THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2016, The Sounds and Oklahoma City Dodgers played at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Nashville scored one in the third, two in the fourth, three in the fifth, and four in the sixth en route to a 10-0 win. The Sounds knocked 15 hits in the victory.

Tonight's Games: The Nashville Sounds and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp will play two for the second time this series, making up for last night's postponement with a doubleheader. Janson Junk and rehabbing Miami southpaw Trevor Rogers will face off in game one, with Nashville righty Pedro Fernandez and Jacksonville lefty Devin Smeltzer getting the nod for game two.

Janson Junk: 27-year-old Janson Junk takes the bump for Nashville in game one. The right-hander is 2-4 with a 4.27 ERA (52.2 IP/25 ER) through 10 appearances and nine starts in Triple-A. Junk made his last start on June 3 at Charlotte and notching a quality start in the no decision. He was acquired by Milwaukee along with RHP Elvis Peguero and LHP Adam Seminaris for RF Hunter Renfroe on November 23, 2022. Junk was selected in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Seattle University by the New York Yankees.

Trevor Rogers: 25-year-old Trevor Rogers is making his second start on rehab assignment with the Jumbo Shrimp in game one. The left-hander is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (9.0 IP) with a start at Single-A Jupiter and Jacksonville since May 30. He is 1-2 with a 4.00 ERA (18.0 IP/8 ER) in four starts with Miami. He was placed on the 15-day injured list with a left bicep strain on April 20. Rogers tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in a win on June 4 at Durham, striking out five with just one hit and walk given up. He was taken with the 13th pick in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Marlins out of Carlsbad High School (New Mexico).

Pedro Fernandez: 29-year-old Pedro Fernandez makes his 14th appearance (eighth start) of 2023 in game two. The Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic native last pitched on June 4, tossing 5.1 frames out of the bullpen against Charlotte. Fernandez went 8-4 with a 4.42 ERA in 17 starts for Quintana Roo of the Mexican League last season and was signed to a minor league deal with Milwaukee on January 23, 2023. He was initially signed as an international free agent by Kansas City on September 2, 2011.

Devin Smeltzer: 27-year-old Devin Smeltzer gets the ball for Jacksonville in game two, his seventh start of the year in Triple-A. The southpaw is 1-3 with an 8.53 ERA (25.1 IP/24 ER) with the Jumbo Shrimp. He's appeared for Miami six times this season (one start), posting a 6.89 ERA in 15.2 innings. Smeltzer signed a minor league deal with Miami on January 18, 2023. He was originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of San Jacinto Junior College (Tex.).

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 15, Fifth: 22, Sixth: 11, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Starters Going Seven: Left-hander Thomas Pannone joined the seven inning start club last night, his first start of 7+ innings since September 4, 2021 with Salt Lake at Sacramento. After Robert Gasser's seven-inning complete game in game two on Wednesday, Sounds starters have gone 7+ innings in back-to-back games for the first time since Chris Bassitt and Daniel Mengden did it on July 24-25, 2018 at Las Vegas.

Rehabbing Brewers: Reliever Matt Bush worked a scoreless eighth inning in his first rehab appearance with the Sounds on Thursday night. Outfielder Jesse Winker was the designated hitter and went 0-for-1 with a walk before being ejected in the third inning. The Sounds currently have four players on rehab assignment on their roster, the most since August 17, 2022 (Jake Cousins, Adrian Houser, J.C. Mejia, Trevor Rosenthal and Omar Narvaez). Bush is the ninth Brewer to join Nashville on rehab assignment this season (Adrian Houser, Tyrone Taylor, Gus Varland, Luke Voit, Luis Urias, Eric Lauer, J.B. Bukauskas and Winker).

Brice is Back: Infielder Brice Turang, who was optioned by the Brewers on June 7, returns to the Sounds lineup for the first time since 2022 tonight. He was the 2022 Sounds MVP after hitting .286 (152-for-532) with 24 doubles, 13 homers and 78 RBI. The first-round pick in the 2018 draft was hitting .205 (34-for-166) with a .254 OBP with the Brewers this season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 630-548 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Junk's last start was June 3 at Charlotte when he tossed his first quality start of the season (6.1 IP, 3 ER). He walked one and struck out one, tossing 90 pitches and 59 for strikes. Junk did not factor into the decision as Nashville put up a three-run ninth to win 5-3.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Junk's sole appearance against Jacksonville came on April 21 of this season. He tossed 5.2 scoreless innings and earned the win.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made his first start in the Brewers organization on April 2, allowing one run in 5.0 innings.
- Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings of relief on April 7 at Memphis, earning the win.
- Recalled to Milwaukee on April 11 to make start at Arizona on April 12 (L, 4.2 IP, 5 R, 4 ER)...optioned to Nashville on April 13.
- Earned the win in a start at Jacksonville on April 19...was the first win by a Nashville starter this season.
- Saddled with loss on April 27 vs. Omaha...home run allowed in second inning snapped Junk's 13.2-inning scoreless streak with Sounds, dating back to April 2.
- Went 0-3 with a 6.66 ERA (25.2 IP/19 ER) in five May starts.

- Went 1-1 with a 6.32 ERA in 3 games (2 starts) with Los Angeles-AL...also went 1-7 with a 4.64 ERA in 16 games (15 starts) with Triple-A Salt Lake.

LAST OUTING: Fernandez was the headliner of the series finale in Charlotte on June 4, taking over in the second inning and allowing four earned runs on eight hits over 5.1 innings. He walked three and struck out five. Fernandez did not receive a decision as the Sounds lost 10-8 in a walkoff.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Fernandez's sole appearance against Jacksonville came on April 21 of this season. He struck out three in 1.1 scoreless innings of relief.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Was the first arm out of the bullpen on Opening Day, holding Louisville scoreless through the middle innings.
- Made three straight starts from April 8 through April 16, going 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA (8.0 IP/3 ER) over the stretch.
- Went 0-1 with a 1.50 ERA (18.0 IP/3 ER) in seven April appearances (3 starts)... is 2-2 with a 5.47 ERA (26.1 IP/16 ER) and .327 opponent average in six games (4 starts) since then.
- On May 24 vs. Iowa, tossed first quality start in affiliated baseball since June 21, 2016 vs. Double-A Arkansas with Northwest Arkansas... earned first win as a starter since July 20, 2018 vs. Tulsa, also with Northwest Arkansas.
