# BROOKLYN CYCLONES (4-9) vs. WILMINGTON BLUE ROCKS (7-6)

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped their first extra-inning game of the season on Friday night, 4-2, to Wilmington in 10 innings...Trailing 2-0, Brooklyn tied it thanks to a RF Stanley Consuegra triple and wild pitch in the 7th and a 2-out RBI infield single from DH Joe Suozzi in the 9th...The Blue Rocks grabbed the lead for good in the 10th on a bunt RBI knock with 2 down by RF Jacob Young plus a fielding error...RHP Tyler Stuart hurled a career-high 5.2 innings of 2-run, 6-strikeout ball in a no-decision for the 'Clones...C Kevin Parada added a pair of hits, including a double.

A.T., ALEX TERRESTRIAL: OF Alex Ramírez comes into Saturday riding a team-season-best 8-game hitting streak...The stretch is also good for the second-longest active streak in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old is 12-for-hislast-33 (.364) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 8 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 stolen bases...Since the start of last season, Ramírez leads all Mets' minor leaguers in batting average (.282) and triples (7)...He is also tied with former Cyclone INF Ronny Mauricio for the most doubles (33)...Ramírez is 2nd in on-base percentage (.344) and hits (155), tied for 2nd in OPS (.777), 3rd in slugging (.433) and total bases (238), and tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (52).

NOPE!: LHP Daniel Juárez has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 5 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 11...In 10 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 10.1 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 18-straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 26 strikeouts in 20.2 innings.

**UNDER THE TAG:** The Cyclones have been active on the base paths to start the 2023 season...Coming to Friday, Brooklyn posses 2 of the SAL's leaders in stolen bags...OF **Omar De Los Santos** and IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** are tied for 4th in circuit with 7 stolen bases apiece...More importantly, both are a combined 14-for-14 on attempts...While the 'Clones are only tied for 9th in the league with 22 team stolen bases, the squad is 3rd in success rate (.880)...Only Hudson Valley (.906) and Rome (.885) have been more successful.

**FIRST CONTACT:** INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style...The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 8 games in 2023...Berbesi is 10-for-26 (.385) at the plate with 10 runs scored, a double, a triple, and 4 RBI...Berbesi enters Saturday's game tops in the SAL in on-base percentage (.568)...He is also 5th in batting average (.385) and 9th in OPS (1.068)...Berbesi has walked 76 times compared to only 84 strikeouts in 104 career games.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS OF THE THIRD KIND: OF Stanley Consuegra — who tripled on Friday — was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week (April 10-16) on Monday... During last week's series in Winston-Salem, Consuegra was 9-for-24 (.375) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 4 hits and fell one RBI

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast 5 of the Nats' top 30 prospects per Baseball America...OF James Wood (1), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (8), OF T.J. White (10), RHP Andry Lara (15), and INF Trey Lipscomb (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against the Blue Rocks in 2022...Brooklyn and Wilmington split 10 games at Maimonides Park last season...The Cyclones are 15-10 all-time at home vs. Wilmington.

short of matching his career-best with 4 RBI last Thursday... The Dominican native's previous 4-hit night came with Brooklyn on July 13, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Coming into the weekend, Consuegra is tied for 2nd in the SAL in home runs (3)... He is also tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (7), tied for 4th in total bases (27), and tied for 9th in RBI (10).

**FLASHING 'SIGNS':** Brooklyn pitching racked up strikeouts in bunches last Friday night...Cyclones pitchers combined to whiff a season-high 17 Winston-Salem hitters in an 8-3 victory... RHP **Raimon Gómez** punched out a career-high 7 over 3.0 frames to start...LHP **Daniel Juárez** (5), RHP **Manny Rodriguez** (3), and RHP **Jace Beck** (2) united to retire 10 in relief...The 17 K's are the most for Brooklyn pitching since they reached that number in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022.

**OUT OF THIS WORLD:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**EVENT HORIZON:** The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26... The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

**INDEPENDENCE DAY:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Including 2023, holds a career record of 108-100 (.519).

**GUARDIANS OF CONEY ISLAND:** Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America...*They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.
