) and BAA (.228). Offensively, Jacksonville ranks first in home runs (40), fourth in slugging (.492), sixth in OPS (.840), sixth steals (37), 10th in average (.269) and 11th in both runs (132) and 12th in hits (209).

#### MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 19 of his 23 starts, including 11 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 32-for-92 (.348/.413/.739/1.152 at the plate with five doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 19 RBIs, 11 walks and 17 runs scored. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (39) and walks (52) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks tied for 16th in home runs (12) and tied for 22nd in hits (70).

#### BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The Queen Creek, Ariz., native has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 38 games, Berry has earned more walks (20) than strikeouts (19) while going 35-for-113 (.310/.419/.496/.915) at the plate with 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 20 RBIs and 22 runs scored.

#### FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

Jacksonville lost 7-2 to Charlotte on Saturday. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 19 of their last 23 games (82.6 percent), including 16 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stertch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs; the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A with 40 home runs over the last 23 games. They hit just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

#### THE MORE. THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 86 games this season, the Shrimp have already used 24 different starting pitchers. Of the three lid-lifters to register double-digit starts for Jacksonville in 2025, only one is still in the rotation (Adam Mazur). Freddy Tarnok is now a member of the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen while Robinson Piña is a member of the Toronto Blue Jays' organization. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 332.2 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.71 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

#### MACK TRUCK

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, Joe Mack went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last 11 games, however, During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 19-for-44 (.432/.457/.932/1.389) with four doubles, six home runs, 10 RBIs, two walks and 11 runs scored. Mack is also the first Jumbo Shrimp to be selected for the MLB All-Star Futures Game since right-handed pitcher Sixto Sánchez in 2019.

#### SHRIMP BITES

At 53-33, Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2006 Jacksonville Suns started 56-30 Nick Nastrini is scheduled to be the Jumbo Shrimp's 25th different starting pitcher this season... Graham Pauley is slashing .303/.387/.636/1.036 (4 2B, 6 HR, 12 RBIs, 12 R) in his last 18 games.

#### ABOUT NICK

-Nastrini was originally selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the fourth round of the  $2021\ draft$  out of UCLA.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Tulsa in the Dodgers' organization, Nastrini was traded to the Chicago White Sox on July 28, 2023 along with outfielder Trayce Thompson and right-handed pitcher Jordan Leasure in exchange for right-handers Lance Lynn and Joe Kelly.

-Nastrini made his major league debut for the White Sox on April 15, 2024, yielding two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings with five strikeouts and two walks in a contest against the Kansas City Royals in Chicago.

-Nastrini pitched in just 21 collegiate games at UCLA, going 5-3 with a  $4.73\,\mathrm{ERA}$ . He lost his spot in the Bruins' weekend rotation during his final season at UCLA, finishing the campaign with a  $6.89\,\mathrm{ERA}$  (31.1 IP, 19 H, 38 BB, 48 K).

#### 2025 SEASON

--The Miami Marlins claimed Nastrini on waivers on July 1, 2025 from the White Sox and promptly optioned him to Triple-A Jacksonville.

#### 2024 SEASON

-In 14 appearances at home, including 12 starts, Nastrini went 2-6 with a 3.63 ERA (62.0 IP, 47 H, 36 BB, 65 K, .205 BAA). In comparison, over 16 road games, including 14 starts, Nastrini was 1-10 with an 8.13 ERA (58.2 IP, 68 H, 52 BB, 59 K, .283 BAA).

-As a starter, Nastrini was 3-16 with a 5.98 ERA in 26 starts (111.1 IP, 110 H, 78 BB, 114 K, .252 BAA). In four appearances out of the bullpen, the right-hander posted a 3.86 ERA (9.1 IP, 5 H, 10 BB, 10 K, .156 BAA).

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

- -Nastrini majored in sociology at UCLA.
- -Was college teammates with fellow big leaguers Garrett Mitchell, Matt McLain and Ryan Kreidler.
- -In college, Nastrini struck out 12.8 batters per nine innings.
- -Was the fourth player and third pitcher to reach the major leagues from Cathedral Catholic High School in San Diego (Sean Bouchard, Daniel Camarena and Stephen Gonsalves).
