YESTERDAY'S NEWS

ROCHESTER, NY (April 4, 2026) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders beat the Rochester Red Wings 4-3 on Saturday afternoon at ESL Ballpark. A pair of seventh-inning home runs gave the RailRiders the lead, and a sharp performance by the bullpen kept the Red Wings at bay for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's third straight win in the set.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre opened the scoring with a pair of runs in the top of the second against Luis Perales. A sac fly from Paul DeJong drove in Seth Brown, and Payton Henry followed with a run-scoring single to bring home Ernesto Martinez Jr. for a 2-0 lead. Rochester answered with a two-run homer from Riley Adams in the bottom half to level the game.

The Red Wings took a 3-2 lead in the fourth when Phillip Glasser singled, stole second, took third on a wild pitch, and scored on a throwing error.

Seth Brown's 350-foot homer to right off Erik Tolman tied it in the seventh. Two batters later, DeJong hit an 0-2 change-up out to left, putting the RailRiders up 4-3 for good.

Dom Hamel worked the first 3.1 innings, allowing three runs, two earned, on three hits. Yerry De Los Santos (1-1), Angel Chivilli, and Kervin Castro combined to shut out the Red Wings over the final 5.1 innings, with Castro earning his first save of the season. Tolman (0-1) took the loss for Rochester.

Brown paced SWB with a pair of hits, and DeJong had two batted in.

NEWS & NOTES

STREAK ON AGAIN - SWB is back to putting their offense on the board first, having done so in every game but one so far. The team has a winning record of 5-2 when they score first on the night. Even crazier, the RailRiders have put the initial run on the board in the first inning in four of their eight games thus far.

SCARY YERRY - Pitcher Yerry De Los Santos was stellar out of the bullpen yesterday posting his best outing of the season. He tossed 2.2 innings of work, retiring all eight batters that he faced while striking out a season-high four. De Los Santos also inherited a runner and stranded him on the basepaths.

CASTRO SAVES THE DAY - Kervin Castro is looking good this summer after recording his first save in a one-run ballgame on Saturday afternoon. He has not allowed a run in three separate appearances, totaling five innings of work. The 27-year-old is in his second season with SWB and is on the Yankees 40-man roster.

WELCOME SETH! - Seth Brown was added to the RailRiders roster on April 2 and has since made a huge impact. In three games, the lefty holds a .417 batting average recording five hits, including one home run. Brown has notched two RBI and scored four of his own runs. The 33-year-old has added a veteran presence to the team with just over five years of MLB experience.

ROAD WARRIORS - The RailRiders are leaving their long road trip with a winning record. The team took their first two games of the season and ultimately the series against Buffalo to start things off. After winning three straight now in Rochester, SWB will at the very least split this series with the hopes to come away on top. The team is 5-3 as they head to PNC Field on Tuesday for their home opener.

RELIEVER RELIEF - We keep saying it but it deserves to be said. The RailRiders bullpen has been really good this season. They have the lowest earned run average in all of Triple-A in eight total games. The bullpen holds a 2.23 ERA in 32.1 innings, garnering four wins and three saves. SWB relievers have allowed just eight earned runs while striking out 34 batters. The RailRiders relievers are also the only team in the league to not allow any home runs.

HAUNTING ERRORS - SWB has had some struggles in the field early on. The team has totaled thirteen errors, the most in Triple-A. These errors have been costly not just in allowing runs but in relinquishing wins. Ernesto Martinez Jr has had six while at first base while a few others have had a pair. There are nine different RailRiders who have made miscues this season.

UTILITY - The RailRiders have some serious versatility on the infield, giving manager Shelley Duncan lots to work with. Braden Shewmake, Max Schuemann, Oswaldo Cabrera, Jonathan Ornelas, and Paul DeJong have all rotated positions on the dirt with Oswaldo even hitting the outfield.

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR NOTES: Was the 10th player and fourth pitcher in franchise history to be named the AL Rookie of the Year in 2024...joined Aaron Judge (2017), Derek Jeter (1996), Dave Righetti (1981), Thurman Munson (1970), Stan Bahnsen (1968), Tom Tresh (1962), Tony Kubek (1957), Bob Grim (1954) and Gil McDougald (1951)...was the fifth Dominican born player and the second pitcher to be named AL Rookie of the Year, joining Julio Rodriguez (2022), Neftali Feliz (2010), Angel Berroa (2003) and Alfredo Griffin (1979)..

WORLD SERIES WONDER: Gil started World Series Game 4 vs. Los Angeles-NL in 2024 (4.0IP, 5H, 4R/ER, 2BB, 1K, 2HR marking his second playoff start... Has since made one more in 2025 in ALDS Game 1 at Toronto

RAILRIDERS NO-NO: Had combined with RHP Reggie McClain (2.0IP, 2K) and RHP Stephen Ridings (1.0IP) to throw a team no-hitter on 7/21/21... Was named the Triple-A East "Pitcher of the Week" for 7/19-25 after tossing 6.0 hitless innings on 7/21 vs. Rochester (2BB, 9K)...

TJ TIME: Underwent right elbow UCL reconstruction surgery on 5/24/22 and missed most of 2023 in recovery...the surgery was performed by Dr. Christopher Ahmad at Columbia Presbyterian Hospital in New York, N.Y...

EARLY DAYS: Saw his first Major League action in 2021, going 1-1 with a 3.07 ERA (29.1IP, 20H, 11R/10ER, 19BB, 38K, 4HR) in six starts with the Yankees over five stints...According to Elias, Gil's career-opening 18.2 scoreless inning streak was the longest career-opening scoreless streak by a Major League pitcher since Seattle's Carson Smith's 19.1 scoreless inning streak from 9/1/14-5/3/15...

CAREER:

2025: In 11 starts with the Yankees, went 4-1 with a 3.32 ERA (57.0IP, 47H, 23R/21ER, 33BB, 41K, 5 HR)... Missed the first 111 team games on the 60-day I.L. with a right lat strain...was placed on the 60-day I.L. on 3/24...Combined to make four rehab starts with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, posting a 5.65 ERA (14.1IP, 11H, 9R/ER, 7BB, 24K, 4HR)...Was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the I.L. on 8/3...Made his only postseason start in ALDS Game 1 at Toronto and took the loss after allowing 2R/ER in 2.2IP (4H, 0BB, 2K, 2HR)...Was not on the Yankees' ALWCS roster...

2024: Was named the Jackie Robinson American League Rookie of the Year after going 15-7 with a 3.50 ERA (151.2IP, 104H, 60R/59ER, 77BB, 171K, 18HR) in 29 starts for the Yankees...made his first Opening Day roster...opponents batted .189/.297/.345 (104-for-550, 18HR); LH .210/.314/.393 (55-for-262, 10HR); RH .170/.282/.302 (49-for-288, 8HR)...His 17 starts of one-or-zero runs allowed were tied with Detroit's Tarik Skubal and Chicago-AL's Garrett Crochet for the most such starts in the Majors... His 171K were the second-most by a Yankees rookie in a single season in franchise history, trailing only Russ Ford's 209K in 1910 and was matched by Will Warren in 2025... Made two postseason starts and did not record a decision...made his first career postseason start in ALCS Game 4 at Cleveland (4.0IP, 3H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 3K, 0HR)
