**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader with the Akron RubberDucks, dropping the first game, 6-2, before winning the second game, 6-4. In Game 1, a three-run homer by George Valera in the third and a three-run fourth inning opened a 6-0 lead for Akron. The Flying Squirrels scored two runs on a double by Franklin Labour in the seventh but stranded the bases loaded to end the game. In Game 2, Sean Roby hit a three-run homer in the first to open an early lead. Akron closed within a run with two runs in the bottom of the first and tied the game, 3-3, in the second with a homer by Johnathan Englemann. Tyler Fitzgerald hit a two-run homer in the third to give Richmond a 5-3 lead. The Ducks answered with a run in the bottom of the third to close the gap to 5-4. Robert Emery pushed the lead to 6-4 in the fourth with a solo homer.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series looking to gain ground in the standings against the division leading Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the second between the two teams this season. From May 3-8, the Flying Squirrels won the first three games against the RubberDucks in a series at The Diamond and dropped the final three for a split. After this week, the two teams will meet for one more six-game series, which will be August 23-28 at Canal Park.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won four-of-five games after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they lost four-of-six in a series at home against Hartford, their first series loss at home this year and second straight set dropped. The Flying Squirrels dropped out of first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division on May 22. Thursday's loss dropped the Flying Squirrels back to third place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 532 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 212 walks issued.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** have lost four-of-five after going 16-4 from May 6-28. Prior to Tuesday, the RubberDucks had not lost consecutive games since dropping three straight against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond from May 3-5. Friday's doubleheader split moved the Ducks into a tie for first with the SeaWolves. The RubberDucks are the defending Double-A Northeast champions after picking up their sixth league title since 2003 last year. This year's Akron roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including RHP Daniel Espino (1 - on IL), OF George Valera (2), INF Braylan Rocchio (4), LHP Logan Allen (8), INF Jose Tena (9), RHP Tanner Burns (11), C Bo Naylor (15), RHP Xzavion Curry (22) and RHP Ethan Hankins (24 - on IL).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander Jake Dahlberg makes his ninth start of the season and second against the RubberDucks. He last pitched on May 19 at Altoona and allowed four runs over five innings with nine strikeouts in a no-decision. He was placed on the IL on May 21 and reinstated today. He pitched against Akron on May 7 at The Diamond and allowed a career-high eight runs (five earned) over four innings in a loss. Dahlberg enters the day ranked seventh in the league in innings pitched (35.2) and tied for sixth in winning percentage (.667). Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Right-hander Tanner Burns makes his sixth start of the season and second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched at The Diamond on May 5 and allowed one run in 3.2 innings in a loss. He was placed on the IL on May 8 and reinstated today. He spent his professional debut season with High-A Lake County in 2021, going 2-5 with a 3.57 ERA in 18 starts. Burns was selected with the 36th-overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft by Cleveland out of Auburn and is rated by MLB.com as the Guardians' No. 11 prospect. Prior to attending Auburn, Burns was the Alabama Gatorade Player of the Year in 2017 at Decatur High School. His father, Mike Burns, played three seasons in the Houston Astros organization from 1991-1993.

**LOPSIDED:** On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -21 runs. In their last 15 losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 6.3 runs. Of those 15 losses, four have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on May 15, a 12-2 loss at Altoona on May 17 and a 19-8 loss on May 22 at Altoona, which tied the franchise record for runs allowed in a game. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in seven of their last 15 losses.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,040) and total attendance (144,959). Richmond is 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 64 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (69). Sean Roby is third in the league with 13 homers on the season, with 10 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 180 home runs.

**BRETT'S BASHING:** Brett Auerbach homered in back-to-back games on Sunday and Tuesday. He went deep in the Flying Squirrels' 22-7 win on Sunday over Hartford, one of a franchise-record seven homers in the game for the team. He hit a two-run homer on Tuesday at Akron to tie the game in a 3-2 win. Auerbach has picked up at least one RBI in seven-of-his-last-12 games since May 19, totaling 10 RBIs.

**MARTY PARTY:** Over his last 18 games played since May 11, Brandon Martorano has hit .318 (21-for-66) with five homers, three doubles, two triples and 14 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. He added a solo homer in last Sunday's series finale at Altoona. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer on Tuesday at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in Thursday's 8-4 win over the Ducks.

**TOASTY:** Frankie Tostado is batting .343 (46-for-134) with seven homers, seven doubles, a triple and 22 RBIs over his last 35 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 376 of his 455 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked second in batting average (.326), eighth in SLG (.517), 10th in OPS (.885), second in hits (56) and tied for third in total bases (89).

**ROBUST:** With his three-run homer on Friday in Game 2 of the doubleheader in Akron, Sean Roby held his spot in third in the league with 13 home runs this season. With two homers on Sunday against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. He has hit 10 homers at The Diamond this season, which is tied for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history with Adam Duvall (2013). Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking four in his last seven games since May 26.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** Frankie Tostado is ranked second in batting average (.326), eighth in SLG (.517), 10th in OPS (.885), second in hits (56) and tied for third in total bases (89). Sean Roby is third in home runs (13) and 10th in SLG (.513). Ryan Walker is first in wins (6) and Solomon Bates is tied for fifth (4). Chris Wright is tied for third in saves (6). Taylor Rashi is tied for sixth in games pitched (17).

**WHERE THE DUCKS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Will Brennan is seventh in batting average (.311), first in RBIs (39), ninth in OPS (.886) and tied for seventh in doubles (12). Bo Naylor is fourth in OBP (.417) and tied for third in walks (34). Jose Tena is tied for third in hits (55). George Valera is seventh in walks (28) and fourth in runs scored (34). Nic Enrigh is tied for first in saves (9).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Kyle Harrison (2), Will Wilson (16), R.J. Dabovich (17) and Chris Wright (27). Franklin Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Simon Whiteman is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Wilson (21), Brett Auerbach (27) and Kai-Wei Teng (30). Harrison is Baseball America's No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
