On May 20, 2000 the Sounds set a team record by collecting 24 hits at Colorado Springs. They matched the feat the very next night as well. The only other 24-hit game for the Sounds was on August 4, 2011 at Colorado Springs.

Since 1978, the Sounds have welcomed 17,878,820 baseball fans to Greer Stadium and First Horizon Park. The franchise is 121,180 away from reaching 18 million fans over its 44-year history.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.96 (335.0 IP/110 ER) after last night's extra inning loss. The 2.96 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Iowa with a 3.37 ERA.

Six Shooter: The Sounds have won every series they have played this year. It's the first time since at least

1987 the team has won its first six series in a season (team records date back to 1988).

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
