### Leading Off

Tonight, Reading begins its first series of the second half against Richmond. The Flying Squirrels swept the R-Phils, 3-0, in Richmond to open the 2023 season from Apr. 8-9. Victor Vargas will start opposite Ryan Murphy for Richmond.

### Looking Back

Reading defeated Portland 7-3 to end the first half on Sunday. The win gave Reading its second series win of the season and closed out the first half on a high note. Tyler Phillips earned his second win of the week with five-strong innings, and the bullpen threw four solid frames to secure the win. Matthew Kroon had three hits and Nick Podkul had two triples in the victory.

### History for De La Cruz

Carlos De La Cruz now holds the longest on-base streak by an R-Phil, dating back to 2009. A hit and walk on Sunday increased his streak to 38 games, which dates back to May 12. Last Tuesday, he passed Cameron Perkins mark of 33 set in 2014.

### Kroon On a Roll

Matthew Kroon has been unstoppable as of late. He had three hits Sunday to increase his average to .327, which leads the team and ranks second in the league. Kroon is hitting .409 in his last ten games and has reached base in 11-straight games.

### Trip Trip Triples for Podkul

On Sunday, Nick Podkul entered the game at DH after Jhailyn Ortiz was ejected in the first inning. Podkul proceeded to go two-for-three and hit two triples. Podkul is the first R-Phil to hit two triples in a game since Art Charles did it on April 24, 2015. It was a season-high in triples in a game for the team and for a player on Reading. It was also a career-high in triples for Podkul in a single game.

### Clean Slate

With the first half in the rearview mirror, Reading's record resets to 0-0, after a 28-40 first half. Aside from the record, the R-Phils still turned in a strong first half, especially on the offensive side of the ball. They led the league in hitting and ranked second in runs scored.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies opened a series at the Chicago Cubs last night with a win after taking two-of-three from the Mets last weekend. Lehigh Valley is back home and takes on Rochester tonight. Jersey Shore is on the road at Brooklyn, and Clearwater is on the road to take on Bradenton, after the Threshers won the first-half title with the best record in the Florida State League.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 28, 2013:** At New Britain, unlikely power sources Tyson Gillies and Edgar Duran each homered to lead Reading past the Rock Cats and former Reading Phillies pitcher Trevor May. Gillies ends up 4-for-5 with 2 runs and 2 RBIs while Duran goes 3-for-3 with 3 RBIs and 2 runs in the 6-5 victory.

### Richmond Roundup

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Richmond, with the first being a sweep for Richmond at The Diamond. Richmond enters this week after going 33-36 in the first half and finishing fourth in the Southwest Division. Last week, Richmond took five-of-six against Harrisburg, including four-straight to close the series. Next week, Richmond takes on Bowie at home.

### Squirrel on the Bump

Righty Ryan Murphy gets the start tonight for Richmond. Murphy is 1-4 with a 5.21 ERA over 14 games and 12 starts this season. Over 48.1 innings, he's allowed 56 hits, 24 walks and picked up 43 strikeouts. He last pitched Thursday against Harrisburg, earning a loss, while allowing three runs over 2.2 innings. Against Reading on April 8, Murphy earned a win with two shutout innings of relief, allowing two hits one walk and having five strikeouts. He was a fifth round pick by the Giants in 2020 out of Le Moyne College in New York.
