THIS WEEK marks games #57-#63 of the 2023 season, the first game of a six-game roadtrip, and the first game of a six-game series against the Lake County Captains. These two teams played 12 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps winning six of 12, and will play 18 times in 2023. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in pro baseball, while Lake County is in their 20th year of affiliation with the Cleveland Guardians.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST WEEK'S END: The West Michigan Whitecaps fell silent on offense as the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers enjoyed dominant pitching in a 4-1 loss in front of 6,656 fans Saturday night at LMCU Ballpark. The Whitecaps collected just four hits while striking out ten times and finishing 1-for-5 with runners in scoring position as the Timber Rattlers tallied three runs in the eighth inning to secure the series victory. Wisconsin grabbed the lead in the second as Terence Dotson roped an RBI single to take the 1-0 advantage. That was the only run Whitecaps starter Carlos Pena allowed, going six innings with a pair of strikeouts as Timber Rattlers starter Tyler Woessner tossed 6.1 scoreless frames before 'Caps outfielder Chris Meyers delivered an RBI double in the seventh to tie the game at 1-1. Wisconsin rallied in the eighth inning, as Alex Hall pounded a two-run double before Eduardo Garcia scored him with an RBI double to forge Wisconsin ahead 4-1. The Whitecaps failed to rally as Wisconsin closer Luis Amaya retired six of the last seven 'Caps hitters to slam the door and earn the 4-1 win. The Timber Rattlers improve to 22-33 as the Whitecaps fall to 29-27. Amaya (2-2) secures his second win of the season, going 2.2 shutout innings with two strikeouts as 'Caps reliever Angel Reyes (1-2) suffers his second loss, allowing three runs through an inning pitched. Beau Brieske was sharp in his second rehab appearance, tossing a scoreless seventh inning. Meyers collected two of the four West Michigan base hits, including a double. The Whitecaps have lost seven of their last eight games.

THE WEEK IS JUNG: On June 5, Whitecaps infielder and Detroit Tigers No. 1 Prospect Jace Jung was named the Midwest League Player of the Week. The 2022 first-round pick went 13-for-19 with five extra-base hits, two home runs and ten RBI over his last five games of the week at Dayton.

SKUBAL SIGHTING: After suffering an elbow injury in August last year, Tarik Skubal made his first live appearance of 2023 on Saturday in Dayton, going two shutout innings with a strikeout. Skubal finished 7-8 with a 3.52 ERA and 117 strikeouts with the Tigers before requiring season-ending surgery.

JUSTICE BEING SERVED: After going 13-for-20 in a series in Mid-May against the Lansing Lugnuts, Whitecaps OF Justice Bigbie collected his first-ever Midwest league Player of the Week award. Bigbie tallied four doubles, three home runs and nine RBI as the 'Caps took 4 out of 6 games with the 'Nuts from May 9-14 at LMCU Ballpark.

ENTERING ELITE COMPANY: With a 11-10 victory over the Great Lakes Loons on May 16, Whitecaps Manager Brayan Peña collected his 151st victory to pass former West Michigan and one-time Baltimore Orioles manager Phil Regan for 5th place on the all-time 'Caps wins list by a manager.

DIFFERENT STRENGTHS: The Whitecaps have stolen just 12 bases this season, the fewest in MiLB. The next closest team is Triple-A Reno with 26.

BRINGING THE PENA: On May 4, Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April. The 24-year-old pitched to a 0.47 ERA in five starts, covering 19.1 innings in the first month of the season, as he allowed one earned run and held opponents to a .200 average. Pena struck out 26 batters and was unscored upon in his first nine innings and his last nine innings of the month. Pena, 24, was signed by Detroit as an international free agent out of Santiago, DR, on March 6, 2019.

HE HIT THE POLE!: In a game against the Captains on May 23rd, the 'Caps hit home runs off each of the two foul poles – one by Josh Crouch and the other by Luis Garcia – at LMCU Ballpark. It is believed to be the first time in 'Caps history that West Michigan has accomplished the feat in a single game.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold nine of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects. Players include those mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

HEALTH REPORT: The 'Caps IL holds seven players in pitchers Aaron Haase, Jackson Jobe, Tanner Kohlhepp, Tyler Mattison, Cristhian Tortosa & Matt Walker, plus catcher Eduardo Valencia.

 Acquired: Drafted by the Tigers in the 9th round, (255th Overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State University.

A Top-30 Prospect in the Detroit Tigers farm system, the 22-year-old makes his high-A debut after posting an eye-popping 103 strikeouts through just 78.2 innings in low-A Lakeland with a 3.43 ERA. Burhenn played three seasons with the Ohio State Buckeyes, compiling a career 15-8 record with 189 punchouts through 192.2 innings, earning All-Big Ten Third Team honors his Junior season with Ohio State.

LAST GAME: *Burhenn struggled to get outs in the shortest appearance of the season for any Whitecaps pitcher, recording just two outs while allowing a pair of runs on two hits as part of a 4-2 Whitecaps defeat to the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers on June 6 at LMCU Ballpark.*

2021 (Junior): Earned All-Big Ten honors after a standout season, finishing 7-2 with a 3.81 ERA and 103 strikeouts to just 19 walks. Burhenn also enjoyed a complete game shutout in his home city of Indianapolis, allowing just one run while striking out a career-high 10 batters in a 3-1 victory over the Indiana Hoosiers on May 23, 2021.

2020 (Sophomore): Burhenn struggled with hard contact early, posting a 2-2 record with an 8.02 ERA in the COVID-shortened season. However, he maintained a walk-to-strikeout ratio of 25-to-1 (ranked third in the BIG 10) while also compiling 29 strikeouts in just four games pitched.

2019 (Freshman): Earned Big Ten All-Freshman Team after going 6-4 with a 3.96 ERA in 15 starts. Burhenn struck out 69 batters while walking only 31 through 91 innings of work before missing the Big Ten Tournament due to injury.

MORE: Son of Heather and Dave Burhenn. Has one brother, Nick. Loves hockey and enjoyed going to see games at Ohio State Ice Rink. Graduate of Lawrence North High School in Indianapolis, Indiana where he hearned First Team All-State honors his senior season. Went to school for accounting and financing.

Selected in the fourth-round of last year's MLB Draft, the 22-year-old makes his high-A debut after posting an impressive 33 strikeouts to just six walks through 26.2 innings in low-A Lakeland with a 3.38 ERA this year. Melton played four seasons with San Diego State, compiling a career 12-8 record with 184 punchouts through 168.1 innings, earning Mountain West Co-Pitcher of the Year honors his Junior season with Aztecs.

LAST GAME: Melton was solid his last time out, allowing just one run through four innings with four strikeouts as part of a narrow 6-5 Whitecaps win over the Dayton Dragons on June 1 at Day Air Ballpark.

2022 (Junior): Earned first-team all-conference distinction despite being injured for a month of the season, finishing 5-2 with a 2.07 ERA and 67 strikeouts to just 15 walks. Melton also enjoyed a career-high 11 strikeouts in seven innings against Air Force on May 6, 2022, marking the highest total by an SDSU pitcher since Bubba Derby (2014).

2021 (RS-Sophomore): Melton struggled with hard contact early but still ranked amongst the best in the conference in strikeouts, posting a 4-5 record with an 6.14 ERA while punching out 83 batters which ranked second in the Mountain West Conference. Melton also officially earned a spot on D1baseball.com's top-100 college draft prospects.

2020 (Sophomore): Earned all-Mountain West honors in a season that was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Posted a 3-1 record with a 3.22 ERA and 26 strikeouts. Melton was top-25 nationally in wins (3) while holding opposing hitters to an average of .196 - ranking fourth in the conference in fewest hits allowed.

MORE: Son of Charles and Tracie Melton. His father played collegiate soccer at the University of Arizona. Lists Mike Trout as his favorite athlete. Recieved his undergraduate degree in marketing. Really good at “minute to win it” NHL edition.

Resides: Miranda, VZ
Acquired: In a trade made by the Tigers along with OF Troy Montgomery from Los Angeles (AL) in a trade for infielder Ian Kinsler on December 13, 2017.

Hernandez is back in West Michigan for the first time in nearly four calendar years -- having last pitched for West Michigan at the end of their run as a Tigers Low-A affiliate in 2019. Hernandez then underwent Tommy John surgery in the canceled COVID-19 season in 2020 and returned to Low-A Lakeland in 2022. Hernandez was once rated the Tigers No. 20 prospect in 2018 by Baseball America.

LAST START: Hernandez came out of the bullpen, following an opener, but giving up a three-run, game-tying home run to the Lake County Captains, earning a no-decision as West Michigan picked up a 5-3 win on May 28 at LMCU Ballpark.

2022: Hernandez posted a respectable 3-5 record with Lakeland and a 4.50 ERA in 14 games and 44 innings. His best month came in May when he collected a 1.23 ERA in five starts and 14.2 IP and just two walks to 23 strikeouts.

2021: Missed the season (injury).

2020: COVID-19 Canceled MiLB Season

2019: Hernandez enjoyed his best professional season, going 9-7 with a 3.73 ERA in 21 games and 101.1 innings pitched, allowing 97 hits and walking 26 with 90 strikeouts.

2018: Hernandez began his 2018 campaign in Connecticut with the short-season New York-Penn League and got hit hard, taking the loss in the only two games he pitched and posting a 7.94 ERA. Despite the numbers, Hernandez struck out nearly two batters per inning with 11 punchouts in 5.2 frames. Upon his arrival in West Michigan, Hernandez stayed competitive but watched his record fall to 2-5.

2017: Hernandez started and relieved with the Los Angeles Angels player development staff and went 4-1 with a 2.64 ERA in 12 games (7 starts). In 44.1 innings between the Arizona Rookie-League Angels and Orem Owls (where he pitched in the same rotation as Whitecaps pitcher Elvin Rodriguez), he allowed just 25 hits in 44.1 IP and gave up 22 walks with 44 strikeouts and permitted opponents a .164 batting average against.

2016: At just 16 years old, Hernandez pitched well in five starts out of the Dominican Summer League, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA and allowed 12 hits in 15 frames on six walks and 14 strikeouts.
