LAST TIME OUT: Rodriguez-Cruz worked through a lot of early baserunners last Friday night against Jersey Shore, limiting the BlueClaws to one run on five hits and two walks across 5.2 innings while striking out five. After throwing 27 pitches in the first inning and 24 in the third, Rodriguez-Cruz settled in in the fourth and ended up retiring the final seven batters he faced in the start.

TRADES BETWEEN RIVALS: The Yankees acquired Rodriguez-Cruz in an offseason trade with their chief rival, the Boston Red Sox. On December 11, the Yankees traded former Renegades C Carlos Narvaez to the Red Sox for Rodriguez-Cruz along with international slot bonus pool money. It was the second conecutive offseason in which the Yankees and Red Sox pulled off a trade, with the Sox sending Alex Verdugo to the Yankees for Greg Weissert, Richard Fitts and Nicholas Judice on December 5, 2023.

GAINING VELOCITY: One of the biggest developments for Rodriguez-Cruz during the 2024 season was a marked spike in velocity. Before, his fastball sat in the low 90s and touched 95, while in 2024 he jumped to sitting 94-97 and touching 99 with his fastball.

IN AND OUT: Across 89.2 combined innings in Single-A and High-A last year, Rodriguez-Cruz allowed only five home runs. However, four of those home runs came in his final three starts (14.0 innings) of the season. He allowed only one homer from 4/6-8/13 (at Lynchburg on 5/31) all season outside of that spike at the end across 75.2 innings.
